VS. LOS ANGELES-AL

The Mariners and Angels meet for the 16th (8-7) of 19 games this season... Seattle is 8-7 vs. the Angels this season, but is 2-4 here; have not had a winning season in Anaheim since 2016:

TONIGHT'S TILT...the Mariners begin their final roadtrip of the season, an 11-day, 10-game, 3-city jaunt to Los Angeles (4 games), Houston (3 games) and Texas (3 games)...were 3-5 on just-completed homestand vs. the Orioles (2-1), New York-AL (1-2) and San Diego (0-2)...tonight's game will be televised on **ROOT SPORTS NW** and broadcast live on **710 ESPN** and the Mariners Radio Network.

ODDS AND ENDS...the Mariners have dropped 2 straight and are 14-16 in their last 30 games dating back to Aug. 9...are 24-35 in their last 59 games since July 4 after winning a season-high 8 straight games, spanning June 25 - July 3...the Mariners are 39-42 in their last 81 games since June 10...Seattle is 65-55 in its last 120 games (4/28-c) and 70-58 over its last 128 games (4/20-c)...Seattle is 24-25 during the day and 55-41 at night...Seattle is 41-33 at Safeco Field, 38-33 on the road.

- **Double Up** - since Aug. 4, **Mitch Haniger** is T3rd in MLB with 15 doubles (M. Chapman-OAK, 18, J. Turner-LAD, 17).
- **Four Score** - the Mariners are 56-19 when scoring 4-or-more runs, but are 23-47 when scoring 3-or-fewer runs.
- **Get Through 8** - the Mariners are 1 of 2 Major League clubs with a 1.000 winning percentage (68-0) when leading after 8 innings this season, joining Oakland (74-0).
- **Home Sweet Home** - the Mariners are 41-33 at Safeco Field this season and with only 7 home games remaining, are assured of a winning season at home...marks the 22nd time in club history to finish a season .500-or-better at home, including the 3rd time in the last 5 seasons and 5th time since 2006 (also: 2006, 2009, 2014 and 2016).
- **Vs. the West** - the Mariners will play their final 17 games of the season vs. AL West opponents...the Mariners are 31-28 (.525) vs. the AL West this season (8-8 vs. HOU, **8-7 vs. LAA**, 9-7 vs. OAK and 6-6 vs. TEX).

BOOMSTICK...**Nelson Cruz** hit his 35th home run of the season Wednesday...is the only player in the Majors to reach the 35-home run plateau in each of the last 5 seasons since 2014...five players each have 3 such seasons over that span, including 2 who have yet to hit 35 home runs this season: Nolan Arenado (3), Khris Davis (3), Edwin Encarnación (3), J.D. Martinez (3) and David Ortiz (3); Arenado (33 HR) and Encarnación (30 HR) could each record their 4th such seasons in 2018.

LIKE A FINE WINE...**Nelson Cruz** has hit at least 35 home runs in each of the last 5 seasons since 2014, each coming in an age-33-or-older season...he becomes the 5th player in Major League history with at least 5 seasons of 35-or-more home runs at age-33 or older...he joins Barry Bonds (6), Rafael Palmeiro (6), Henry Aaron (5) and Babe Ruth (5) in this elite group.

A LITTLE EXTRA...**Mitch Haniger** tallied his 60th extra-base hits of the season with his RBI-triple Wednesday...Haniger becomes the 7th Mariners outfielder (done 19x) with at least 60 extra-base hits in a season and the first since Raúl Ibañez had 69 extra-base hits in 2008.

LEADING OFF...**Mitch Haniger** is batting .313 (40x128) with 21 runs, 13 doubles, 2 triples, 6 home runs, 14 RBI, 2 HBP, 11 walks, a .376 on-base percentage and a .586 slugging percentage (.962 OPS) in 30 games batting leadoff, dating back to Aug. 9...Haniger's .962 OPS is 2nd-best among American League leadoff batters this season, trailing only Boston's Mookie Betts (1.064).

ALEXANDER THE GREAT...in his last 29 appearances, dating back to June 30, **Alex Colomé** is 4-0 with 17 holds and a 1.52 ERA (5 ER, 29.2 IP)...during this span, he has recorded 36 strikeouts and 9 walks, while limiting opposing batters to a .194 (21x108) average against...since making his Mariners debut on May 27, Colomé leads the Major Leagues with 26 holds...overall, he is 4-0 with 1 save, 26 holds and a 2.83 ERA (13 ER, 41.1 IP) with 46 strikeouts and 11 walks in 42 relief appearances with the Mariners...he has recorded at least 1 strikeout in each of his last 10 games (8/18-c), including 5 outings with multiple strikeouts; has tallied 17 strikeouts over this span.

1,000 AND COUNTING...**Nelson Cruz** hit a solo home run in the 5th inning yesterday vs. San Diego, his 1,000th career RBI in 1,553 career games...is the 11th active player to record at least 1,000 RBI, joining Albert Pujols (1,982), Adrián Beltré (1,697), Miguel Cabrera (1,635), Matt Holliday (1,220), **Robinson Canó** (1,217), Adrián González (1,202), Victor Martinez (1,176), Edwin Encarnación (1,145), Ryan Braun (1,041) and Chase Utley (1,025)...Cruz is the 6th player to record his 1,000th career RBI in a Mariners uniform, joining Ken Griffey Jr. (9/15/98 at MIN), **Edgar Martinez** (8/8/01 vs. TOR), John Olerud (6/22/02 at HOU), Bret Boone (5/10/05 at NYY) and **Robinson Canó** (4/26/16 vs. HOU).

ELECTRIC EDDIE...**Edwin Díaz** is 4 strikeouts shy of recording his 300th career strikeout...his 296 career strikeouts are currently 7th-most in club history by a reliever, trailing only Jeff Nelson (471), Mike Jackson (383), Bobby Ayala (374), J.J. Putz (337), Arthur Rhodes (315) and Tom Wilhelmson (307)...Díaz's 296 strikeouts are 3rd-most among Major League relievers since his debut season of 2016, trailing only Dellin Betances (332) and Brad Hand (314), while ranking ahead of Craig Kimbrel (295) and Kenley Jansen (284).

THE EDWIN DÍAZ REPORT...in 69 games this season, **Edwin Díaz** is 54-for-58 (93.1%) in save opportunities with a 1.95 ERA (15 ER, 69.1 IP) with 119 strikeouts and 16 walks...he has limited opposing batters to a .161 (39x242) average against with a 0.79 WHIP (16 BB, 39 H, 69.1 IP)...here are some notes on Díaz's standout season:

- Leads the Major Leagues with 54 saves...Wade Davis-COL & Craig Kimbrel-BOS are 2nd with 39.
- Is the 14th pitcher (done 17x) in ML history to record at least 50 saves in a season.
- Ranks 2nd among Major League relievers with 119 strikeouts...Josh Hader-MIL is 1st with 130.
- Is 27-for-30 (90.0%) in one-run save opportunities with a 0.89 ERA (3 ER, 30.1 IP) with 55 strikeouts and 5 walks...the Mariners are 30-0 this season when he enters with a one-run lead.
- Has struck out 45.2% (119 K, 263 BF) of batters faced this season, the 2nd-best mark by a reliever this season and the 5th-best single-season strikeout rate by a reliever in Major League history.
- His 54 saves are a franchise record, surpassing Fernando Rodney (48, 2014).

AS YOU (MAY) KNOW...**Mitch Haniger** has had a hit to lead off the 1st inning in each of the past two games, but...**DID YOU KNOW?**...that the Mariners leadoff hitters this season - **Dee Gordon** (99 games), **Mitch Haniger** (30 games), **Jean Segura** (13 games), **Guillermo Heredia** (2 games) and **Denard Span** (1 game) - have combined to hit .350 leading off a game this year (49-for-140 with 8 extra-base hits, including 2 home runs)?...that's the best average in the Majors, ahead of Kansas City (.321), St. Louis (.310) and Atlanta (.296).

ABOUT LEAKE...

- 30-year-old right-hander is making his 29th start of the season, 34th Mariners start, 267th career appearance (262nd career start) and 5th career start vs. the Angels tonight.
- A native of San Diego, CA, graduated from Fallbrook (CA) High School.
- Played in 3 seasons (2007-09) at Arizona State University...went 16-1 with a 1.71 ERA (27 ER, 142.0 IP) with 162 strikeouts and 24 walks in 19 games (18 starts) in his junior season (2009), earning *Baseball America* First-Team All-American, Pac-12 Pitcher of the Year and First-Team All-Pac-12.
- Selected by Oakland in 7th round of the 2006 MLB First-Year Player Draft...did not sign.
- Selected and signed by Cincinnati out of the 1st round (8th overall pick) in the 2009 MLB Draft.
- Is 12-14 with a 4.21 ERA (93 ER, 199.0 IP) in 34 career GS in Sept.

LAST OUTING...snapped a 5-game losing streak with his team-leading 17th quality start of the season in a 5-2 Mariners win vs. Baltimore on Sept. 5...allowed 2 runs (0 earned) on 7 hits and 0 walks while striking out 4 batters across 6.0 innings pitched.

STAYING GROUNDED...is ranked 4th in the American League with a ground ball rate of 49.7%, trailing Dallas Keuchel-HOU (55.0%), Kyle Gibson-MIN (50.0%) and Alex Cobb-BAL (49.9%)...opponents have grounded into 23 double plays with Leake on the mound this season, most in the AL (2nd-most in the Majors).

LEADERBOARD...among American League leaders, ranks 4th in walks per batter faced (.046) and walks per 9.0 innings (1.74/33 BB, 171.0 IP), T10th in quality starts (17), 12th in innings pitched (171.0), 14th in home runs per 9.0 innings (1.11) and 21st in ERA (4.11/78 ER, 171.0 IP) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.18/105 K, 33 BB).

QUALITY AND QUANTITY...14 of his last 19 starts (5/22-c) have been quality starts, including 4 outings of 8.0 innings while allowing 2-or-fewer earned runs...his 42.0 innings pitched in June were tied with Jacob deGrom-NYM for most in the Majors...among ML starters, only Jacob deGrom-NYM (43.2 IP in August) and **James Paxton** (43.0 IP in May) have tossed more innings in a single calendar month this season.

GOING FOR DISTANCE...his 4 starts of at least 8.0 innings pitched and 2 or fewer runs allowed (5/27 vs. MIN, 6/7 at TB, 6/23 at BOS & 8/15 at OAK) are T3rd-most in the Majors (3 others), trailing only Jacob deGrom-NYM (6) and Kevin Gausman-BAL/ATL (5).

GIVE 'EM A CHANCE...has exited 19 of his 28 starts with a lead (13 games) or a tie score (6 games)...in 3 of his other 9 starts, exited trailing 1-3 after 6.0 IP, 0-3 in the 6th inning and 2-3 after 6.0 IP...the Mariners are 18-10 in his 28 starts this season.

HELLO, SEATTLE...since making his Mariners debut on Sept. 1, 2017, is 12-10 with a 3.86 ERA (87 ER, 203.0 IP) in 33 starts (21 quality starts)...during that span, Leake leads Mariners starters in games started, innings pitched and quality starts...in 24 of his 33 Mariners starts, Leake has gone at least 5.0 innings and allowed 3 or fewer earned runs...the Mariners are 21-12 in Leake starts.

TAKING HIS TURN...since making his Major League debut in 2010, has made 261 starts, T12th-most among all pitchers (also: Clayton Kershaw)...among all pitchers since 2010, ranks 14th in innings pitched (1617.1).

2017 SEASON RECAP...went 10-13 with a 3.92 ERA (81 ER, 186.0 IP) with 130 strikeouts and 37 walks in 31 starts...was acquired along with cash considerations and international slot money from STL on Aug. 30, 2017 in exchange for minor league infielder Rayder Ascanio...went 3-1 with a 2.53 ERA (9 ER, 32.0 IP) with 27 strikeouts and 2 walks in 5 starts with Seattle.

DURABLE...made 30 starts in each of the past 6 seasons...is one of 4 pitchers in the Major Leagues to make at least 30 starts in every season from 2012-17, joining Jon Lester, Max Scherzer and Ian Kennedy.

CAREER...has appeared in 9 Major League seasons with Cincinnati (2010-15), San Francisco (2015), St. Louis (2016-17) and Seattle (2017-c)...has a career record of 92-86 with a 4.00 ERA (718 ER, 1617.1 IP) with 1,094 strikeouts and 375 walks in 266 career games (261 starts)...made his Major League debut in a start on April 11, 2010 vs. Chicago-NL with Cincinnati...selected by Oakland in the 7th round of the 2006 MLB First-Year Player Draft but did not sign...selected and signed by Cincinnati in the 1st round (8th overall pick) of the 2009 MLB Draft out of Arizona State University.
