THE TWINS: The Twins completed their 10-day roadtrip with a record of 5-5, going 1-3 vs. Kansas City, 3-0 vs. Detroit and 1-2 vs. Oakland...tonight they will begin a seven-game homestand with three against Detroit tonight through Thursday and four against Chicago-AL (doubleheader Friday) over the weekend to complete the 2018 season.

TWINS FINISH ROAD ON A HIGH: The Twins beat the Athletics on Sunday afternoon by a score of 5-1 at the Coliseum...Kyle Gibson (9-13) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on seven hits in 7.1 innings pitched...Trevor May earned his first career save with 1.1 innings of relief...the offense recorded nine hits, two from Joe Mauer, Jake Cave and Ehire Adrianza...Cave hit a two-run homer in the first inning, his 12th of the season.

TWINS AND TIGERS: The Twins and Tigers are playing the 17th of 19 scheduled meetings...the Twins have gone 10-6 this season, 5-2 at home and 5-4 at Comerica...they have won four straight and six of their last seven over Detroit...additionally, they have gone 17-7 in their last 24 vs. Detroit.

☞ The Twins have hit 16 homers (3, 3, 4, 3, 2, 1, 0) in their last seven vs. the Tigers.

MAUER AND THE TIGERS: Joe Mauer is hitting .305 (242-for-794) with 43 doubles, two triples, 18 home runs, 121 RBI, 104 walks and a .385 on-base percentage in 213 career games vs. the Tigers...below are his ranks among actives against Detroit in a few categories:

ALL ABOUT ADRIANZA: Ehire Adrianza has started 15 of the Twins last 18 games at third base...he has driven in 13 runs this month in 17 games played, the most on the club for September and tied for 16th most in the AL.

ROGER THAT: Taylor Rogers enters tonight with a scoreless inning streak of 23.2 (since July 30)...it's the longest active streak in baseball...the Twins record is 36.0 straight, held by J.C. Romero, from June 26-September 11, 2004...below are the all-time streaks in club history (since 1961):

PRIMARY PITCHER: Stewart is making his fourth appearance as a primary pitcher this year and his fourth in a row...in three appearances as a primary pitcher, is 2-0, 1.88 ERA (14.1 IP, 3 ER) with nine walks and eight strikeouts...today will be the seventh time the Twins will use an opener this year...the Twins are 3-3 in games in which they use an opener.

LAST APPEARANCE: Stewart made his seventh career appearance and third against Detroit on September 17...earned the win after allowing one unearned run on three hits and three walks with five strikeouts over 6.0 innings of relief...first major league outing without an earned run and first professional outing without allowing an earned run since July 30 with Triple-A Rochester against Scranton/Wilkes-Barre...third straight outing allowing three or fewer hits...run scored on an Eddie Rosario error in left field.

AGAINST DETROIT: Stewart is making his fourth career appearance against Detroit, is 1-1 with a 4.15 ERA (13.0 IP, 6 ER) with eight walks and eight strikeouts...last outing against the Tigers was September 17 and is making his second consecutive appearance against Detroit...made big league debut against Detroit on August 12, suffered the loss after allowing three runs on eight hits and one walk with a strikeout over 4.1 innings...faced Detroit once at Target Field on August 18, did not factor into the decision after allowing three runs on three hits and four walks with two strikeouts over 2.2 innings.

WELCOME TO THE BIGS: Stewart made his major league debut on August 11 at Detroit, the 177th player to make his major league debut this year...he is one of eight Twins to make his big league debut this year (Fernando Romero 5/2 vs. TOR, Tyler Kinley 4/7 vs. SEA, Williams Astudillo 6/30 vs. CHC, Stephen Gonsalves 8/20 vs. CWS, Jake Cave 5/19 vs. MIL, Zack Littell 6/5 vs. CWS and Andrew Vasquez 9/1 at TEX).

DOWN ON THE FARM: Stewart split the season between Double-A Chattanooga and Triple-A Rochester...in 14 starts with the Lookouts, is 3-4 with a 4.76 ERA (68.0 IP, 36 ER) with 21 walks and 71 strikeouts...promoted to Rochester on June 24, is 0-3 with a 3.98 ERA (40.2 IP, 18 ER) with 12 walks and 30 strikeouts in seven games (5 starts).

ANOTHER FRESH FACE: By making his debut on August 11, Stewart became the 11th of 13 different starting pitcher the Twins have used this year (not including three openers)...he is one of 34 different pitchers to make an appearance this year (including outfielder Ryan LaMarre, infielder Williams Astudillo, catcher Mitch Garver and catcher Chris Gimenez), tied for third most in the AL with Oakland.
