FISH BITES

The Marlins continue a 10-game, 11-day road swing with the opener of this three-game series against the St. Louis Cardinals tonight at 7:15 p.m. RHP **José Ureña**, making his 13th start of the season, is facing St. Louis for the fourth time in his career, going 1-1 with an 8.16 ERA (14.1 ip/13 er). The Cardinals are countering with RHP Carlos Martinez, who in four career starts against the Marlins has gone 2-1 with a 5.04 ERA (25.0/14). Miami came into their current trip off a three-game homestand against the Nationals (0-3). Prior to that series, Miami completed a six-game road trip, going 1-2 against Atlanta and 2-1 against the Mets. The current trip started in San Diego (1-3), and then went to Arizona (0-3). The Marlins are in the midst of a season-long six-game losing streak, their longest slide since another six-game streak from September 9-15, 2017. The last streak longer than six games was an eight-game slide from May 15-22, 2015. The Marlins are in a stretch that will see them play 49 games in 52 days from May 25 to the All-Star Break.

SUNDAY'S RECAP

Miami's season-long slide ran to six games following a 6-1 loss to the Arizona Diamondbacks. Miami was limited to just six hits, and scored its lone run in the ninth inning on an RBI-double by **Justin Bour**. **Brian Anderson** collected two hits, his fifth multi-hit game over the seven games played on the current road trip. **Dan Straily** was dealt the loss, allowing one run on two hits and five walks, with four strikeouts, over 4.1 innings.

DAY 1 DRAFT RECAP

The Miami Marlins last night made three selections in the 2018 First-Year Player Draft, including outfielder Connor Scott out of Plant High School in Tampa, Florida, with the 13th overall pick. The Club also selected shortstop Osiris Johnson out of Encinal High School (CA) with the 53rd overall pick, and catcher Will Banfield out of Brookwood High School (GA) with the 69th overall pick. Round 2, which began this afternoon at 1:00 p.m. ET, saw the Marlins with the 89th overall selection. Rounds 3-10 will take place today, with one minute intervals between selections. Day three of the Draft concludes tomorrow, June 6th, and will begin at 12:00 p.m. (ET), featuring picks in rounds 11-40, with no time delay between selections.

IN SEARCH OF W

José Ureña has opened the season with an 0-7 record and 4.41 ERA over his first 12 starts. The Marlins have yet to win any of his starts this season, and dating back to September 26, 2017, Miami has not been victorious in any of his last 14 starting assignments. The 14 starts without a team win is the longest streak in Franchise history. He was previously tied with Brian Moehler, who started 12 consecutive team losses from July 26, 2005-April 28, 2006. It is the longest such streak in the Majors since Chris Capuano went 19 starts without a team win from May 13, 2007-June 3, 2010. Ureña's seven losses to start the season is tied with Joe Fontenot (1998) and Edinson Volquez (2017) for the longest losing streak to begin a season in Club history (*Stats LLC*).

SUPPORT HOSED

Despite a 3.53 ERA (43.1/17), **José Ureña** is 0-4 over his last seven starts. He has received a run support average of just 2.08 over those seven starts, third-lowest in the Majors since April 27, behind James Shields (1.15) and Tanner Roark (1.96). For the season, he has a run support average of just 2.86, lowest in the National League and second-lowest in the Majors behind Baltimore's Andrew Cashner (2.58).

DANDY ANDY

Since May 15, **Brian Anderson** has posted a .347 average (26x75), recording at least one hit in 15 of 19 games, including 11 multi-hit efforts. He is tied with Freddie Freeman and Eric Hosmer for third in the National League in hits over that span (26), behind Brandon Crawford (28) and Scooter Gennett (27), while his average ranks seventh.

ROOKIE LEADER

Brian Anderson has appeared in all 59 games for the Marlins this season - the only rookie to appear in each of his team's games in 2018. Anderson leads all qualified Major League rookies in games, at-bats (220), runs (30), hits (64), and on-base percentage (.366); tied for the lead in multi-hit games (19); ranks second in average (.291), walks (21), doubles (14), and slugging percentage (.400); is tied for third in RBI (25), and triples (2).

- Ranks second among National League players 25-younger in hits, behind Ozzie Albies (68).
- Owns three outfield assists in 29 G in RF - his first action at the position in his professional career. Is tied with Cincinnati's Jesse Winker for most assists among MLB rookies.
- His three assists are the most by a Marlins rookie since Marcell Ozuna (8) and Jake Marisnick (5) in 2013.
- Is on pace to record 106 hits before the All-Star Break, which would be the most ever recorded by a Marlins rookie. Alex Gonzalez currently holds the Franchise record with 99 in 1999, while Gaby Sanchez ranks second with 95 in 2010. He is also on pace to record 42 first-half RBI, which would tie him with Jeff Conine for fifth-most by a Marlins rookie.

- In the first inning of a contest on May 15, 1998, the Marlins set a then-club record with eight consecutive hits, and a club record with 11 consecutive batters reaching base (9 hits, 2 walks) in an 8-7 win at Busch Stadium.
- After allowing five runs in the eighth inning on August 26, 1998 at Busch Stadium, Miami hit four home runs in the ninth and scored six times to force extra innings in an eventual 7-6 loss (10 innings). The four home runs is a Club record for one inning.
- The Marlins set a club record by playing a 20-inning game on April 27, 2003 vs. St. Louis. The Fish also set a club record by drawing 16 walks.

JUNE 5

The Pirates snapped Brad Penny's streak of 17 starts (18 appearances) without a loss in a 5-2 win over the Fish in **2001**. It was the longest span of starts in Club history without taking a loss. Gary Sheffield also hit an inside-the-park home run in the ninth inning.

- José Ureña will make his 13th start of the season on tonight when Miami opens a three-game series in St. Louis.
- Will mark his fourth career start and appearance against the Cardinals. He is 1-1 with an 8.16 ERA (14.1 ip/13 er) in those outings. Allowed eight earned runs over 4.1 innings in his start against them on July 29, 2016 in Miami. Allowed three-or-fewer in his other two starts.
- Will be his second start at Busch Stadium. Other was on July 4 last season, when he picked up the win after allowing two runs on three hits, two walks, and a hit batter over 5.0 innings, with a career-high tying seven strikeouts.
- After opening 2018 with 5.88 ERA (26.0 ip/17 er) over his first five starts. In his seven starts since then, he has posted a 3.53 ERA (43.1/17), allowing three-or-fewer runs five times.
- Team has dropped each of his 12 starts this season, and 14 straight dating back to September 26, 2017. That is the longest stretch of consecutive losses in a pitcher's starts in Club history, surpassing Brian Moehler's former record of 12, from July 26, 2005 to April 28, 2006.
- Was in line for the win in his last outing, May 30 at San Diego, a 3-2 walk-off loss.
- His average of 2.86 runs of support during his starts ranks lowest among National League starters (min. 12 GS), followed by teammate Caleb Smith (2.98) and Homer Bailey (3.19).
- Left in line for win on April 21 vs. Milwaukee, but ended up with no decision after Brewers scored two late runs. Allowed four runs on four hits and two walks, while striking out three, over 5.0 innings.
- On April 3, held Boston to one run on four hits over 7.0 innings. Walked one while striking out a career high-tying seven. It was third career seven-strikeout game; added a fourth in last start, on May 25 vs. Washington.
- Earned Opening Day start against Cubs on March 29 at Marlins Park. Was seventh different OD starter in last seven openers for Miami. Took loss, allowing five runs on six hits over 4.0 innings. Hit three batters in first inning, becoming only second Marlins pitcher to ever tally three HBP in a single inning (Sergio Mitre on Aug. 31, 2007 vs. PHI).
- Posted team-high 14 wins last season, to go with 3.82 ERA (169.2/72) and 113 strikeouts in 34 appearances (28 starts). Established career highs in wins, appearances, innings pitched, strikeouts, and ERA.
- Finished season 14-7, 3.97 (154.1/68) as starter. Did not factor in a decision and had a 2.35 ERA (15.1/4) in six relief appearances.
- Went 6-1 with 2.40 ERA (63.2/17) in 11 day-game starts. Owned fourth lowest ERA among NL starters (min. 50.0 IP), behind Max Scherzer (1.90), Stephen Strasburg (2.06) and Jimmy Nelson (2.32). - *Stats LLC*
- From May 7 through end of season, led National League with 28 starts, and 14 wins in that time tied Zack Greinke and Alex Wood for second, behind only Zach Davies (15). Among NL pitchers who made at least 25 starts in that time, average against (.232) ranked sixth and ERA ranked 10th.
- Set career high with five-game winning streak over seven starts from May 23 to June 23. Did so despite posting a 4.58 ERA (37.1/19) in that time, as he received 7.47 runs of support during stretch.

- Wei-Yin Chen tomorrow will be making his eighth start of the season since coming off the 10-day disabled list on April 28. Began season on DL with a left elbow strain.
- Made two rehab appearances at Single-A Jupiter, allowing just one run over 7.2 innings, with just one walk and 11 strikeouts. In first appearance, April 17 vs. Lakeland, allowed one run and three hits over 2.2 innings. In second start, April 22 vs. St. Lucie, tossed two-hit, 5.0-inning complete game. Struck out seven without issuing a walk, tossing total of 73 pitches (60 strikes).
- Will be just second career start vs. St. Louis. The first came here at Busch Stadium on July 15, 2016. Did not factor in the decision, a 7-6 win, after allowing four runs on six hits (two home runs) and one walk over 6.0 innings, with five strikeouts.
- Made his first start of season on April 28 vs. Colorado, earning a win after allowing just one run on four hits (one home run), two walks, and a hit batter over 5.1 innings, with three strikeouts. In his next two starts, went 0-2 with 16.71 ERA (7.0 ip/13 er), and an average against of .400 (12x30) with 10 extra-base hits (4 2B, 3B, 5 HR, 1.100 SLG).
- Bounced back in next three starts despite not factoring in a decision (team 1-2), combining for 1.59 ERA (17.0/3) with a .180 average against (11x61) and two extra-base hits allowed (2B, HR). Has walked six (1 IBB) and struck out 14 in that time. Was in line for the win on May 20 at Atlanta, before bullpen surrendered six runs in ninth inning for a 10-9 walk-off loss.
- In last start, May 31 at San Diego, made shortest start of Marlins' career (1.2 ip), allowing four runs on four hits and two walks in an 8-3 loss.
