**Triple Crown**

**Christian Yelich** (.324, 36hr, 109rbi) is looking to become the 11th player (13x) to win the Triple Crown....the last player to accomplish the feat was the Tigers' **Miguel Cabrera** (.330, 44hr, 139rbi) in 2012....the last National League player to do it was the Cardinals' **Joe Medwick** (.374, 31hr, 154rbi) in 1937....all players to win the Triple Crown, except Cabrera, who is still active, are in the Hall of Fame.

**AT HOME:** The Brewers are 50-30 at home, going 16-7-3 in series play, including this series....had a season-high 6-game home winning streak from 4/17-4/22 and a season-high 3-game home losing streak from 4/7-4/16....the team went 46-38 at home last season, going 14-9-4 in series play.

**ON THE ROAD:** The Brewers went 44-37 on the road, going 14-8-4 in series play....the team won its last 5 road series....had a season-high 5-game road winning streak from 4/30-5/11 and a season-high 6-game road losing streak from 7/11-7/15....the team went 40-38 on the road last season, going 13-11-2 in series play.

**MANAGER:** **Craig Counsell** is in his fourth season as manager of the Brewers (314-308) and third full season....he was named the 19th manager in franchise history on 5/4/15, replacing Ron Roenicke....bio is on p. 44 of the media guide.

**COACHES:** Hitting coach **Darnell Coles** (4th season), pitching coach **Derek Johnson** (3rd season), coach **Jason Lane** (3rd season), bench coach **Pat Murphy** (3rd season), third base coach **Ed Sedar** (12th season, 8th as 3B coach), first base/infield coach **Carlos Subero** (3rd season) and bullpen coach **Lee Tunnell** (6th season) all returned from the 2017 staff.

**LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE:** The Brewers have made 34 replay challenges, going 7-27....their last challenge (lost) came on 9/28 vs. Detroit as a Jeimer Candelario hit by pitch stood....went 17-27 in 44 replay challenges last season.

# TODAY'S STARTER: #47 - LHP GIO GONZALEZ (31gs, 9-11, 4.34)

**GONZALEZ AT A GLANCE:** Gio Gonzalez, 33, is making his 32nd start of the season.... Gonzalez last started on Tuesday at St. Louis and had no decision in the Brewers' 12-4 win (4ip, 3h, 3r, 3er, 2bb, 2k, 1hr)....he has gone 2-0 with a 2.66 ERA in 4 starts with the Brewers (20.1ip, 6er)....Gonzalez was acquired on 8/31 from Washington, along with international slot money, in exchange for 1B/C KJ Harrison and INF Gilbert Lara....his teams are 15-16 in his starts (4-0 with the Brewers)....he has made 11 quality starts....opponents are batting .259 (164-for-634, 17hr)....he has reached 30+ starts for the eighth time in his career....bio is available in the press box.

**LAST SEASON:** Gonzalez went 15-9 with a 2.96 ERA in 32 starts with Washington....he made 30+ starts for the seventh time....he made 22 quality starts, which tied Max Scherzer for the National League lead....he also ranked among the NL leaders in innings (6th, 201.0) and wins (T6th, 15)....his 79 walks led the National League....the team went 18-14 in his starts....opponents batted .216 (158-for-731, 21hr), which ranked fifth in the National League.

**CAREER:** Is 126-97 with a 3.70 ERA in 312 games / 306 starts (1809ip, 744er)....is in his 11th Major League season....has pitched for Oakland (2008-11), Washington (2012-18) and Milwaukee (2018)....Gonzalez is a two-time All-Star (2011 and 2012)....he pitched in the postseason in 2012, 2014, 2016 and 2017.

**CAREER AT MILLER PARK:** Has gone 3-3 with a 4.81 ERA in 8 starts (43ip, 23er), including 2-1 with a 3.27 ERA in 4 starts this season (22ip, 8er).

**CAREER ON THE ROAD:** Has gone 62-55 with a 4.02 ERA in 163 games / 158 starts (936.2ip, 418r)....is 3-7 with a 4.83 ERA in 16 starts this season (87.2ip, 47er).

**CAREER vs. TIGERS:** Is 1-4 with a 7.85 ERA in 6 starts (28.2ip, 25er)....has not faced Detroit since 2013.

**CAREER AT THE PLATE:** Is a .093 hitter (36-for-384) with 3 HR....has 8 walks and 173 strikeouts....homed in 2012, 2013 and 2014....**THIS SEASON:** Is batting .080 (4-for-50) with 1 RBI....has 1 walk and 31 strikeouts....has 3 sacrifice bunts.
