**THE TWINS:** The Twins began their final homestand with a loss and a win to the Tigers the last two nights...tonight they will play the three-game series finale with Detroit...tomorrow afternoon the Twins will welcome in the White Sox for four over the weekend, including a split doubleheader tomorrow.

**BATS AND BULLPEN BULLY THE TIGERS:** The Twins beat the Tigers last night by a score of 11-4, evening the three-game series...Jake Odorizzi was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing four runs on six hits in 3.0 innings pitched...the bullpen combined for 6.0 scoreless innings of relief with two hits allowed and one walk...the offense recorded 14 hits, three from Willians Astudillo...Johnny Field recorded his first multi-homer game... the win marked the 300th of Paul Molitor's managerial career.

**TWINS AND TIGERS:** The Twins and Tigers are playing the final of 19 scheduled meetings in 2018...the Twins have gone 11-7 this season, 6-3 at home and 5-4 at Comerica Park...a win tonight would give them their most wins over the Tigers in a season since 2009 (12-7)...in fact, they have only won 12-plus over the Tigers six times ever (1962, 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004, 2009).

☞ The Twins are looking to win their third straight series over the Tigers...the Twins have won six of their last eight series' over the Tigers.

☞ Twins have scored 91 runs against the Tigers this season, second most to Kansas City (96).

☞ They have gone 18-8 in their last 26 vs. Detroit.

☞ Tyler Austin is hitting .412 (14-for-34) with four home runs and 12 RBI in 10 games vs. the Tigers this season.

☞ Ehire Adrianza is hitting .362 (17-for-47) with six doubles and 11 RBI vs. Detroit in 15 games this season.

☞ Joe Mauer is hitting .333 (14-for-42) in 11 games vs. Detroit this season.

**MAUER AND THE TIGERS:** Joe Mauer is hitting .305 (245-for-802) with 43 doubles, two triples, 18 home runs, 121 RBI, 106 walks and a .386 on-base percentage in 215 career games vs. the Tigers...below are his ranks among actives against Detroit in a few categories:

**EVERYDAY EHIRE:** Ehire Adrianza has started 16 of the Twins last 20 games at third base...he has hit safely in a career-high eight straight games, hitting .364 (12-for-33) with seven doubles and six RBI in that span...he has driven in 13 runs this month in 18 games played, tied with Jake Cave for most on the club.

**MAUER MAKING THE MOST OF IT:** Joe Mauer has reached base safely in each of his last 11 games...in that span he is hitting .356 (16-for-45) with one home run, seven RBI, five walks, nine runs scored, and a .412 on-base percentage and six multi-hit games.

**LIVE, IN FRONT OF ASTUDILLO AUDIENCE:** Willians Astudillo is hitting .389 (21-for-54) with two doubles, two home runs and 11 RBI in 15 games this month...among AL rookies this month, he ranks first in batting average and tied for seventh both in hits and RBI.

**MINNESOTA, NICE:** The Twins have gone 44-32 at home this season, compared to 29-52 on the road...44 home wins are their most since winning 46 in 2015...the Twins won 41 games at home last season...they have gone 25-12 at Target Field since June 24...since that date, they have the fifth best home winning percentage in baseball (.676), trailing Boston (.762), Oakland (.732), Tampa Bay (.727) and Colorado (.707).

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 1998, Twins manager Paul Molitor played his final game of his Hall of Fame career, batting fourth at DH for the Twins...he went 2-for-4 and singled off Doug Jones in his last career plate appearance for hit number 3,319.

**THE REMAINS:** The Twins have five games remaining on the 2018 schedule, all home games...three night games and two day games...they play Detroit once and Chicago-AL four times, including a doubleheader with the White Sox on Friday (makeup game from weather postponements in mid-April)...the Twins will begin their 2019 schedule with the Indians at Target Field on March 28.

**LAST APPEARANCE:** Gonsalves entered the game as a primary pitcher for the second time this season in his last appearance at Detroit on September 19...earned his first Major League win after going 6.0 shutout innings and allowed just one hit and one walk, while striking out four...established a new career-high in innings pitched and tied career-high strikeouts...first scoreless appearance of his season and career...established career-low in walks with one.

**PRIMARY PITCHER:** Gonsalves is making his third appearance as a primary pitcher this year and his third in-a-row...his last appearance as a primary pitcher was September 19...his first appearance as the primary pitcher as on September 13...he did not factor into the decision after allowing one unearned run on four walks and four strikeouts over 3.0 innings...this will be Gonsalves's seven career relief appearance.

**AGAINST THE TIGERS:** Gonsalves is making his second career appearance against Detroit and second in a row...last appearance he went 6.0 shutout innings and walked just one batter...has faced Detroit minor league affiliates three times in his career, overall is 2-1 with a 5.52 ERA (16.1 IP, 10 ER) with eight walks and 19 strikeouts...last outing against a Detroit affiliate was August 9 as a member of Triple-A Rochester against Toledo, earned the win after allowing three runs on three hits and three walks with nine strikeouts over 6.0 innings.

**2018 ON THE FARM:** Gonsalves began the season in Double-A Chattanooga where he went 3-0 across four starts with a 1.77 ERA (20.1 IP, 4 ER), two home runs allowed, 10 walks and 25 strikeouts...was named Twins Minor League Pitcher of the week for the week of April 22-28...promoted to Triple-A Rochester and made his first start for the Red Wings on May 1... had three winning months in Rochester, going 4-1 in May, 2-0 in July and 2-0 in August...in July, he went 2-0 with a 0.88 ERA (30.2 IP, 3 ER) across five starts.

**KEEP 'EM COMIN':** Gonsalves became the 12th different starting pitcher the Twins used this year (not including the three openers)...he is one of 34 different pitchers to make an appearance this year (including outfielder Ryan LaMarre, infielder Williams Astudillo, catcher Mitch Garver and catcher Chris Gimenez), tied for third most in the AL with Oakland.

**2017 RECAP:**

- Spent first career spring training with Twins and reassigned to minor league camp March 13; reported to Double-A Chattanooga.
- Began season on 7-day disabled list with left rotator cuff strain.
- Named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Month for June, going 4-1, 2.32 ERA (31.00 IP, 8 ER) in five starts for the Lookouts.
- Ranked third on Chattanooga staff in wins (8), innings pitched (87.1), and strikeouts, despite pitching just three months.
- Promoted to Triple-A Rochester August 7.
- Made five appearances (four starts) for Red Wings in August where he finished the season
- Named left-handed starting pitcher on the Twins Organizational All-Star team by MiLB.com.
- Ranked fourth best prospect and best changeup in Twins system by Baseball America, entering 2018...ranked 78th best prospect in baseball by MLB.com.
