THE TWINS: After completing their six-game homestand with a record of 2-4 (1-2 vs. Cincinnati and 1-2 vs. Toronto), the Twins began their 10-game, 11-day roadtrip winning two of their first three against Chicago...they will play the fourth and final game of their series vs. Chicago today...after today's finale, they will travel to St. Louis for two games on Monday and Tuesday, followed by an off-day in Anaheim Wednesday and four vs. the Angels Thursday-Sunday...the Twins have gone 4-12 since April 20...the Twins have now won back-to-back games for the first time since winning three straight April 10-12.

GETTING BACK-TO-BACK: The Twins beat the White Sox last night by a score of 8-4, winning for the third time in their last four games, and their first back-to-back wins since April 11-12... Lance Lynn (1-3) won his first game as a member of the Twins, allowing two runs on eight hits in 6.0 innings, his first quality start of 2018...Eddie Rosario went 4-for-5 with a home run and five RBI, the Twins first four-plus hit-game since Rosario had four hits September 26, 2017, and the most RBI by any Twin in 2018.

TWINS AND SOX: The Twins and White Sox are playing the fifth of 19 games this season...the Twins have won six of their last seven over the Sox, 12 of their last 17, and 17 of their last 25.
☞ Brian Dozier is hitting .331 (44-for-133) with 11 doubles, 12 home runs, 24 RBI and a .403 on-base percentage in his last 33 games vs. the White Sox.
☞ The Twins have gone 10-5 in their last 15 at Guaranteed Rate Field...in fact, the Twins are 15-8 in their last 23 games overall against the Sox since the start of 2017, their most wins against a single opponent in that span.

MAUER AND CHICAGO: Joe Mauer is hitting .300 (227-for-757) with 52 doubles, 18 home runs, 103 RBI, 105 walks, 119 runs scored and a .387 on-base percentage in 203 career games against the Sox...below are the active leaders vs. the Sox:

RED HOT ROSIE: Eddie Rosario collected four hits last night, the first four-hit game by a Twin in 2018...Rosario is batting .385 (15-for-39) with five doubles, four home runs and 12 RBI in his last nine games...Rosario has a 1.221 OPS in those nine since April 27, ninth best in the majors and fourth best in the American League.

☞ Rosario has 101 multi-hit games since 2015, the third most among all Twins (Dozier - 131, Mauer - 117).
☞ His home run last night was just his seventh career homer off a left-handed pitcher and the first since August 30, 2017 (71 at-bats between homers vs. LHPs).
☞ Rosario has nine extra-base hits in his last nine games, second to only Eduardo Escobar (10) in the majors...12 RBI in those nine are third most in the majors.

'PEN PALS: The Twins bullpen has allowed three runs on nine hits, one walk and 17 strikeouts in their last four games, spanning 12.2 innings...Zach Duke enters today with an active scoreless streak of 5.2...in the Twins 11 wins this season the bullpen has posted a 1.45 ERA (43.1 IP, 7 ER) with opponents hitting .209 (33-for-158) with five home runs.

TWINS WEEKLY MINOR LEAGUE HONORS: The Twins have named Single-A Cedar Rapids outfielder **Alex Kirilloff** ML Player of the Week and Single-A Cedar Rapids right-handed pitcher **Edwar Colina** and left-handed pitcher **Jovani Moran** Co-ML Pitchers of the Week... Kirilloff hit .333 (8-for-24) helping lead the Kernels to a 4-1 record on the week...Colina and Moran overcame six walks and two errors, combining for the Kernels' first no-hitter in five years as Cedar Rapids beat South Bend, 10-0, on Tuesday at Perfect Game Field at Veterans Memorial Stadium...Colina tossed 6.0 innings with five walks and two strikeouts while Moran finished the game with 3.0 innings.

LAST START: Gibson's last outing was against Toronto on May 1, a contest the Twins lost 7-4... Gibson threw 5.0 innings, allowing two runs on five hits and two walks with six strikeouts...he left the game in a 2-2 tie and did not factor into the decision, his fourth no decision in six starts... remains 3-1 and improved his ERA to 4.79 (41.1 IP, 22 ER) in seven career starts against Toronto.

AGAINST THE WHITE SOX: Gibson has made 10 career starts against the White Sox and is 6-2 with a 2.26 ERA (67.2 IP, 17 ER) with 12 walks and 57 strikeouts...last start against the White Sox came August 22, 2017, allowed one run on seven hits and one walk with eight strikeouts over 7.0 innings to earn the win...last loss to the White Sox was September 2, 2016, gave up five runs on nine hits and one walk with six strikeouts over 5.2 innings...lowest career ERA against an AL Central opponent.

LEADING THE WAY: Through five starts, Gibson is leading the Twins starters with at least four starts in ERA (3.38), has allowed the fewest earned runs (12) and has the second lowest opponent batting average (.212)...Gibson is second among all Twins pitchers in strikeouts (36) and is third in innings pitched (32.0).

GIBBY ON TARGET: Dating back to last season, Gibson has a three-game winning streak at Target Field (4 no-decisions since that 3-game win-streak, posting a 4.15 ERA (30.1 IP, 14 ER) in that span...his last loss at home coming August 17 vs. Cleveland, allowing three runs on seven hits in 4.0 innings pitched.

PICKING UP WHERE HE LEFT OFF: After a rough first half of 2017, Gibson finished the second half of the season 7-3, 3.76 ERA (76.2 IP, 32 ER) with 22 walks and 70 strikeouts...since July 14, 2017, Gibson is 8-4, 3.64 ERA (108.2 IP, 44 ER) with 38 walks and 106 strikeouts and is holding opponents to a .248 average.

2017 RECAP:

- Was the Twins third starter to begin the season.
- Optioned to Triple-A after six starts, going 0-4 and allowing 24 earned runs over 26.1 innings on 39 hits.
- In return to Twins, recorded his first win on May 22 against Baltimore.
- Won his final six decisions, allowing 11 runs over 31.2 innings in the six wins, notching the longest win streak of his career.
- Made his 100th career start on April 12 at Detroit...the first pitcher to make 100 starts for the Twins since Francisco Liriano from 2005-11...was the 25th pitcher in Twins history to make 100-plus starts for the club.

NO HITS, NO PROBLEM: In Gibson's 2018 debut, he didn't allow a hit in 6.0 innings of work against Baltimore on March 31...his 6.0 hitless innings is his longest outing in his career without allowing a hit...Gibson's previous career-low in hits allowed in a game was four, which has happened four times, most recently on July 22, 2016 at Boston.

KILLING TWO BIRDS WITH ONE STONE: Gibson induced 26 double plays in 2017, ranking third in the AL...his 1.48 GIDP/9 ranked fourth in baseball among pitchers who threw more than 150 innings in 2017...since 2014, Gibson is second in GIDP in the majors with 99 (Dallas Keuchel - 100) and is second in GIDP/9 with 1.25 (Martin Perez - 1.61).

SWING AND A MISS: Thus far in 2018, Gibson has recorded 36 strikeouts through six starts and owns a strikeouts rate of 26.3 percent and a swing-and-miss rate of 29.7 percent, both significantly higher marks than he has ever put up in any previous year...his career strikeouts rate is 16.4 percent while his career swing-and-miss rate is 22.5 percent.

KEEP THE K'S COMING: Gibson has improved his strikeouts-per-9.0 innings rate nearly every year in his career, setting a career-high in 2017 with 6.89 K/9...through six starts in 2018, Gibson is striking out 10.13 batters-per-9.0 innings, 11th in the AL.

ROAD RUNNER: Over his career, Gibson has had success on the road, posting a 25-23 record across 66 starts away from Target Field as compared to his 20-26 record at home...since 2016, Gibson has posted a 12-7 record on the road, in contrast to his 7-15 record at home...his road ERA in that span is 4.33 as compared to 5.46...in 2018, Gibson is tied for 13th in the AL in road ERA with 1.96, and has held opponents scoreless in two of his three road starts this year.

HOT START: Through the end of April, Gibson posted a 3.33 ERA (27.0 IP, 10 ER), the best ERA through the month of April in his career...previously, Gibson's best ERA to start the season was 4.34 in 2014 and last year his ERA through the first month was 8.06, the highest of his career... Gibson also struck out 30 batters through April, blowing away his previous career high through the month of April, which was set last year (13 K).

- Given 2015 Joseph W. Haynes Award for Twins Pitcher of the Year voted on by the Twin Cities Chapter of the BBWAA.
- His 2.85 ERA pre-ASG in 2015 was the fourth-lowest for a Twins starter since 1992 with a minimum of 80.0 IP (Liriano - 1.83 in 2006, Santana - 2.75 in 2007, Radke - 2.77 in 1998).
- In 2014, his first full season in the majors, became one of three pitchers in Twins history to win each of their first three games while posting a sub-1.00 ERA.
- Earned the win in his MLB debut 6/29/13 vs. KC allowing three runs on eight hits in 6.0 innings.
- Named the Twins Minor League Player of the Week for May 12, 2013 after tossing a CG SHO.
- Named an Arizona Fall League Rising star in 2012 and the AFL Player of the Week, 10/23/12.
- Selected to the 2011 Futures Game where he tossed 1.1 inning, allowing two hits.
- Named to the 2010 Eastern League Mid-Season All-Star Team.
- Named the Florida State League Pitcher of the Week, May 3, 2010.
- Selected in the first round (22nd overall) by the Twins in the 2009 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Missouri as a senior...major was communications.
- Originally selected by Philadelphia in the 36th round of the 2006 First-Year Player Draft out of Greenfield Central High School in Greenfield, IN.
- Named to the All-Big 12 honorable mention team in 2007 and 2008 and All-Big 12 First-Team in 2009 as the Tigers' Friday night starter.
