CARDINALS NOTES (Extra Innings: 3-3)

- **Luke Weaver** made his seventh start, second against the Cubs in 2018 (0-1) and fourth career start vs. the Cubs (0-2)...made his Major League debut vs. the Cubs at Wrigley Field (8/13) in a no decision...surrendered a career-high nine hits in his last start vs. CHI (4/19)...has yet to pitch over 4.0 innings vs. the Cubs in his career and has a career ERA of 12.00 (20 ER/15.0 IP)...has allowed four runs or more in four straight starts.
- **Kolten Wong** hit his 3rd career walk-off home run (last: 5/13/15 vs. PIT)...his 3rd career extra inning home run (Last: 7/19/15 vs. NYM)...was hit by pitch twice in today's game, the 9th Cardinals player since 1913 to be HBP twice in a game and the first since **Aledmys Díaz** (6/10/2016 at PIT).
- **Matt Carpenter** had two RBI today, his 3rd career game with multiple RBI vs. CHI with twice this season (4/17 at CHI, 3 RBI)...passed **Red Schoendienst** for 14th all-time in Cardinals history with 498 career walks.
- **Greg Garcia** recorded his first RBI since 4/22 vs. CIN...his last 3 RBI have all been in a pinch-hit role...is the only Cardinals batter with a PH RBI this season (3)...hit his 3rd career sac fly (has one in each of the last three seasons).
- **Harrison Bader** tied his season/career-high with two runs scored (also: 4/25 vs. NYM).
- **Marcell Ozuna** tallied his team-leading 6th multi-RBI game of the season.
- **José Martinez** has posted consecutive multi-hit games for the 3rd time this season.
- **Dexter Fowler** has scored in three straight games for the 2nd time this season (4/21-24).
- **Matt Bowman** has allowed three home runs in his last five appearances...had allowed four home runs total in each of his last two seasons.
- **Greg Holland** recorded his fifth straight scoreless appearance at home.
- **Tyler Lyons** earned his first win of the season. Last win was 9/9/17 vs. PIT.
- *Several Cardinals left the game today with apparent injuries Tommy Pham (right groin tightness), Yadier Molina (undisclosed) and Bud Norris (triceps tightened).*
- **The Cardinals** overcame their largest deficit of the season (4 runs) to win...8th come-from-behind win of the season...recorded their 4th walk-off win of the season, second this week (5/1 vs. CWS) and 3rd in their last five home games...last walk-off win vs. CHI was 4/2/17 on Opening Day (4-3)...have played in six extra inning games, tied with Atlanta (1-5) for the most in MLB this season...have homered in four straight games...drew their largest crowd of the season (47,154)...won their first series from the Cubs since 5/12-14/2017 (2-of-3).

CUBS NOTES (Extra Innings: 1-2)

- **Tyler Chatwood** made his sixth start of the season, second against the Cardinals in 2018 (0-1) and third career start (6th app.) vs. the Cardinals (0-3)...is 14-9 with a 2.60 ERA in 29 road starts (32 app.) since the start of 2016...walked five batters today and has walked 12 batters in 8.2 IP vs. STL this season (15 BB/24.0 IP against all other teams)... walked seven and struck out seven in his last start vs. STL (4/17) ...his teams have not won a game in which he has pitched vs. STL (0-6)...has not allowed a run in the 1st inning this season (6.0 IP)...registered two hit batsmen in the game and had four total all of last season (3rd career game with 2 HBP. Last: 9/30/17 vs. LAD).
- **Tyler Chatwood** recorded his 2nd RBI of the season...has an RBI in consecutive games for the 3rd time in his career.
- **Javier Báez** hit his first home run of the season on a two-strike count (22nd career)...was his 2nd home run against a left-handed pitcher this season (entered 5-for-32, .156 BA vs. LHP this season).
- **Ben Zobrist** has hit safely in his first plate appearance in each of his two games batting lead-off, was 0-for-4 in his previous game.
- **Kyle Schwarber** scored for the first time since 4/26 vs. MIL...tallied his 9th multi-hit game of the season, tied for the team lead.
- **Jason Heyward** snapped an 0-for-12 with a single in the 2nd inning...was his longest stretch of games in 2018 without a hit.
- **Anthony Rizzo** hit his first home run against the Cardinals since 9/14/16...has 3 HR in his last 4 games...has hit safely in his last four games (6-17, .353) and has an RBI in 4 of his lasts 5 games.
- **Kris Bryant** extended his hitting streak to five games (5-21, .238) with a double in the 9th inning...has a double in back-to-back games.
- **Mike Montgomery** did not walk a batter, ending his streak of walking a batter in six straight appearances, which was previously the longest active streak in MLB this season.
- **Pedro Strop** recorded his longest outing of the season at 2.0 IP. The last time he threw 2.0 IP in a game was 5/7/17 vs. NYY in which he threw the 17th and 18th innings taking the loss.
- **Carl Edwards, Jr.**, pitched his 12th straight appearance without allowing a run...13-of-14 appearances this season have been scoreless...entered today with the 5th-longest active scoreless streak in the National League (11.2 IP).
- **Brandon Morrow** blew his first save of the season...had not allowed a run in his last 20 appearances dating back to 9/7/17 w/ LAD (allowed 2 runs vs. SD 9/2/17)...has not allowed a home run since Sept. 8, 2016 vs. COL w/SD (64 appearances).
- **Luke Farrell** took his first Major League loss...has surrendered home runs in consecutive appearances (5/2 vs. COL, N. Arenado).
- *The Cubs challenged the out call of Addison Russell at home plate in the 2nd inning. Call overturned (Time: 1:41).*
- *The Cubs challenged the safe call on Luke Weaver at second base in the 2nd inning. Call overturned (Time: 1:40).*
- The **Cubs** scored six runs, their highest offensive output since scoring 10 at Cleveland (4/24), a span of nine games.
