### BALTIMORE ORIOLES (19-45) vs. BOSTON RED SOX (44-22)

### RHP Dylan Bundy (4-7, 4.04) vs. RHP Steven Wright (2-0, 1.57)

**WHAT A LONG, STRANGE TRIP IT'S BEEN:** The Orioles return home tonight for a six-game, seven-day homestand with games against Boston (three games) and Miami (three games)...The Orioles completed a six-game road trip that included stops at New York-NL (2-0) and Toronto (0-4)...The two-game series sweep of the Mets marked the O's first series sweep since August 28-30, 2017 vs. Seattle and first series sweep on the road since August 25-27, 2017 at Boston...The sweep also marked the second road series win of the season for the Orioles; both have come in New York...The Orioles also won three-of-four against the Yankees from April 5-8 at Yankee Stadium.

**SCORING CHANGE:** Major League Baseball and the official scorer have made a scoring change to the Orioles game on June 9 at Toronto...In the top of the ninth inning, **SS Manny Machado** advanced to second base on what was originally scored defensive indifference... This has been changed to a stolen base for Machado.

**DOWN ON THE FARM:** Class A-Advanced Frederick **OF Ryan McKenna** leads the Carolina League in hitting (.367), hits (84), OBP (.455), and runs (50)...His 84 hits are the second-most in all of minor league baseball, only trailing Triple-A Salt Lake's **INF David Fletcher** (88)... The Keys **RHP Michael Baumann** is tied for the second-most wins in minor league baseball with eight, and his 1.60 ERA (11 ER/62.0 IP) ranks fourth-lowest among minor leaguers...He's gone 3-0 with a 1.88 ERA (5 ER/24.0 IP) in four starts with Frederick, and 8-0 with a 1.60 ERA (11 ER/62.0 IP) overall...Class-A Delmarva **INF Seamus Curran** leads the Orioles minor leagues with 11 home runs and 38 RBI, he was one of three ShoreBirds to be named to the South Atlantic All-Star team, joined by **INF Trevor Craport** and **OF Zach Jarrett**...**INF Kirvin Moesquit**'s 29 stolen bases are second-most in the minor leagues and they lead the SAL.

**YOU'RE LOOKING AT THE MAN-NY:** **SS Manny Machado** has hit safely in 49-of-64 games played this season...He currently ranks among league leaders in many offensive categories (see chart at right)...Additionally, his .380 on-base percentage ranks eighth in the AL and 18<sup>th</sup> in the majors...His .591 slugging percentage ranks fifth in the majors...His 21 multi-hit games are tied for 12<sup>th</sup> in the AL and are tied for 20<sup>th</sup> in the majors...His 146 total bases rank fourth in the majors...His nine intentional walks rank first in the majors.

**QUALITY OVER QUANTITY:** **RHP Kevin Gausman** tossed the Orioles 31<sup>st</sup> Quality Start of the season on Saturday...The O's 31 Quality Starts this season are tied for fifth in the AL and are tied for seventh in the majors...**RHP Dylan Bundy** is tied for 12<sup>th</sup> in the AL with eight Quality Starts...Orioles starters have received 138 runs of support this season, which ranks fewest in the majors...Overall, Orioles pitchers have received 229 runs of support this season, which is fewest in the AL and ranks second-fewest in the majors (Miami Marlins, 224).

**A WYNNING STRATEGY:** On Tuesday night at Citi Field in New York, **C Austin Wynns** notched a single to left field in the first at-bat of his first Major League game...Wynns was recalled from Triple-A Norfolk, where he hit .257 (28-for-109) in 32 games this season with four doubles, four home runs, and 16 RBI...According to STATS, LLC., Wynns became the 77<sup>th</sup> Orioles player (since 1954) to collect a hit in his Major League debut and the first since **Anthony Santander** on August 18, 2017 vs. Los Angeles-AL...He became the first to do so in his first plate appearance since **Hyun Soo Kim** on April 10, 2016 vs. Tampa Bay...Wynns is the fifth Oriole to make his Major League debut this season, joining **LHP Nestor Cortes, Jr.**, **RHP Pedro Araujo**, **INF Engelb Vielma**, and **RHP David Hess**.

**OUT OF LEFT FIELD:** **LF Trey Mancini** recorded his team-leading seventh outfield assist on June 1 against the Yankees when he threw out **Gleyber Torres** at third base...Mancini's seven outfield assists are tied for the Major League lead (with **Lorenzo Cain** and **Kole Calhoun**)...Mancini notched two outfield assists in the bottom of the fifth inning on May 21 at Chicago-AL...According to the Elias Sports Bureau, Mancini is one of just two players in Orioles history (since 1954) with two outfield assists in the same inning (also **LF Don Buford** on June 25, 1970 at Boston in the first inning)...According to STATS, LLC., the last player in the majors with two outfield assists in the same inning was **LF José Osuna** of the Pittsburgh Pirates, who did so on July 6, 2017 at Philadelphia in the second inning.

**CATCH THIS:** On April 21, **C Chance Sisco** threw out three Cleveland base runners attempting to steal (**LF Michael Brantley** at second base in the sixth inning, **SS Francisco Lindor** at second base in the seventh inning, and **PR Rajai Davis** at third in the ninth inning)...It marked the first time an O's catcher had three caught stealing in a game since **C Matt Wieters** caught three runners on August 25, 2012 vs. Toronto...Sisco has caught 10-of-34 would-be base stealers this season and is tied for second in the majors with 10 catcher caught stealing.

**VS. BOSTON:** The Orioles and Red Sox play the eighth game of 19 matchups between the two clubs this season...The Red Sox lead the season series, 6-1...The Orioles won the 2017 season series, 10-9...Baltimore trails Boston in the all-time series, 490-569, with the Orioles trailing 249-280 at home and trailing 241-289 at Boston.

**THIS DATE IN ORIOLES HISTORY:** On this date in 1962, future Hall of Famer **RHP Robin Roberts**, signed by on May 21 after being released by the Yankees, notched his first win for the Orioles by defeating the Yankees, 5-3...After **LF Boog Powell** was beamed by **LHP Bud Daley** and carried off the field on a stretcher in the top of the fourth, Roberts tossed a pitch over the head of **CF Roger Maris** to lead off the bottom of the fourth...The pitch incited a brawl and the ejections of Orioles manager **Billy Hitchcock** and the Yankees skipper **Ralph Houk**.

**GENUINE DRAFT:** The Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft was held from June 4-6 at MLB Network's Studio 42 in Secaucus, NJ...The Orioles selected **RHP Grayson Rodriguez** from Central Heights (TX) High School with their first selection as the 11<sup>th</sup> overall pick and **INF Cadyn Grenier** at No. 37 overall out of Oregon State University...The Orioles selected 40 players overall: 22 pitchers and 18 position players, with 28 of the selections being college athletes...The Orioles chose 16 right-handed pitchers, six left-handed pitchers, seven infielders, seven outfielders, and four catchers.

**ORIOLES HALL OF FAME:** Former **2B Brian Roberts** has been elected to the Orioles Hall of Fame...Additionally, long-time Orioles Radio broadcaster **Fred Manfra** will be inducted as this year's Herb Armstrong Award winner...Roberts and Manfra will be honored at a luncheon at Oriole Park on August 10, as well as during an on-field ceremony prior to the August 11 game...Roberts played 13 seasons with the Orioles from 2001-13, compiling a .278 batting average and 1,452 hits...He ranks first in O's history among second basemen in all major offensive categories...Drafted by Baltimore in the first round of the 1999 First-Year Player Draft (No. 50 overall), Roberts was a two-time All-Star (2005 and 2007)...Roberts will provide analysis for select games on the Orioles Radio Network this season...Before retiring in 2017, Manfra spent 24 years with the Orioles Radio Network...The East Baltimore native and Patterson High School graduate joined Orioles Radio broadcasts in 1993...In his 47-year broadcasting career, Manfra covered numerous O's highlights and other marquee sporting events.

**MANCINI JOINS HOOTON FOUNDATION:** Earlier this season, **OF Trey Mancini** joined the Taylor Hooton Foundation "Advisory Board" of players from throughout Major League Baseball...The Taylor Hooton Foundation is widely acknowledged as the leader in the advocacy against appearance and performance enhancing substance use by kids...Mancini replaced **INF J.J. Hardy** as the Orioles representative.

**DISABLED LIST:** Six Orioles are currently on the disabled list...**OF Colby Rasmus** (left hip flexor strain, since 4/7), **INF Luis Sardiñas** (lower back strain, retroactive to 4/29), and **RHP Chris Tillman** (lower back strain, since 5/11) are on the 10-day disabled list...**LHP Zach Britton** (right Achilles surgery, since 2/15), **RHP Gabriel Ynoa** (right shoulder inflammation, retroactive to 3/26), and **INF Tim Beckham** (left groin strain, retroactive to 4/24) are on the 60-day DL.

**THE SKIPPER:** A three-time Manager of the Year (1994, 2004, 2014), **Buck Showalter** is in his ninth season as Orioles manager...He has managed the Yankees (313-268, 1992-95), Diamondbacks (250-236, 1998-2000), Rangers (319-329, 2003-06), and Orioles (641-614, Aug. 2010-current)...Showalter's 1,523 career wins rank 23<sup>rd</sup> all-time and are third among active managers behind **Bruce Bochy** and **Mike Scioscia**...His 641 wins as O's manager are second-most in club history behind only Earl Weaver (1,480).
