DAVIES AT A GLANCE: Zach Davies, 25, is making his second start of the season....he started the home opener on Monday vs. St. Louis and took an 8-4 loss (5.2ip, 8h, 7r, 6er, 0bb, 6k, 1hr, 1hbp).....Davies was acquired from Baltimore on 7/31/15 in exchange for OF Gerardo Parra.....bio is on p. 84 of the media guide.

LAST SEASON: Davies went 17-9 with a 3.90 ERA in 33 starts.....he led the team in wins for the second straight season.....his 17 wins tied Zack Greinke for second in the National League, trailing only Clayton Kershaw (18).....his 33 starts tied for the NL lead (with three others) and 191.1 innings pitched ranked ninth.....the team went 20-13 in his starts.....he produced 15 quality starts, going 10-3 with a 1.44 ERA in those starts (100.1ip, 16er).....opponents batted .275 (204-for-741, 20hr).....he went 7-4 with a 5.40 ERA over his first 15 starts (78.1ip, 47er) and 10-5 with a 2.87 ERA over his last 18 starts (113ip, 36er).

CAREER: Is 31-19 with a 3.99 ERA in 68 starts for the Brewers (394.1ip, 175er)....made his Major League debut with the Brewers in 2015.

CAREER AT MILLER PARK: Is 15-14 with a 4.91 ERA in 38 starts (218.1ip, 119er).....went 8-7 with a 5.82 ERA in 17 starts last season (94.1ip, 61er).....his 5.82 ERA at home was the second-highest in the majors.

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 16-5 with a 2.86 ERA in 30 starts (176ip, 56er).....went 9-2 with a 2.04 ERA in 16 starts last season (97ip, 22er).....his 2.04 ERA on the road ranked fourth in the majors.

CAREER vs. CUBS: Is 5-4 with a 3.90 ERA in 10 starts (60ip, 26er), including 2-2 with a 3.66 ERA in 5 starts last season (32ip, 13er).
