NATIONALS NEWS

WINNING WAYS

The Washington Nationals won their fifth straight game and claimed the series victory thanks to a 3-2 win over the Baltimore Orioles on Tuesday night...A win tonight would mark the second three-game sweep of the Baltimore Orioles in Nationals history (2005-pres.)...They also completed a three-game sweep June 12-14, 2007 at Baltimore.

- Since April 29, the Nationals are 20-6 and have outscored their opponents, 119-70...The 20-6 (.769) record is the best in Major League Baseball.
- Washington's 20-6 record over the last 26 games is the best 26-game stretch for the club since the 2015 Nationals went 20-6 from April 29 to May 27.
- Only the New York Yankees (22, 21 several times) and Boston Red Sox (21) have posted more wins in a 26-game stretch this season than the Nationals in their current 26-game run.
- Washington's 18 wins during the month of May are tied for the most for any May in team history (18, May 2015)...Washington's record for wins in a calendar month is 20 in June 2005.

ROAD STREAKIN'

Washington has won nine straight road games, tied for the longest road winning streak in team history (2005-pres.)...They are tied with the 2011 Nationals, who won nine in a row from Sept. 12 to Sept. 26.

- Washington's current streak is tied for the second-longest road winning streak in MLB this season, behind the Los Angeles Angels (11 G, 3/30-4/24)...The nine-game streak is tied with the Boston Red Sox (9 G, 3/30-4/20).
- At 19-8 (.704), the Nationals own the best road record in Major League Baseball.

START ME UP

Washington's starting rotation leads the National League in ERA (2.88), strikeouts (361), opp. AVG (.213), opp. OBP (.277), hits per 9.0 IP (7.02), WHIP (1.07), and strikeouts per 9.0 IP (10.03)...The staff ranks second in strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.76), opp. SLG (.362), and opp. OPS (.639).

- Since April 28, Nationals starters have allowed three earned runs or fewer in 27 of 28 starts...During this stretch, the Nationals starting staff owns the best ERA in Major League Baseball (2.25 ERA).
- **Max Scherzer** (2nd, .180), **Tanner Roark** (4th, .198) and **Stephen Strasburg** (8th, .216) rank in the top 10 in the National League in opp. AVG...All three also rank in the top 10 in opp. OBP: Scherzer (2nd, .244), Roark (9th, .268) and Strasburg (10th, .276).
- **Gio Gonzalez** (2nd, 2.10), Scherzer (3rd, 2.13), Strasburg (13th, 3.13) and Roark (15th, 3.17) each rank in the top 15 in the National League in ERA...The Nationals are the only club with more than two pitchers in the top 15.

RELIEVERS ARE PEOPLE, TOO

Over the last eight games, **Henry Blanco's** bullpen has tossed 23.1 innings of relief, striking out 27 batters, walking just three and surrendering just two earned runs along the way (0.77 ERA)...Nationals relievers have inherited 12 runners during this stretch and have not allowed any to score.

- Washington's 0.77 bullpen ERA is the best in Major League Baseball since May 21.
- On the season, Washington relievers rank among National League 'pens in strikeout-to-walk ratio (2nd, 2.96), strikeouts per 9.0 IP (2nd, 9.766), and inherited runners scored percent (3rd, 20.3%).

SUMMER OF SOTO

In eight games with the Nationals, **Juan Soto** is hitting .393 (11-for-28) with four of his 11 hits being extra base hits (3 2B, HR)...He has recorded three RBI, five walks and five runs scored while striking out just five times.

- Soto has hit safely in four straight games, going 8-for-15 (.533) with three doubles, one walk and two runs scored...He has multi-hit efforts in three of the four games.

DINGERS OF THE DAY

The Nationals lead the National League with 71 home runs...**Bryce Harper** (1st, 17) and **Matt Adams** (T6th, 12) rank in the top 10 in the National League...Only the Nationals and the Colorado Rockies have more than one player in the top 10 in home runs in the National League.

- The Nationals have homered in a season-high nine straight games.
- Since joining the Nationals on May 13, **Mark Reynolds** ranks second in the National League (T3rd in MLB) with six home runs.

IN THE COMMUNITY

June 8: Anthony's Academy All-Stars

Anthony's Academy All-Stars is a season-long program that gives scholar-athletes from the Nationals Youth Baseball Academy, where **Anthony Rendon** sits on the Board of Directors, the opportunity to enjoy a Nationals Baseball game. The group enjoys a behind-the-scenes look at team operations, a private meet and greet with Rendon as well as special batting practice viewing and tickets complete with NatsBucks.

NATIONALS HISTORY

May 30 (4-8 on this date)

2010 - **Ryan Zimmerman** hit 100th and 101st home runs of his career, but the Nationals fall at San Diego, 3-2. Zimmerman became the second member of the 2005 First-Year Draft class to reach the 100-homer plateau (ML's **Ryan Braun**).

OPPONENT

BALTIMORE ORIOLES

28 players, two managers and three coaches have suited up for both the Washington Nationals and Baltimore Orioles since 2005.

THE SERIES

The Battle of the Beltways will feature three games in Baltimore and three games in Washington D.C... The series has favored the Orioles since 2005, but the Nationals have won five of the last seven matchups between the two clubs.

DAVE MARTINEZ

Nationals manager **Dave Martinez** was named the seventh field manager in Nationals history on Oct. 30, 2017. He joined the Nationals for what will be his 30th season in professional baseball. A 16-year Major League outfielder, Martinez has been a Major League coach for the last 10 seasons, serving as Cubs manager **Joe Maddon's** bench coach and right-hand man in Chicago (2015-17) as well as Tampa Bay (2008-14). This is the first Major League managerial assignment of Martinez's career.

#31 - MAX SCHERZER - RHP

Polished veteran right-hander, three-time Cy Young Award Winner and five-time consecutive All-Star signed a historic seven-year contract with Washington on Jan. 21, 2015...Joined the Nationals after seven Major League seasons with the Detroit Tigers (2010-14) and Arizona Diamondbacks (2008-09)...Is one of just 10 pitchers in Major League history to take home the Cy Young Award three or more times.

AGAINST THE ORIOLES: Faces Baltimore for the fifth time as a member of the Washington Nationals...Has tossed at least 8.0 IP in three of the previous four outings...Allowed two earned runs in 16. IP (1.13 ERA) spanning his last two starts against the Orioles.

LAST START: Earned his seventh win in a row, battling through 6.0 innings of four-run ball as the Nationals topped the Marlins, 9-5...The four runs and seven hits were both season highs.

2018 NOTES

- Is in the midst of a seven-game winning streak, the third-longest streak of his career (13 G; 4/6-7/3/13 and 9 G; 8/20/16-4/7/17)...It is tied for the longest winning streak in Major League Baseball in 2018 with Houston right-hander **Charlie Morton**.
- Struck out at least 10 batters in three consecutive starts from May 6-19, tied for the third-longest streak of his career (6 G; 5/26-6/21/17).
- Ranks among National League pitchers in strikeouts (1st, 108), strikeouts per 9.0 IP (1st, 13.56), wins (1st, 8), WHIP (2nd, 0.91), opp. AVG (2nd, .180), opp. OBP (2nd, .244), hits per 9.0 IP (2nd, 5.90), ERA (3rd, 2.13), strikeout-to-walk ratio (3rd, 6.00) and opp. SLG (9th, .333).
- His 13.56 strikeouts per 9.0 IP would be the best since **Randy Johnson** in 2001 (13.41).
- Opposing right-handed batters are just 17-for-105 (.162) against him...Has not allowed a home run to a RHB (Last: **Stanton**; 8/7/17 vs. MIA).
- Did not earn the win, but struck out a season-high 15 batters on May 6 vs. PHI...It was his 69th career 10+strikeout game and fifth career 15+strikeout game...He became the first pitcher in Major League history (since 1913) to strike out at least 15 batters in no more than 6.1 IP according to Baseball-Reference.com.
- Was named National League Pitcher of the Month for April (5-0, 1.62 ERA, 57 SO, 9 BB, .165 opp. AVG).
- Has been called upon to help snap five-game, three-game and four-game losing streaks this season...Washington won all three starts.
- Was named National League Player of the Week for the week of April 9 through 15 (2-0, 1.13 ERA, 21 SO, BB, 3 H).
- Opened the season in strong fashion striking out 10 batters in 6.0 shutout innings in Washington's 2-0 win over the Cincinnati Reds on Opening Day...His 10 strikeouts tied the most on Opening Day in MON/WSH history: **Stephen Strasburg** (3/31/14 at NYM) and **Steve Rogers** (4/9/82 at PHI).

CAREER NOTES

- His 71 games of 10+ strikeouts are 10th-most in MLB history (since 1913) and most among active pitchers.
- Is one of 12 pitchers (only active) in MLB history (since 1913) with at least 38 G of at least 10 SO and one earned run or fewer allowed.
- Is one of 12 pitchers (2 active, **Kershaw**) in MLB history (since 1913) with at least 19 G of at least 10 SO and zero earned runs allowed.
- Scherzer's five career games with 15 or more strikeouts are the most among active players and tied for seventh-most all-time.
- Leads all active starters and ranks second in MLB history with a career 10.32 strikeouts per 9.0 IP (**Randy Johnson** - 10.61).
- His career .199 opp. AVG vs. right-handed batters is fourth-best all-time and second among starting pitchers (**J.R. Richard** - .186).
- Is the only pitcher in MLB with an active streak of six-plus seasons with at least 200 strikeouts.
- Since joining the Nationals in 2015, has taken a no-hitter into the sixth inning in 11 or 109 starts (10.0%), per MASN in-game reporter, Dan Kolko.
- Since 2015, has posted a 0.93 WHIP, behind only **Clayton Kershaw** (0.88) for the best over this stretch.
