FISH BITES

The Marlins continue a six-game homestand with the second of three against the St. Louis Cardinals tonight at 7:10 p.m. RHP **Pablo López**, making his seventh career, is facing the Cardinals for the first time in his young career. St. Louis is countering with RHP Miles Mikolas, who in four career appearances (two starts) against Miami has gone 1-0 with a 2.70 ERA (13.1 ip/4 er); in his only start against Miami this season, allowed one unearned run and three hits with an intentional walk and five strikeouts on June 7 at Busch Stadium. The current homestand will continue following Thursday's off-day with a three-game set against the New York Mets. Miami just returned from a six-game road swing to Atlanta (0-2) and Philadelphia (0-4). The final game of the Atlanta series was rained out and will be made up as part of a split doubleheader on August 13. Broadcast note, FOX Sports Florida will carry both games of the doubleheader. Miami plays 30 of their remaining 48 games (63%) against division foes.

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP

Miami snapped a six-game losing streak with a 2-1 win over the visiting St. Louis Cardinals. **Wei-Yin Chen** dominated once again at home, allowing just one hit and two walks, with four strikeouts, over 5.2 innings. **Derek Dietrich** led off the bottom of the first with a double and was brought home on a **Brian Anderson** single to give the Marlins an early 1-0 lead. **Starlin Castro** extended the lead with two outs in the fourth, connecting for his ninth homer of the season.

CLOSE CALLS

The Marlins are now 15-12 in one-run games this season, having won their last six such games and 10 of their last 13.

IN THIS CASE, IT'S HOW YOU START

With **Wei-Yin Chen**'s scoreless start last night, Marlins starting pitchers have tossed three consecutive scoreless outings at home for the sixth time in Club history and first since July 25-27, 2016. They also did so from June 30-July 8, 2013; August 17-19, 2005; June 15-17, 2004; and June 15-18, 2002. **Pablo López** is looking to extend that streak to four games, which would be the most in Club history.

GOOD TO BE HOME

Since June 8, Miami has gone 17-13 over its last 30 games at Marlins Park. That is a drastic improvement over a 10-18 record over the first 28 games at home. The Marlins have posted a 3.51 ERA (290.0 ip/113 er) over the current stretch, which is the third-best among National League teams behind the Dodgers (3.38) and Milwaukee (3.42). The staff has limited opponents to a .240 average against, which ranks sixth. On offense over that same span, **Brian Anderson** (35) and **Starlin Castro** (35) are tied with Charlie Blackmon for second in hits at home, behind David Peralta (39).

STEPPING UP

The two rookie starters in Miami's rotation, **Pablo López** and **Trevor Richards**, who will start for Miami over the next two games, have combined to go 2-2 with a 1.74 ERA (41.1 ip/8 er), 30 hits allowed, 10 walks and 39 strikeouts over their last seven combined starts. López has allowed six earned over his last three starting assignments (17.2 ip), while Richards has surrendered just two runs over his last four starts spanning 23.2 innings (0.76 ERA).

GIVE ME A SECOND

Starlin Castro has recorded 127 hits in 111 games played at second base this season to lead all Major League second basemen. He ranks second in hits (Jose Altuve-128), tied for the lead in multi-hit games (37), ranks fourth in runs scored (64), and tied for fourth in doubles (23).

HIT TO THE NINES

With three more hits this season, **Starlin Castro** will reach the 130 hit mark for the ninth time in his Major League career. He would join a list of five others who debuted in the last 20 years to record 130+ hits in each of his first nine Major League seasons. See list at right provided by *Stats LLC*.

HOME COOKING

As a team, Miami ranks fifth in the National League in total hits at home with 484, trailing Pittsburgh (529), the Cubs (499), Colorado (492), and San Francisco (487). Individually, **Starlin Castro** (67) and **Brian Anderson** (64) rank third and tied-fourth in the NL, behind Nolan Arenado (69) and David Peralta (68). Anderson is tied with Bryce Harper for fifth in runs scored with 39, and **Justin Bour** is tied for 11th in the NL with 11 home runs.

PROVING HIS WORTH

In his final game before the break, **Brian Anderson** recorded his sixth three-hit game of the season to run his season hit total to 109. His hit total prior to the break tied Rocco Baldelli for the second-most by a Major League rookie since 2003, behind only Hideki Matsui (114 in 2003). He is the only Marlins rookie in franchise history to record 100+ hits prior to the break.

- Anderson recorded 101 hits over his first 92 games of the season, becoming the 142nd rookie since 1958 to record 100+ hits in 92-or-fewer games. Of those, 34 went on to win Rookie of the Year honors, including most recently Aaron Judge (2017), Corey Seager (2016), Carlos Correa (2015), José Abreu (2014), Mike Trout (2012) and Buster Posey (2010). - *Stats LLC*
- He leads all MLB rookies in games (113), at-bats (438), hits (126), multi-hit games (37), three+-hit games (8), average with RISP (.406), runs (63), on-base percentage (.368), and RBI (53); ranks second in doubles (25), and slugging (.420); ranks third in average (.288) and walks (45); is tied for third in triples (3); and tied for 10th in HR (9).
- He is on pace for 178 hits this season, which would rank as the second-most by a National League rookie since 2010, behind Corey Seager's 193 in 2016, and would rank as the fifth-most by an NL rookie since 2000. He is also on pace to score 89 runs, which would rank as the 11th-most by a rookie since 2000.

The Marlins, in partnership with AutoNation, America's largest automotive retailer, will be awarding a prize of a 24-month car lease to a select fan tonight, the 18th of 25 dates this season where a fan will drive off with a new car. THIS DAY IN MARLINS HISTORY

AUGUST 7

The Marlins defeated the St. Louis Cardinals, 5-4, in extra innings in 2010. Hanley Ramirez drove in the game-winning run with his 10th inning double. Logan Morrison was 1x4 with an RBI single and began his on-base streak of 42 games, a Marlins rookie record. In 2016, Ichiro Suzuki reached 3,000 career MLB hits with a seventh-inning triple in a 10-7 victory at Colorado. He was the 30th player to record 3,000 hits and the second to reach the milestone with a triple (also, Paul Molitor). Ichiro was also the second player to reach 3,000 hits in his first 16 MLB seasons, along with Pete Rose (3,164).
