**THE LOSS:** The Royals have lost eight of nine, dropping to a season-low 23 games under .500 (22-45) for the first time since end of play on Sept. 13, 2011 (63-86).

- + Are now 3-5 in extra innings, matching Minnesota (2-5), Cleveland (1-5) and the Angels (1-5) for the most extra-inning losses in the American League.
- + Fell to 10-22 at home—including a 1-12 start—but have had a winning home record in each of the previous five seasons (2013-17), going 227-178.
- + Dropped to 21-25 (.457) in Interleague play since 2016—including 2-4 this season—after going an American League-best 37-23 (.617) from 2013-15.
- + Lost vs. Cincinnati for the first time since June 12, 2010—eight years ago today—snapping a five-game win streak vs. the Reds and dropping to 13-9 all-time.

**IAN KENNEDY:** Recorded 8.0 shutout innings for the first time since April 16, 2017 vs. the Angels (40 starts in between), but remains winless in his last 12 starts since his last win on April 7 at Cleveland, one shy of the longest active streak in the Majors (min. 1 start in 2018), trailing **Chris Bassitt** and **Joe Biagini**.

- + He's 5-1 with a 1.99 ERA (12 ER in 54.1 IP) in eight career starts vs. Cincinnati, his lowest ERA vs. any opponent (min. 7 starts)...he's one of three active pitchers with at least five wins and an ERA of 1.99 or lower vs. the Reds, joining **Cole Hammels** (10, 1.93 ERA) and **Tyson Ross** (5, 1.54 ERA).
- + Allowed a leadoff single in the first, but escaped with a 4-6-3 double play and a strikeout of **Joey Votto**...faced a bases-loaded, one-out jam in the second, but escaped with an inning-ending 8-2 double play, the first of 12 consecutive batters he retired until a two-out single in the sixth...stranded a two-out walk in the seventh before a 1-2-3 eighth, exiting after 8.0 innings, leading 1-0...pitch count by inning: 16 (1st), 15 (2nd), 13 (3rd), 8 (4th), 7 (5th), 17 (6th), 17 (7th), 11 (8th), 104 total.

**KELVIN HERRERA:** Surrendered the game-tying solo HR to **Tucker Barnhart** in the ninth inning, just the third run he's allowed in 25.2 innings this season, raising his ERA to 1.05...it was the first run he's allowed since May 15 vs. Tampa Bay, snapping a scoreless streak of 9.0 innings over nine appearances.

- + Issued a walk to his next batter, **Joey Votto**, his first walk since Sept. 7, 2017 vs. Minnesota (intentional walk to **Joe Mauer**), snapping a streak of 124 batters faced without a walk, which was the second-longest active streak in the Majors behind only **Corey Kluber** (168)...it snapped his streak of 26 appearances (24.2 IP) without a walk to begin the season, the third-longest streak since at least 1908, four shy of **Kenley Jansen** (2017) and **Mark Eichhorn** (1991).

**KEVIN MCCARTHY:** Charged with four runs on four hits and one walk in the 10th inning, the first runs he's allowed at home this season, snapping his streak at 11 appearances (12.1 IP), which was tied for the fourth-longest such streak by a Royal to begin a season...it's the third time in 68 career outings he's allowed four runs

**HUNTER DOZIER:** Put Kansas City on the board with a solo home run to leadoff the fifth inning, the second of his career and first since May 30 vs. Minnesota.

- + He's reached safely in 15 of his last 16 games since May 25, a stretch in which he's batting .288/.344/.458 (17-for-59).

**WHIT MERRIFIELD:** Made his fifth start in right field, becoming one of two players this season to make at least five starts at four different fielding positions (also: 44 at 2B, 6 in CF and 5 at 1B), joining Detroit's **Niko Goodrum**, who has made at least five starts at five different positions (8 at 1B, 7 at 2B & 3B, 6 in LF & 5 in RF).

- + Had two of the Royals' four hits and is batting .320/.391/.444 (39-for-153) in 39 games since April 29, raising his average from .242 to .290.

**REDS:** Improved to 1-0 to begin this five-game road trip (also: 3 games at Pittsburgh) and are 21-28 under **Jim Riggleman**, after starting 3-15 under **Bryan Price**.

- + Snapped a five-game skid vs. the Royals with their first win since June 12, 2010—eight years ago today—and their first in Kansas City since June 6, 1999.
- + Are 3-1 vs. the American League (2-1 at Minnesota) but they haven't recorded a winning season in Interleague play since 2013 (11-9), going 26-58 (.310).
- + **Tucker Barnhart's** tying HR in the ninth was the Reds' fourth tying or go-ahead HR in the ninth or later in 2018, but the first that wasn't a walk-off HR (also: **Scouter Gennett**, 12th inning on April 24 vs. Atlanta, **Adam Duvall**, 10th inning on May 9 vs. the Mets and **Jesse Winker**, 13th inning on June 7 vs. Colorado).
- + **Joey Votto's** bases-clearing triple in the 10th was the first go-ahead triple in extra innings by Cincinnati since April 18, 2004 at the Cubs (**Juan Castro**, 10th).

**SAL ROMANO:** Had 8.0 innings—surpassing **Homer Bailey** (7.0 IP on April 15 vs. STL) for most by a Red in 2018—matching his career high (Sept. 16, 2017 vs. PIT), becoming the first Red to get a no-decision despite allowing no more than one run on four hits in 8.0+ innings since **Mike Leake** (May 13, 2014 vs. SD).

- + Scattered four hits over 8.0 innings...escaped a first-and-second, one-out jam in the first inning with an inning-ending 6-4-3 double play, before stranding a two-out single in the third...maintained a scoreless tie into the fifth, when he surrendered a solo home run to **Hunter Dozier**...retired 12 of his last 14 batters before exiting after 8.0 innings, tied 1-1...pitch count by inning: 21 (1st), 13 (2nd), 11 (3rd), 12 (4th), 14 (5th), 13 (6th), 9 (7th), 13 (8th), 106 total.
- + He's allowed a HR in 11 of 14 starts this season, matching **Masahiro Tanaka**, **Sean Manaea** and teammate **Luis Castillo** for most in the Majors.

**JOEY VOTTO:** Walked in the ninth to extend his on-base streak to 20 games—the longest active streak in the NL—in which he's batting .378/.495/.500 (28-for-74).

- + Also had the go-ahead, bases-clearing triple in the 10th inning, his first go-ahead hit in extra innings since a walk-off single on April 8, 2015 vs. Pittsburgh (11th).

**TUCKER BARNHART:** Tied the game with a solo HR in the ninth inning off **Kelvin Herrera**, just his third career HR in the ninth inning or later and first that tied or gave his team the lead...it was the 22nd HR of his career, 15 of which have been solo and 18 of which have come vs. right-handed pitchers.
