NATIONALS NEWS

MOVING ON

The Washington Nationals fell, 4-3, to the Boston Red Sox in the opening game of this three-game series... **Anthony Rendon** (solo), **Daniel Murphy** (solo) and **Bryce Harper** (solo) provided the offense via the home run ball, while **Max Scherzer** battled through 6.0 innings of three-run ball.

- Murphy has hit safely in six of his last eight games, going 9-for-30 (.300) with a double, home run, five RBI, two walks and two runs scored.

#VoteRendon

Anthony Rendon clubbed his 12th home run of the season on Monday night against the Red Sox...He has homered in three of his last four games and has hit safely in 15 of his last 17 games dating to June 15...He is hitting .388 (26-for-67) with 10 doubles, six homers, 14 RBI, six walks and 14 runs scored over this span... His 16 extra-base hits are the most in Major League Baseball since June 15.

- Rendon entered play on June 6 hitting .253/.333/.448 and in 22 games since then, he is hitting .356 with 18 extra-base hits (12 2B, 6 HR)...He is now slashing .291/.356/.537 on the season.
- Rendon's 24 doubles rank tied for third in the National League and are tied for the most among NL third basemen with STL **Matt Carpenter**.
- Rendon is one of nine players in the National League with at least 10 home runs and 20 doubles this season, joining ATL **Ozzie Albies**, CHI **Javier Baez**, COL **Trevor Story**, STL **Matt Carpenter**, ATL **Freddie Freeman**, CIN **Scouter Gennett**, PIT **Gregory Polanco** and SFG **Brandon Crawford**.

HARPER'S HOMERS

Bryce Harper clubbed his 21st home run of the season on Monday night, a solo shot in the eighth inning... Harper's 21 home runs are tied with COL **Nolan Arenado** (21) for the most in the National League.

- Over his last 11 games, Harper is hitting .273 (9-for-33) with a .479 on-base percentage (14 walks/13 strikeouts) and a .636 slugging percentage (6 2B, 2 HR).

A HAND FOR THE 'PEN

Over the last three games, Washington's bullpen has pitched to a 1.32 ERA (2 ER/13.2 IP) while striking out 16 batters and issuing just three walks...Opposing batters have hit .152 (7-for-46) against them over this stretch...They have not allowed any of the five inherited runners to score.

- On the season, Washington's bullpen ranks in the National League in WHIP (2nd, 1.16), walks per 9.0 IP (2nd, 2.92), inherited runners scored percent (2nd, 23.8) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (2nd, 3.07).

MAX MAKING HISTORY

Max Scherzer collected his 1,000th strikeout as a member of the Washington Nationals on Monday night...He became the 11th player in Major League history to record at least 1,000 strikeouts with two different clubs... Here is the list he will join, according to the *Elias Sports Bureau*: **Jim Bunning** (DET/PHI), **Roger Clemens** (BOS/NYY), **Randy Johnson** (ARI/SEA), **Mark Langston** (ANA/SEA), **Greg Maddux** (CHI/ATL), **Mike Mussina** (BAL/NYY), **Nolan Ryan** (CAL/HOU), **CC Sabathia** (CLE/NYY), **Luis Tiant** (BOS/CLE) and **Cy Young** (BOS/CLE).

WELL-DESERVED HONOR

Juan Soto was named National League Rookie of the Month for June on Monday...He hit .317 (26-for-82) with six doubles, six homers, 15 RBI, 18 walks and 19 runs scored in 24 games during the month...He led National League rookies in batting average (.317), on-base percentage (.440), slugging percentage (.610), OPS (1.050), home runs (6) and walks (18). He ranked second in doubles (6), hits (26) and was third with 15 RBI for the month.

- On the season, Soto ranks among all Major League rookies (min. 150 PA), in batting average (.313), on-base percentage (.429), slugging percentage (.570) and OPS (.999).
- Among all National League players (min. 150 PA), Soto ranks in on-base percentage (1st, .429), OPS (2nd, .999), batting average (T5th, .313), and slugging percentage (6th, .570).
- Since May 15, he ranks among National League rookies in walks (1st, 26), home runs (1st, 8), RBI (T2nd, 21), runs (2nd, 25), doubles (3rd, 9), and hits (3rd, 40).

TREA'S TURNING IT ON

Over his last 13 games, **Trea Turner** is 18-for-52 (.383) with one double, one triple, two homers, four RBI, five walks, two stolen bases and 11 runs scored...He has a .414 on-base percentage and a .519 slugging percentage during this stretch.

FIVE FINGER DISCOUNTS

The Nationals lead the National League with 64 stolen bases...They rank behind the Boston Red Sox (65) and Chicago White Sox (65) for the most in Major League Baseball.

- Michael A. Taylor** leads MLB with 23 stolen bases, while **Trea Turner** (22) ranks second.

NATIONALS HISTORY

July 3 (7-5 on this date)

2016 — **Danny Espinosa** clubbed his 17th and 18th home runs, including his second grand slam in four days. He homered from both sides of the plate for the second time in the four-game series against the Cincinnati Reds (also 6/30/16). Over the course of the Nationals' four-game set with the Reds, Espinosa hit five home runs and drove in 15 RBI (a franchise record).

IN THE COMMUNITY

July 7: Neighborhood Day

Once again, the Nationals will dedicate a day to recognize and thank their neighbors in Ward 6. The team will provide hundreds of residents with tickets to area residents to watch the Nationals take on Miami. A variety of residents will also be recognized for their contributions to the community during the pregame ceremonies, including the ceremonial first pitch.

DAVE MARTINEZ

Nationals manager **Dave Martinez** was named the seventh field manager in Nationals history on Oct. 30, 2017. He joined the Nationals for what will be his 30th season in professional baseball. A 16-year Major League outfielder, Martinez has been a Major League coach for the last 10 seasons, serving as Cubs manager **Joe Maddon's** bench coach and right-hand man in Chicago (2015-17) as well as Tampa Bay (2008-14). This is the first Major League managerial assignment of Martinez's career.
