FISH BITES

The Marlins continue a quick four-game road swing to the nation's capital to take on the Washington Nationals in game two tonight at 7:05 p.m. RHP **Dan Straily**, who is making his 13th start of the season, has gone 0-1 with a 4.03 ERA (29.0 ip/13 er) in five career starts against the Nationals. Washington is countering with LHP Gio Gonzalez, who in 16 career starts against the Marlins has gone 10-3 with a 1.85 ERA (102.1 ip/21 er). Miami recently completed a 10-game homestand against Arizona (1-3), the Mets (2-1) and Tampa Bay (2-1). Upon conclusion of this series, Miami will return home to finish out the pre-break schedule with a six-game homestand against Milwaukee and Philadelphia.

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP

Miami jumped out to a 9-0 lead only to see it evaporate, equalling the largest lead lost in franchise history, and fell to the Washington Nationals, 14-12. After scoring the first run on an error in the first frame, Miami pushed six runs across the plate in the second, highlighted by **Martin Prado's** first home run of the season, a three-run shot off the left field foul pole. In the fourth, **Justin Bour** extended the Marlins lead to 9-0 with a two-run homer to center field, his 14th of the season. Washington went on to score 14 unanswered runs; one in the fourth, four in the fifth, five in the sixth, and four in the seventh. Down 14-9 in the eighth, **Brian Anderson** cut the deficit to just two with a three-run homer to center. **Pablo López**, making his second career start, was touched for five runs on five hits with two walks and three strikeouts over 5.0 innings. **Adam Conley** suffered his first loss of the season, allowing five runs on two hits and four walks over 0.2 inning.

TODAY'S TRANSACTIONS

The Marlins today reinstated OF **Garrett Cooper** from the 60-day disabled list and optioned LHP **Dillon Peters** to Triple-A New Orleans. In 11 rehab games between Single-A Jupiter and Triple-A New Orleans, Cooper posted a .333 average (11x33) with a double, one home run and five RBI.

VS. THE NATIONALS

This is just the second meeting of the season between the two rivals, and the first at Nationals Park. The Marlins dropped the 2017 series against the Nationals, 6-13, which included an eight-game losing streak to conclude the series. Miami was swept in the first series of the season, a three-game set at Marlins Park from May 25-27, and have dropped 12 straight to the Nationals. The 12-game slide is the longest against the Nationals in Club history, and is tied for the longest to any opponent in Club history: Milwaukee from April 3, 1998-May 5, 1999. Miami is 54-66 against the Nationals in DC, and 122-120 overall, since 2005.

THE BIG ONE THAT GOT AWAY

Last night's nine run lead that was lost tied a franchise record, also done on July 4, 2008 at Colorado. In that game, Miami was up 13-4 after the top of the fourth inning only to lose the game 18-17. The last team to lose a nine-plus run lead was the San Diego Padres, who were up 12-2 on the Seattle Mariners after five innings on June 2, 2016. The Padres eventually lost, 16-13. The last team to lose after taking a 9-0 lead was the Nationals on July 20, 2012. In that game, they held a 9-0 lead over the Braves after five innings only to fall, 11-10, in 11 innings. - *Stats LLC*

UMM...WHAT'S IT CALLED AGAIN?

Miami got off to a slow start this season, going 5-17 over their first 22 games. However, they have improved dramatically over their last 67, posting a 31-36 record, including a 16-17 mark since June 1. All of this while playing the fifth toughest schedule in the Majors to date, second toughest among National League teams, with their opponents combining on a .511 winning percentage. The remainder of the schedule will see Miami play the eighth-hardest schedule in the Majors, fourth most difficult in the NL (.518).

12 FOR 11

J.T. Realmuto went 2x4 last night to extend his current hitting streak to 12 games, the longest active streak in the Majors. He has hit .340 (18x55) with seven doubles, two home runs and 14 RBI over the streak. The 12-game streak equals a career best done earlier this season from April 20-May 4. The 12-game hitting streak equals the longest by a Marlins catcher in Franchise history, and he now owns the three longest hitting streaks by a Marlins catcher. - *Stats LLC*

CASTRO-LLING

With two hits last night, **Starlin Castro** marked his 28th multi-hit game of the season, tied for sixth among National League hitters with teammate **Brian Anderson** and Eric Hosmer. He has hit safely in 10 of his last 11 games, batting .500 (21x42) over that span. In that time he has raised his average from .267 to a current .296. He is one of just five National League players with 100+ hits this season, joining Nick Markakis (108), Scooter Gennett (105), Ozzie Albies (104), and Freeman (101).

BOOK IT

J.T. Realmuto hit his 11th home run of the season Monday night; Miami is 9-0 when he homers (two multi-homer games) this year. According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, that is tied for the longest winning streak to open a season when an individual homers in Club history. The Marlins also won the first nine games when Josh Willingham homered in 2007, and when Mike Lowell went deep in 2004.

HE'S DOING ONE STECK OF A JOB

Drew Steckenrider entered Tuesday night's game and provided a scoreless seventh inning, allowing just one hit while striking out two. He is on a career-best 17.2 inning scoreless streak over his last 20 appearances, a run that has seen him become the first pitcher in Club history to make 14-or-more appearances in a calendar month (June) without allowing a run; he last allowed a run (2) on May 20 at Atlanta. His scoreless streak is now the longest active streak in the Majors, and is the second-longest by a Marlins reliever this season (Barraclough 20.2).

WHAT A RELIEF

Since May 28, Miami's bullpen has limited opponents to the second-best average against among National League bullpens with a .219 average, behind only the Nationals (.219). The 'pen leads the NL in innings pitched (154.2) and ranks fifth in ERA at 3.61 (154.2 ip/62 er), behind Arizona (2.51), the Giants (3.13), the Nationals (3.34), and the Dodgers (3.50).

A WORLD OF DIFFERENCE

Rosters for the 2018 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game, which will be played at 4:00 p.m. (ET) on Sunday, July 15th at Nationals Park in Washington, DC, were announced by Major League Baseball today and Marlins' prospect **Jorge Guzman** was named to the World Team. Guzman, acquired from the New York Yankees this offseason, has made 13 starts for Jupiter this season, going 0-6 with a 3.05 ERA (59.0 ip/20 er) and 56 strikeouts.

JULY 6

Florida fell to the Rockies, 8-3, in Colorado in **1993**. Henry Cotto was 3x5 out of the leadoff spot for the Marlins and he led off the game with a home run. It was Cotto's first homer as a Marlin. In **2016**, Giancarlo Stanton hit a solo home run in each of his first two at-bats of a 4-2 Marlins loss at the Mets, giving him home runs in four consecutive at-bats to tie a Major League record and become the first Marlins player to accomplish that feat.

- Dan Straily will make his 13th start of the season in game two of this four-game road trip tonight.
- This will be his first start of the year against Washington. Faced Nats three times in 2017, going 0-1, 4.80 (15.0 ip/8 er). Two of those outings were here in DC, going 0-1, 7.00 (9.0/7).
- Has 2-1 record and 3.10 ERA (29.0/10) in five starts against NL East opponents this season, with 24 strikeouts and 17 walks. Also, holding division rivals to a .202 average (21x104).
- Has a 3.81 ERA (28.1/12) in six road starts, but is just 1-3, while the team is 3-3.
- Snapped a personal three-game losing streak, and a 0-5 skid by the team in his starts, on June 25 vs. Arizona. Picked up win after tossing 6.1 innings (most since 7.0 on May 18 at ATL) and allowing three runs on four hits and a hit batter, with six strikeouts.
- Miami won his first five starts this season; he went 2-0, 3.12 (26.0/9) in that time, with a .204 (19x93) average against. Since then, Marlins have lost six of his seven outings, and he is 1-4, 5.94 (33.1/22) over that span, with a .264 (34x129) average against.
- Is striking out 7.89 batters per 9.0 innings this season, down from 8.42 in 2017. Is also walking 4.40 batters per 9.0 this year, up from 2.97 and 3.43 the last two years, respectively. Has fourth-highest BB/9.0 rate of NL starters this season (min. 12 GS).
- He made four Spring Training starts, going 1-0 with a 1.29 ERA (14.0 ip/2 er), before being shut down with right forearm inflammation on March 20.
- Made two rehab appearances at Single-A Jupiter, going 1-1 with 8.22 ERA (7.2/7). Allowed seven runs (six earned) and five hits over 2.2 innings in first start, April 13 at Daytona. Limited Lakeland to one run and six hits over 5.0 frames on April 18. Transferred to Double-A Jacksonville and made 5.1-inning start on April 24 at Tennessee, allowing four runs (three earned) on six hits with a walk and six strikeouts.
- Last season, set career highs in starts (33) and strikeouts (170), leading the starting rotation in starts, strikeouts, and innings pitched (181.2).
- He went 5-3 with a 3.57 ERA (90.2 ip/36 er) in 17 starts at home, and 5-6, 4.95 (91.0/50) in 16 starts on the road.
- Was one of just seven NL starters to make 17-plus starts at home, tied with four others for the second-highest total, behind R.A. Dickey, Zack Greinke, and Jon Lester (18 each). Among that group, only Greinke (2.87) and Patrick Corbin (3.15) had a lower home ERA.
- Struck out nine batters on September 24 at Arizona, setting a new single-season career high. He finished the game with 167 strikeouts, surpassing his previous high of 162, set in 2016 with Cincinnati.
- Had one of the best starts of his career on July 7 at San Francisco. He set a career high with 8.1 innings pitched in picking up his seventh victory of the season. Allowed just four hits, did not walk a batter, and struck out four. He allowed just one run, a solo home run to Denard Span, the final batter he faced. From the second out of the second inning until there were two outs in the seventh, he set a new career high by retiring 16 consecutive batters, according to *Stats LLC*. It surpassed his previous high of 14, which he set over his first two starts of 2017 (April 22-29).
- In his start on July 19 vs. Philadelphia, he issued three walks. It snapped a streak of nine consecutive starts with one or zero walks, which tied Justin Nicolino (2016) for the second-longest such streak within one season in Club history, trailing Ricky Nolasco, who did so in his final 12 starts of 2008 (overall streak reached 13).
