TRIBE TOP THREE

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** won American League Player of the Week honors for a second consecutive week after batting .600 (12-20) over his past five games with four homers, four doubles, five RBI and eight runs scored.
» **CARLOS CARRASCO** takes the hill tonight after tossing a complete game (3H, 1R/ER, 2BB, 6K) in his previous start against Detroit on April 11 at Progressive Field...leads the Major Leagues with two complete games this season.
» Cleveland enters play tonight with an active 11-game win streak against Detroit, posting a team ERA of 1.00 (11ER/99.0IP) over that span.

TIGER BY THE TAIL

» The Indians and Tigers are set to begin the second of six scheduled series between the clubs tonight, including the first of nine contests at Comerica Park.
» The teams previously met from April 9-12 at Progressive Field, where Cleveland recorded a four-game sweep, outscoring Detroit 18-5...**COREY KLUBER** struck out 13 batters over 8.0 shutout innings in the Tribe's 2-0 win on April 9, while **CARLOS CARRASCO** tossed a complete game in Cleveland's 5-1 victory on April 11.
» The Tribe enters tonight on an 11-game winning streak against Detroit, holding the Tigers to three-or-fewer runs in each of those contests with a 1.00 ERA (11ER/99.0IP) in that span...since the start of 2016, the Tribe has gone 31-10 (.756) against the Tigers, including a separate 11-game win streak from April 22 - July 5, 2016...the Indians' two recent 11-game streaks vs. Detroit are their longest since beating the Tigers in 13 straight contests from May 14, 1996 - May 3, 1997.
» Cleveland owns an overall franchise record of 1088-1118 (.493) against the Tigers in a 118-year-old rivalry (1901-)...the two clubs have combined for six of the last seven A.L. Central division titles.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

» The Tribe offense erupted for 15 hits and 11 runs as Cleveland claimed the rubber match of their weekend series vs. Kansas City with a convincing 11-2 victory.
» **YAN GOMES** came a triple shy of the cycle as he went 4-for-5 with a three-run homer and a double...matched his career highs in hits and runs scored (3)...**JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** also hit a three-run homer for the Tribe, belting his 12th longball of the season (tied with **FRANCISCO LINDOR** for the team lead).
» **Lindor** continued his torrid offensive run, extending his hit streak to a career-long 14 games with a 3-for-4 effort...**MICHAEL BRANTLEY** capped the scoring with a two-run homer, his fifth of the season and second in the past three games.
» **COREY KLUBER** became the first pitcher in the American League with six wins as he held the Royals to two runs (both unearned) on eight hits over 7.0 innings of work (0BB, 4K)...marked Kluber's 21st consecutive start allowing three-or-fewer runs, tying **Sonny Siebert** for the longest Indians streak in the *Baseball Reference* Play Index era (1908-)...**OLIVER DRAKE** made his Indians debut, striking out one batter and allowing one hit over 1.1 innings.

CENTRAL HEATING

» The Tribe is set to begin its fifth series against a divisional opponent, having gone 9-3 in their first 12 games against the A.L. Central (8-2 at Progressive Field, 1-1 on the road).
» Since July 1, 2017, the Indians have posted a 40-11 record (.784) against A.L. Central teams...Cleveland has gone 15-0-1 in its last 16 series against the A.L. Central, including an outright 14-series win streak against intra-divisional opponents from July 1, 2017 - April 12, 2018, the longest by any team in MLB's divisional era (1969-, *STATS LLC*)...Cleveland has not lost a series against an A.L. Central team since being swept at home by the Minnesota Twins from June 23-25, 2017.
» Dominant pitching has been key to the Tribe's success against the A.L. Central, as Cleveland pitchers have posted a 1.79 ERA (66ER/331.0IP) in their last 36 divisional games... they have also allowed two-or-fewer earned runs in 28 of those contests.
» The Indians enter this series with a 1.5-game lead in the A.L. Central over second-place Minnesota (17-19)...the Tribe has held the outright divisional lead for each of the last 23 days.

1994: Paul Shuey, making just his second career big-league appearance, becomes the first rookie in American League history to strike out four batters in one inning...Shuey worked the 9th inning of the Tribe's 9-3 win vs. Detroit, striking out Chad Kreuter and Chris Gomez looking before issuing a wild pitch on the third strike to future Indian Travis Fryman...he proceeded to fan Cecil Fielder swinging to complete the rare feat.

TWICE IS NICE

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** today was named American League Co-Player of the Week for the period ending May 13, after winning the honor outright the week before...he is the first player in MLB to win consecutive weekly honors since Arizona's **J.D. Martínez** (September 10 & 17, 2017) and the first A.L. player to do so since **Gary Sánchez** (August 21 & 28, 2016)...Lindor is the first Indians player to win Player of the Week consecutively since the award began in 1974.
» In the past week (five games), Lindor batted .600 (12-20) with four homers, four doubles, five RBI and eight runs scored...in that span, Lindor shares the Major League lead in home runs, doubles and extra-base hits.
» Lindor's 3-for-4 performance yesterday extended his hit streak to 14 games, the longest of his career and the longest active streak in MLB...is batting .476 (30-63) during the streak with eight homers, eight doubles, 15 RBI and 19 runs scored.
» Lindor is also batting .473 (26-55) in 12 games in May, ranking 1st in MLB in batting average (min. 30 PA) while holding the monthly lead in homers (8), extra-base hits (16) and doubles (8).
» Enters play tonight in the American League's Top 10 in several categories, including multi-hit games (17, T1st), extra-base hits (26, 2nd), homers (12, T3rd), runs scored (34, 2nd), hits (53, 3rd), total bases (103, 3rd), doubles (14, 4th), slugging percentage (.624, T4th) and batting average (.321, 10th).

SMOOTH SAILING

» **MICHAEL BRANTLEY** homered for the second time in three games yesterday, his first longball of the season off a left-hander.
» Marked Brantley's third consecutive start in the second spot of the Tribe batting order...through those three contests, Brantley is batting .429 (6-14) as Cleveland's #2 hitter with two homers, a double, nine RBI and six runs scored...has recorded multiple RBI in all three of those games.
» Brantley enters play tonight ranked 6th in the American League with his .336 (39-116) batting average, while he leads the American League with a .387 (29-75) average against right-handed pitching.

COOKIE EARNING HIS STRIPES

» **CARLOS CARRASCO** will make his ninth start of the season tonight in the opener of this weekend series...tossed his MLB-high second complete game of 2018 in his last start, which came on May 9 at Milwaukee...held the Brewers to two runs on five hits with 14 strikeouts, the most by an Indians pitcher this season.
» Carrasco has made one previous start against the Tigers this season, which came at Progressive Field on April 11...threw his first complete game of the season as he limited the Tigers to one run on three hits (2BB, 6K) in the Tribe's 5-1 win...owns a career record of 11-7 with a 3.67 ERA (51ER/125.0IP) in 21 career starts (26 appearances) against Detroit.
» Has won each of his last 12 decisions against A.L. Central opponents, marking the longest active streak in MLB vs. a single division, and the longest by an Indians pitcher since **Len Barker** won 13 consecutive decisions against the A.L. West in 1980.

YAN THE MOVE

» **YAN GOMES** led the Tribe offense yesterday with a four-hit performance, driving in three runs with his fifth homer of the season.
» Over his last 20 starts (21 games), Gomes is batting .299 (23-77) with four home runs, five doubles, eight RBI and 14 runs scored...enters play today with a .266 batting average, which ranks 5th among American League catchers (min. 100 PA).
» The Indians are 14-10 this season in Gomes' 24 starts at catcher, while they also won his lone start at DH (April 30 vs. Texas).

THE BOMB SQUAD

» The Indians hit another three home runs yesterday to claim sole possession of the MLB lead with 60 total homers this season.
» The Indians are the only team in MLB boasting two players with 12-or-more homers, as **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** and **FRANCISCO LINDOR** have 12 each...Ramírez and Lindor are just the third pair in Indians franchise history with 12 homers through the club's first 40 games, joining duos in 1997 (**Matt Williams & David Justice**) and 1995 (**Paul Sorrento & Manny Ramírez**).

59 CARLOS CARRASCO RHP (5-1, 3.61 ERA)

TODAY'S START

The 31-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his ninth start of the 2018 campaign in tonight's series opener at Detroit...marks the 150th start and 184th appearance of his MLB career.

Will be pitching on regular four days' rest after making his last start on May 9 at Milwaukee...tossed his second complete game of 2018, as he held the Brewers to two runs on five hits with a season-high 14 strikeouts.

Set to make his second start of 2018 against Detroit, following an outing at Progressive Field on April 11...also threw a complete game in that start, allowing one run on three hits (2BB, 6K) in the Tribe's 5-1 win over the Tigers.

LAST TIME OUT | 2018 RECAP

Carrasco last started on May 9 at Milwaukee...threw his 10th career complete game and his second of 2018, holding the Brewers to two runs on five hits in the Tribe's 6-2 win...Carrasco struck out a season-high 14 batters, one shy of his career high and the most by any Indians pitcher this season...also helped his own cause at the plate, collecting an RBI-single in the 9th inning...became the first Tribe pitcher with an RBI in his own complete game since Gaylord Perry did so on September 22, 1972 vs. New York-AL.

Carrasco made his 2018 debut on March 31 at Seattle, in the Tribe's second game of the season...was touched for five runs on seven hits over 5.2 innings of work (0BB, 4K), but picked up his first win of 2018 as the Indians held on to beat the Mariners, 6-5...earned his second win in the Tribe's home opener on April 6, allowing two runs on five hits over 6.0 innings (1BB, 4K).

Improved to 3-0 for the first time in his career as he tossed his 9th career complete game on April 11 vs. Detroit... held the Tigers to just one run on three hits over 9.0 innings, walking two and striking out six batters...took a no-decision at Estadio Hiram Bithorn against Minnesota on April 18 despite tossing 7.0 shutout innings (3H, 1BB, 7K).

Carrasco enters play tonight T3rd in the American League in wins (5), 1st in complete games (2), 1st in night games ERA (0.77), 7th in road ERA (2.48) and 9th in walks per 9.0 innings (1.9).

VS. DETROIT | A.L. CENTRAL

Carrasco will be making his 22nd career start (27th appearance) against the Detroit Tigers...holds a career record of 11-7 vs. the Tigers with a 3.67 ERA (51ER/125.0IP).

Has made one start already in 2018 vs. Detroit, which came at Progressive Field on April 11...tossed a complete game in the Indians' 5-1 victory, allowing one run on just three hits (2BB, 6K)...has gone 4-0 over his last five starts against the Tigers with a 1.25 ERA (5ER/36.0IP) and 41 strikeouts.

Carrasco enters tonight 2-0 with a 1.23 ERA (3ER/22.0IP) in three starts against divisional opponents...over his last 14 starts against A.L. Central teams (since June 11, 2017), Carrasco has gone 12-0 with an 1.49 ERA (16ER/96.2IP) and 108 strikeouts...he has allowed two-or-fewer runs in 13 of those 14 starts.

Carrasco's 12-decision winning streak against the A.L. Central is the longest active streak by any MLB pitcher against a single division...the only other Tribe starter in the divisional era (1969-) to win 12-or-more straight decisions against a division was Len Barker, who won 13 straight decisions against the A.L. West from June 14 - September 6, 1980...special thanks to Mike Pocta of STO and STATS LLC for research assistance.

COMPLETION RATE

Carrasco's dominant effort on May 9 at Milwaukee made him the first pitcher in Major League baseball this season with two complete games...also marked his 10th career complete game, nine of which have come on the road.

Through just eight starts, Carrasco sits one complete game shy of his career season high (3 in 2015)...he became the fastest Tribe pitcher to throw his second complete game (team game #36) since Justin Masterson also did so in Cleveland's 36th game of the 2013 season.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN

Today will mark Carrasco's 75th career road start (93rd overall appearance)...Carrasco has pitched to a 40-22 record with a 3.09 ERA (167ER/486.2IP) in his road career.

Owens a 3-0 record with a 2.48 ERA (6ER/20.0IP) through his first four road outings this season, as he currently ranks 7th in the American League in road ERA...won his first road start of 2018 on March 31 at Seattle (5.2IP, 7H, 5R/ER, 4K) and took a no-decision despite tossing 7.0 shutout innings in Puerto Rico on April 18...earned the win on April 23 at Baltimore after holding the Orioles to one run on six hits over 7.1 strong innings (2BB, 7K)...most recently, Carrasco threw a complete game on May 9 at Milwaukee, striking out 14 batters while allowing two runs on five hits.

Carrasco was outstanding on the road in 2017, going 11-3 with a 2.65 ERA (31ER/105.1IP) in 17 starts...posted the 2nd-lowest road ERA in the American League (min. 75.0IP) while earning the most away wins for a Tribe pitcher since Cliff Lee (12-3) in his 2008 Cy Young season.

Since 2015, Carrasco's 2.52 road ERA is the 3rd-lowest in MLB among pitchers with at least 200.0 road innings, trailing only Clayton Kershaw and Max Scherzer.

2017 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS

Enjoyed the most prolific season of his career, finishing fourth in American League Cy Young voting as he set new career-highs in wins (18), starts (32), innings pitched (200.0) and strikeouts (226)...Carrasco finished in the A.L. Top 10 in wins (T1st), ERA (3.29, 6th), strikeouts (5th) and innings (8th)...joined Corey Kluber as the first teammates to accumulate 18 wins and 220 strikeouts each since Arizona's Randy Johnson & Curt Schilling in 2002 (6th duo all-time).

Went 5-0 with a 1.48 ERA (7ER/42.2IP) and 51 strikeouts in six September starts, finishing the season on a career-best six-decision winning streak...Carrasco and Corey Kluber simultaneously became the first pitchers to post five wins, 50 strikeouts, and an ERA of 1.50-or-less in a calendar month since Sam McDowell in June 1969 (6-0, 50K, 1.05 ERA; courtesy of ELIAS).

Notched his 200th inning in his final start of the year, an 8.1-inning, 14-strikeout performance on September 28 vs. Minnesota...marked a single-game season-high as well as the 2nd-highest total of his career (15, 9/25/2015 at Kansas City).

Made his Postseason debut in Game 3 of the ALDS against New York-AL after missing the 2016 playoffs with a broken metacarpal in his right hand...tossed 5.2 shutout innings on just three hits (3BB, 7K) but took a no decision in the Tribe's eventual 1-0 loss at Yankee Stadium.

CAREER SNAPSHOT

Right-hander is in his 10th season with the Cleveland organization after being acquired from the Philadelphia Phillies on July 29, 2009, along with INF Jason Donald, RHP Jason Knapp & C Lou Marson, in exchange for OF Ben Francisco & LHP Cliff Lee...switched dugouts upon announcement of trade, as AAA Columbus was playing AAA Lehigh Valley.

Signed 4-year contract extension with Indians thru 2018 on April 7, 2015, including club options for 2019 & 2020 and could cover up to first 3 years of free agency.

Made his major league debut September 1, 2009 as the Indians starter against the Detroit Tigers at Comerica Park...took the loss after allowing six runs on nine hits (three home runs) with three walks and three strikeouts in 3.0 innings.

Is in his 15th professional season since signing with Philadelphia as a non-drafted free agent on Nov. 25, 2003...has appeared in parts of nine Major League seasons with Cleveland...missed the entire 2012 season after having right elbow surgery.
