SAN DIEGO NOTES

- **Eric Lauer recorded his major league-leading 10th pickoff of the season**, the most by a rookie in single season since OAK's Greg Smith had 16 pickoffs in 2008...Jerry Garvin holds the all-time pickoff record with 23 in 1977 while with TOR (was also his rookie season).
 - In seven career starts against NL West opponents, is 3-1 with a 3.49 ERA, compared to his 6.75 ERA across 11 starts in all other divisions.
- **Austin Hedges** is riding a six-game on-base streak with a .409 OBP and three walks...has gone 11-for-29 (.379) with two doubles, two homers and five RBI at home in the month of July.
 - Logged his eighth multi-hit game of the season.
- **Hunter Renfro** blasted his eighth home run of the season after going 0-for-12 over his previous four games...is batting .280 (7-for-25) with three home runs and a .680 SLG this season vs. SF.
- **Eric Hosmer** is riding a seven-game hitting streak (9-for-26, .346), tying his longest streak as a Padre (also: May 11-18)...swiped his fifth stolen base of the season tonight.
- **Manuel Margot** snapped his career-long 10-game hitting streak, one game shy of tying Christian Villanueva's 11-game spree (April 13-28) as the longest by a Padre this season.

SAN FRANCISCO NOTES

- **Derek Holland** has pitched to a 2-2 record with a 2.68 ERA (13 ER, 43.2 IP) over his last eight games as a starter and has allowed three runs (earned) or fewer in 16 of his 20 games started this season ...is 1-1 in four career starts against SD.
- **Chase d'Arnaud** belted his third homer of the year...is 10-for-25 (.400) against lefties this season and just 1-for-14 (.071) off right-handers.
- **Buster Posey** extended his hitting streak to four games, the longest active streak on the team...is hitting .333 (19-for-57) over his last 13 games with three doubles and nine RBI.
 - Is batting .299 (69-for-231) in 59 career games at Petco Park.
- **Gorkys Hernandez** has hit home runs in back-to-back games for the second time this season (also: June 24 vs. SD, June 26 vs. COL)...is one home run shy of tying Brandon Crawford for the team lead.
- **Andrew McCutchen** recorded his seventh three-hit game and first since July 8 vs. STL.
