## NATIONALS NEWS

### WINNING WAYS

The Washington Nationals topped the Baltimore Orioles, 6-0, on Monday afternoon behind 7.2 shutout innings from **Gio Gonzalez** and third-inning three-run home run off the bat of **Anthony Rendon** (2-for-5, 2B, HR, 3 RBI, 2 R).

- The Nationals have won four games in a row and six of their last seven.
- Since April 29, the Nationals are 19-6 and have outscored their opponents, 116-68...The 19-6 (.760) record is the best in Major League Baseball.
- Washington's 19-6 record over the last 25 games is the best 25-game stretch for the club since the 2015 Nationals went 19-6 from April 30 to May 27.
- Only the New York Yankees (21 and 20, several times) have posted more wins in a 25-game stretch this season than the Nationals in their current 25-game run.

### ROAD STREAKIN'

Washington has won eight straight road games, tied for the second-longest road winning streak in team history (2005-pres.)...The 2012 Nationals won eight straight road games from July 28 to Aug. 11...The 2011 Nationals own the longest road winning streak in team history, winning nine in a row from Sept. 12 to Sept. 26.

- Washington's current streak is tied for the third-longest road winning streak in MLB this season, behind the Los Angeles Angels (11 G, 3/30-4/24) and the Boston Red Sox (9 G, 3/30-4/20).
- At 18-8 (.692), the Nationals own the best road record in Major League Baseball.

### DINGERS OF THE DAY

The Nationals lead the National League with 69 home runs...**Bryce Harper** (1st, 16) and **Matt Adams** (T6th, 12) rank in the top 10 in the National League...Only the Nationals and the Colorado Rockies have more than one player in the top 10 in home runs in the National League.

- The Nationals have homered in a season-high eight straight games.

### START ME UP

Washington's starting rotation leads the National League in ERA (2.87), strikeouts (358), opp. AVG (.211), opp. OBP (.275), hits per 9.0 IP (6.96), WHIP (1.07), and strikeouts per 9.0 IP (10.03)...The staff ranks second in strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.73), opp. SLG (.359), and opp. OPS (.634).

- Since April 28, Nationals starters have allowed three earned runs or fewer in 26 of 27 starts.
- **Max Scherzer** (2nd, .180), **Tanner Roark** (4th, .198) and **Stephen Strasburg** (9th, .216) rank in the top 10 in the National League in opp. AVG...All three also rank in the top 10 in opp. OBP: Scherzer (2nd, .244), Roark (9th, .268) and Strasburg (10th, .276).
- **Gio Gonzalez** (2nd, 2.10), Scherzer (3rd, 2.13), Strasburg (13th, 3.13) and Roark (16th, 3.17) and each rank in the top 16 in the National League in ERA...Only the Atlanta Braves (3) have more than two players in the top 16.

### RELIEVERS ARE PEOPLE, TOO

Over the last seven games, **Henry Blanco's** bullpen has tossed 19.1 innings of relief, striking out 21 batters, walking just three and surrendering just two earned runs along the way (0.93 ERA)...Nationals relievers have inherited 12 runners during this stretch and have not allowed any to score.

- On the season, Washington relievers rank among National League 'pens in strikeout-to-walk ratio (2nd, 2.86), inherited runners scored percent (3rd, 20.3%), and strikeouts per 9.0 IP (3rd, 9.66).

### BIG CITY DOING BIG CITY THINGS

At 2.7 plate appearances/team game, **Matt Adams** falls just short of qualifying to be among league leaders (3.1 PA/game), but if he did qualify, he would rank in the National League in slugging percentage (2nd, .605) and OPS (3rd, .971).

### SUMMER OF SOTO

In seven games with the Nationals, **Juan Soto** is hitting .286 (8-for-25) with four of his eight hits being extra base hits (3 2B, HR)...He has recorded three RBI, four walks and five runs scored while striking out just five times.

- Soto has hit safely in three straight games, going 5-for-12 (.417) with three doubles and two runs scored.

### TURNING IT ON

**Trea Turner** is hitting .301 with seven doubles, five homers, 18 RBI, five stolen bases, 14 walks and 20 runs scored in 29 games since his five-hit game on April 25.

- He leads National League shortstops in on-base percentage (.361), runs scored (T1st, 30), walks (29), and stolen bases (14).
- According to FanGraphs.com, Turner leads all active National League shortstops in Wins Above Replacement at 1.7.

### June 8: Anthony's Academy All-Stars

Anthony's Academy All-Stars is a season-long program that gives scholar-athletes from the Nationals Youth Baseball Academy, where **Anthony Rendon** sits on the Board of Directors, the opportunity to enjoy a Nationals Baseball game. The group enjoys a behind-the-scenes look at team operations, a private meet and greet with Rendon as well as special batting practice viewing and tickets complete with NatsBucks.

## NATIONALS HISTORY

### May 29 (2-9 on this date)

2005 — **Livan Hernandez** outdueled **Chris Carpenter** as the Nationals edged St. Louis, 3-2, at Busch Stadium. **Brad Wilkerson** posted three hits and two RBI from the leadoff spot to spark a victory that began a memorable stretch in which the Nationals win 15 times in 17 games to assume sole possession of first place in the NL East.

### BALTIMORE ORIOLES

28 players, two managers and three coaches have suited up for both the Washington Nationals and Baltimore Orioles since 2005.

### THE SERIES

The Battle of the Beltways will feature three games in Baltimore and three games in Washington D.C... The series has favored the Orioles since 2005, but the Nationals have won four of the last six matchups between the two clubs.

## DAVE MARTINEZ

Nationals manager **Dave Martinez** was named the seventh field manager in Nationals history on Oct. 30, 2017. He joined the Nationals for what will be his 30th season in professional baseball. A 16-year Major League outfielder, Martinez has been a Major League coach for the last 10 seasons, serving as Cubs manager **Joe Maddon's** bench coach and right-hand man in Chicago (2015-17) as well as Tampa Bay (2008-14). This is the first Major League managerial assignment of Martinez's career.

## #58 - JEREMY HELLICKSON - RHP

A veteran of eight Major League seasons joined the Nationals on a Minor League deal with an invite to Major League Spring Training in mid-March... Was the 2011 American League Rookie of the Year for Tampa Bay...Took home the Gold Glove in 2012...Has made more than 27 starts in six of his eight Major League seasons...Pitched for Tampa Bay from 2010-14 while Nationals manager **Dave Martinez** served as the club's bench coach.

**AGAINST THE ORIOLES:** Faces former American League East foe - and former club - Baltimore Orioles for the 20th time (18th start)...His last start against the Orioles came on Sept. 7, 2014.

**LAST START:** Allowed one earned run for the second consecutive start on May 22 vs. San Diego...Allowed five hits, struck out five batters and issued just one walk in 5.1 innings of work...Did not factor in the decision as the Nationals walked-off the Padres.

### 2018 NOTES

- Has allowed just two earned runs in 22.2 innings spanning his last four starts (0.79 ERA)...He's fanned 22 batters, walked two, and opposing batters are just 13-for-77 (.169) against him.
- Among pitchers with at least seven starts, ranks seventh in MLB (4th in the NL) with a 2.13 ERA...Also ranks among National League pitchers (min. 7 GS) in opp. OBP (2nd, .241), WHIP (2nd, 0.89), home runs allowed (15th, 3), walks per 9.0 IP (3rd, 1.42), opp. OPS (7th, .582), strikeout-to-walk ratio (7th, 5.17), hits per 9.0 IP (8th, 6.63), and opp. AVG (9th, .207).
- Allowed just one earned run on three hits in 5.0 innings of work in his second start of the season against the Diamondbacks...He struck out five batters while walking just one.
- On May 8 at San Diego, he took a perfect game into the seventh inning to earn his first win of the season...A single by **Franchy Cordero** in the seventh inning broke up the bid...Tossed 6.2 scoreless innings, giving up just two hits and striking out a season-high eight batters.
- Tossed 5.2 scoreless innings on May 3 against Pittsburgh to help Washington complete the four-game sweep...Surrendered just three hits while striking out four...Did not issue a walk.
- In his third start for the Nationals allowed two earned runs on five hits in 5.1 innings of work as Washington fell to Arizona, 4-3, on April 28...Both earned runs came via the home run.
- Allowed three earned runs on three hits in 5.2 innings on April 22 at LAD...Did not factor in the decision as the Dodgers took the lead in the 7th inn.
- Made his Nationals debut on April 16 at NYM...Allowed two earned runs on seven hits in 4.2 innings in Washington's 8-6 victory.

### 2017 NOTES

- Began his second season in Philadelphia by going 6-5 with a 4.73 ERA in 20 starts before being acquired by Baltimore on July 28.
- While with Philadelphia, he went 3-1 with a 3.64 ERA (19 ER/47.0 IP) in eight starts against National League East opponents.
- His 47 walks on the season were the third fewest of his career (min. 15 starts).
- Did not issue a walk in eight of his 30 starts between the two clubs.

### 2016 NOTES

- Made his Phillies debut on Opening Day, becoming the first starting pitcher to make his Phillies debut on Opening Day since Roy Halladay in 2010.
- Ranked tied for third in the NL in shutouts (1), tied for fifth in GDP (21), tied for eighth in starts (32) and ranked ninth in walks per 9.0 IP (2.14)
- Set career highs in strikeouts (154) and starts and tied his career high in innings (189.0).
