NEW YORK YANKEES NOTES

- The Yankees improved to 2-3 on their seven-game homestand...are 10-4 in their last 14G...went 9-8 at home this month...have recorded a winning record at home in 15 of their last 16 calendar months since May 2016 (went 6-8 in August of 2017).
 - Improved to 21-8 (.724) vs. the AL Central this season...are 25-8 in their last 33G vs. the division (since 9/18/17).
 - Are 35G over .500, 1G shy of their season high (twice, last at 84-48 at the end of play on Tuesday).
 - Own the Majors' best record when their starter tosses at least 6.0IP (52-9, .852).
- With a total attendance of 3,018,265 fans through 70 home dates in 2018, **the Yankees have surpassed 3,000,000 for the Major League-record 20th consecutive season (1999-2017).**
 - The Yankees have also set a record for the current Yankee Stadium with 22 home sellouts in 2018.
- **SS Gleyber Torres** (2-for-4) hit a go-ahead two-run single in the eighth...is 5-for-11 (.455) with 11RBI with the bases loaded this season.
 - Has reached safely multiple times in all five games on the homestand, batting .563/.650/.938 (9-for-16) with 2R, 2HR, 6RBI, 4BB and 1SB.
- **LF Brett Gardner** (2-for-4, 2R, 1 double, 1HR, 2RBI) hit a two-run home run in the sixth inning, the first Yankees batter to record a hit...since 2017, the Yankees are 24-4 when he homers.
- **CF Aaron Hicks** (1-for-3, 2R, 1BB) hit a game-tying solo HR in the sixth inning...has 32BB in 38 games since the All-Star break...entered tonight's game tied for the most walks in the Majors since the All-Star break.
- **3B Miguel Andújar** (1-for-4) hit a go-ahead solo HR in the sixth inning...of his 23 home runs this season, 11 have tied the game (four) or given the Yankees the lead (seven).
 - Has 62XBH this season, third-most in a season by a rookie in Yankees history behind Joe DiMaggio (88 in 1936) and Aaron Judge (79 in 2017).
 - Has reached base safely in a career-high 14 consecutive games (since 8/17), batting .339/.355/.593 (20-for-59) with 10R, 3 doubles, 4HR, 16RBI and 2BB over that span.
- **C Austin Romine** (1-for-4) hit an RBI single in the eighth... has 18RBI in last 32 games started.
- **RHP Luis Severino** (6.0IP, 6H, 3ER, 0BB, 10K, 1HR) started and did not record a decision...recorded his fifth double-digit strikeout game of the season and the 10th of his career...each of his last two starts with at least 10K have come against the Tigers (also 10K on 6/4 at Detroit).
 - The Yankees are 22-6 in his starts, the most team wins started by one pitcher in 2018.
 - His 199K are the fourth-most by a Yankees pitcher through the club's first 135 games of a season (David Cone-215K in 1997; Ron Guidry-215K in 1978; and CC Sabathia-201K in 2011).
 - Has allowed 13HR in his last 10 starts after permitting just 6HR in his first 18 starts
 - Is 9-2 with a 3.18 ERA (85.0IP, 30ER) in 14 starts at Yankee Stadium this season.
 - Has 429K over the last two seasons (2017-18), the third-highest total over a two-season span in Yankees history...trails Ron Guidry (449 in 1978-79) and David Cone (431 in 1997-98).
- **Yankees batters** hit 3HR in the sixth inning, their most in an inning since 9/27/17 vs. Tampa Bay (3HR in the sixth).
 - Went hitless in their first 17AB.
 - Recorded their 32nd game with at least 3HR, the second-most in a season in Yankees history (33 in 2004)...are 26-6 in those games.
- **Manager Aaron Boone** was ejected in the fifth inning by HP Umpire Nic Lentz.

DETROIT TIGERS NOTES

- The Tigers fell to 1-3 on their current three-city, nine-game road trip...fell to 5-13 when tied after seven innings this season and 16-10 when recording 12H-or-more this season...are now 35-33 when scoring first this season.
 - Are now 2-3 vs. the Yankees this season...had their three-game winning streak at Yankee Stadium snapped and fell to 11-20 all-time at the current Yankee Stadium.
- **Tigers batters** plated 5R tonight...have scored more than 4R just seven times in their last 32 games vs. the Yankees (since 8/11/13).
- **RHP Jordan Zimmermann** (6.0IP, 3H, 4R/1ER, 1BB, 6K, 3HR) took a no-hitter into the sixth inning...was broken up by Brett Gardner's one-out home run...has allowed 1ER-or-fewer in three of his last five starts, going 2-2 with a 3.99 ERA (29.1IP, 13ER) over the stretch.
 - Tied a career high with 3HR allowed (14th time, also 4/19/18 vs. Baltimore)...was just the second time in his career giving up 3HR in a single inning (also 3HR in the third inning on 8/2/15 vs. New York-NL with Washington)...has allowed 7HR in his last four starts.
 - Is the first pitcher since CC Sabathia on 5/10/14 at Milwaukee to give up 3HR and allow just 1ER.
 - Did not receive a decision tonight and is 3-1 with a 2.84 ERA (38.0IP, 12ER) in six career starts vs. the Yankees...in two career starts at Yankee Stadium, has allowed just 1ER in 13.0IP (0.69 ERA, 9H, 4R/1ER, 1BB, 12K, 3HR, 1HP).
- **LF Niko Goodrum** (1-for-3, 1R, 1HR, 1RBI, 1BB, 1K) has hit home runs in back-to-back games for the third time this season (also 5/13-14 and 8/10-11).
- **1B Jim Adduci** (1-for-3, 1 triple, 2RBI, 1K) tripled home two runs in the fifth...was the first triple by a Tigers batter since he tripled on 8/11 vs. Minnesota...is the first Tigers first baseman since Miguel Cabrera in 2008 to record multiple triples in a season...tied his season high with 2RBI (fourth time, last on 8/23 vs. Chicago-AL).
- **DH Victor Martinez** (2-for-4) has recorded multiple hits in three of his last four games...is hitting .339/.373/.532 (21-for-62) with 7R, 6 doubles, 2HR, 12RBI 3BB and 1HP in his last 17 games (since 8/11).
- **CF Dawel Lugo** (3-for-4, 1R) has four hits in his first two Major League games (4-for-8)...is the first Tiger to record a three-hit game within his first two career games since Danny Worth on 5/19/2010 at Oakland.
- **RF Nicholas Castellanos** (1-for-5, 1R, 3K) scored his team-leading 73rd run of the season...tied his season high with 3K (13th time, last on 8/18 at Minnesota).
- **Manager Ron Gardenhire** was ejected by first base umpire Paul Nauert in the eighth inning...was his fourth ejection of the season and 77th of his career.
