TUESDAY BLUES: The Padres fell 5-4 last night to the visiting San Francisco Giants, pushing their record vs. their Bay Area foe to 5-10 on the season and to 3-5 @ Petco Park this year...starter **Joey Lucchesi** worked 5.0 innings, allowing 3 runs on 7 hits with 8 strikeouts and 1 walk...**Freddy Galvis** went 4-for-5 with a pair of two-baggers, and **Franmil Reyes** went 2-for-5 with a HR and 3 RBI.

VS. SF: The Friars have now lost their last 6 games opposite SF, their longest losing streak against the Giants since their 9-game losing stretch from April 25-May 25, 2016.

AWEDNESDAY WISH: In partnership with Make-A-Wish San Diego, the Padres have agreed to terms on a one-day contract with five-year-old Levi Smith of San Diego...Levi was born with a congenital heart condition that resulted in him being placed in the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) and having a pacemaker inserted after surgery...his wish to be a Padre for a day will be granted tonight at Petco Park.

YOUNG YET POWERFUL: Padre rookies have combined to hit 51 HR this year, the most of any rookies on any National League club (trailing only NYY's 66 for most in the majors)...last season, SD rookies hit 64 HR, also leading the NL and 2nd to NYY's 66.

HIS NAME IS ERL: Robbie Erlin is in search for his first career win tonight against the Giants...the veteran southpaw looks to right the ship, having been saddled with the loss in a career-high-tying 4 consecutive outings since August 26...in 2018, Erlin has relied on 5 pitches: sinker (30.6%), four seamer (30%), curve (18.4%), changeup (16.9%) and slider (4.1%).

<u>VS. STRATTON</u>: Padres with notable numbers vs. **Chris Stratton**: **Travis Jankowski** (.333, 2-for-6), **Manuel Margot** (.333, 2-for-6 with 1 2b), **Wil Myers** (.286, 2-for-7 with 1 hr and 2 bb) and **Cory Spangenberg** (.375, 3-for-8 with 1 2b and 1 bb).

WHO'S THE MAN? PLOT TWIST, IT'S A FRAN: Franmil Reyes is riding a career-high-tying 10-game hitting streak since Sept. 7 @ CIN (.389, 14-for-36)...a hit in his next appearance will tie for the longest hitting streak by a Padre this year (Hunter Renfroe and Christian Villanueva both had 11-game streaks)...in his last 25 games since Aug. 21, his .385 clip leads the majors.

CAN'T STAY 'PENNED: In their last 9 games since Sept. 8 @ CIN, Friar relievers own a 2.41 ERA (9 er, 33.2 ip) and a Major League-leading .179 opponent average... their 0.95 WHIP in that time is 2nd in the NL behind MIL's 0.93.

TAKE YOUR BASE: In their last 5 games since the start of the homestand, the Padres have drawn 24 walks, the 4th most in the big leagues in that time...it's the longest streak this season by the Padres of drawing 4-or-more walks...the Giants have drawn just 6 bases on balls in that time, the fewest in the majors.

IN THE CLUTCH: The Padres have only had 2 games in the month of September in which they've logged more than 2 hits with RISP, hitting .168 w/RISP overall this month...in games this season in which they have at least 3 hits with RISP, the Padres own a 30-11 record and have won 9 of their last 10 such games.

<u>THIS DATE IN PADRE HISTORY</u>: On Sept. 19, 1995, 3B **Ken Caminiti** went 4-for-4 with 2 home runs and a franchise record-tying 8 RBI in a 15-4 win over Colorado @ San Diego Jack Murphy Stadium.

STARTING PITCHER NOTES

#41 LHP Robbie Erlin (3-7, 4.27)

HURLIN' ERLIN: 27-year-old Robbie Erlin is set to make his 11th start of the season and 36th of his career today against the Giants...it'll be his 38th overall appearance this season, having made 27 appearances out of the SD bullpen.

 Will be searching for his first career win tonight against the Giants...has made three relief appearances against San Francisco this season, pitching to a combined 4.76 ERA across 5.2 IP.

LAST TIME OUT: Saddled with the loss his last time out on 9/14 vs. TEX despite allowing just two runs (one earned) across 5.1 IP, with six strikeouts and no walks in the Padres' 4-0 defeat.

SNAP THAT STREAK: Has been saddled with the loss in a career-high-tying four consecutive outings since 8/26 (also: April 15-30, 2014).

 The last Padre to be tagged with the loss in five consecutive starts was Andrew Cashner in 2015 from April 24-May 16, despite posting a 3.55 ERA and 31 strikeouts against seven walks...Mat Latos (2010), Andy Benes (1993) and Dennis Rasmussen hold the franchise record with losses in nine consecutive starts.

FIRST AND FOREMOST: In the first inning of his 10 starts, he has posted a 0.90 ERA (1 ER, 10.0 IP) while limiting the opposition to a .125 average...in the second inning, opponents are hitting .440 and Erlin has posted a 12.19 ERA (14 ER, 10.1 IP).

HOME VS. AWAY: Has posted a 2.80 ERA (17 ER, 54.2 IP) with an opponent slash line of .242/.259/.359 at Petco Park...on the road, he has posted a 6.09 ERA and opponents are slashing .306/.319/.483.

BE SUPPORTIVE: Has received three runs of support or more in just two of his starts...among all ML pitchers who have made at least 10 starts, his 20 total runs of support are the fourth fewest.

ERLIN'S ARSENAL: This season, he's relied on five pitches: sinker (30.6%), four seamer (30%), curve (18.4%), changeup (16.9%) and slider (4.1%).

SPIN RATE: His curveball this season has an average spin rate of 2478 rpm (revolutions per minute), which is the highest spin rate of any pitch in a single season in his career.

FEW FREE PASSES: Has walked just 10 of the 396 batters he has faced this season...his 0.91 walks per nine innings this season is the third-best mark of any pitcher this year who has made at least 37 appearances.

RISPY BUSINESS: In his last eight starts since August 2, opposing bats have hit .378 vs. Robbie with RISP (14-for-37)...in his career, opponents are hitting .303 (60-for-198) with RISP.

GOOD 'PENMANSHIP: Prior to making eight consecutive starts since 8/2, he worked primarily out of the bullpen earlier this season, making 18 scoreless appearances out of his 27 relief outings and posting a 2.05 ERA (12 er, 52.2 ip) with 44 strikeouts against four walks...Erlin has made five separate long relief outings of at least 3.1 ip, including a career-high scoreless 5.2 ip of relief on May 28 vs. MIA.

GIVE ME A BREAK: In his career, Erlin has posted a 4.63 ERA (72 er, 140.0 ip) before the All-Star Break... he's posted a 4.18 mark (50 er, 107.2 ip) in his career post-All-Star Break...this season, he had a 3.83 ERA (23 ER, 54.0 IP) prior to the break, and he's fostered a 4.80 ERA since (24 er, 45.0 ip).

LONGEST TENURED PADRE: Erlin was originally acquired by the Pares along with RHP Joe Wieland from the Texas Ranges in exchange for RHP Mike Adams on July 31, 2011...he made his ML debut on April 30, 2013 at CHC...he is the longest tenured pitcher who has appeared for the Padres at the big league level.

LONG ROAD BACK: Began the 2016 season with El Paso (AAA) but did not pitch in a game before being called up by SD on April 8, 2016, making three starts before undergoing season-ending Tommy John surgery on his left elbow on May 17, 2016.

FRIDAY'S STARTER — #46 LHP Eric Lauer (5-7, 4.74) — @e_lauer10 💆

LONGING FOR SOME LAUER: LHP **Eric Lauer** is set to make his 22nd start and third of the season against the Dodgers... it will be his first career start at Dodger Stadium...is 2-0 with a 0.61 ERA (1 ER, 14.2 IP) vs. the Dodgers.

- Is one of just 20 rookies in Padres franchise history to make 20 starts in a single season...along with fellow lefty Joey Lucchesi, it marks just the fifth time the Padres have had two rookies make at least 20 starts in the same season.
- In his last 14 starts since 6/2, Lauer has posted a 3.53 ERA (28 ER, 71.1 IP)...allowing three earned runs or less in 12 of his 14 outings.
