ROCKY ROAD: Today, the Dodgers take on their division rivals, the Colorado Rockies, for the first time this spring at Salt River Field in Scottsdale. The two clubs will meet again on March 14 for a night game at Camelback Ranch, their final matchup of the Cactus League schedule, but will play 19 times during the regular season (May 21-23, June 29-July 1, Sept. 17-19 in Los Angeles and June 1-3, Aug. 9-12, Sept. 7-9 in Denver). The Dodgers have 16 more exhibition games this spring; including seven at Camelback Ranch on two Spring Training weekends and will head back to Los Angeles for a three-game Freeway Series against the Angels on March 25-27. Following the I-5 matchup, the Dodgers will open the 2018 season on March 29 against the San Francisco Giants at Dodger Stadium.

WALK IT OUT: Yesterday, the Dodgers beat the Cubs 6-5 in the bottom of the 9th inning with a walk-off sacrifice fly from **Donovan Solano** in his only at-bat of the game. The Dodgers got on the board in the first inning with back-to-back doubles from **Chris Taylor**, his first of two on the night, and **Andrew Toles**, who became the first to reach double-digit hits this spring for the Dodgers with 10. **Kiké Hernández** connected for his second Cactus League home run, a three-run blast in the bottom of the seventh to tie the game at five. On the mound, **Rich Hill** allowed just one unearned run in 4.0 innings while striking out four, while **Walker Buehler** earned the win in his spring training debut after pitching two scoreless frames with five punch-outs. **J.T. Chargois** also contributed a scoreless inning, and has not given up a run in 4.0 innings of relief this spring.

- 📌 Toles leads the Dodgers with 10 hits and is batting .400 (10-for-25) with two homers, two doubles, and nine RBI. The nine ribbies rank second on the squad, trailing only **Jake Peter** (12).
- 📌 The Dodgers 29 home runs this spring trail just the Giants (33), Indians (32) and Padres (32) for the most in the Majors.
- 📌 The Dodgers' 43 doubles this spring lead all Cactus League teams and the offense currently ranks among the top teams in the Majors this spring in hits (161, 7th), runs scored (105, 5th), slugging percentage (.509, 4th) and OPS (.853, 4th).
- 📌 Dodger pitchers have recorded 148 strikeouts this spring, which ties the Giants for the fifth most in the Cactus League, trailing just the Indians (163), Reds (155), Cubs (154) and Angels (150).

RYU DAY: Dodger left-hander **Hyun-Jin Ryu** will make his Cactus League debut today against Colorado after pitching 2.2 innings in a "B" game on March 5 vs. White Sox. In 2017, his first full season since 2014 after recovering from shoulder surgery (2015-16) and elbow tendonitis (2016), he went 5-9 with one save and posted a 3.77 ERA in 25 games (24 starts). Last season, Ryu struck out 116 batters against 45 walks in 126.2 innings, holding opposing hitters to a .263 average, including a .240 mark against righties.

HAPPY HAPPY: The Dodgers would like to wish a very happy birthday to left-hander **Rich Hill**, who turns 38 today! In 13 big league seasons, Hill has logged a 46-34 record with a 3.90 ERA in 119 career starts. Last season he went 12-8 with a 3.32 ERA (50 ER/135.2 IP) in 25 starts. The Dodgers would also like to congratulate **Pedro Baez** on his 30th birthday. In his fourth Major League season, the Dominican native went 3-6 with a 2.95 ERA (21 ER/64.0 IP) in 66 relief appearances. He held batters to a .225 average, including a .206 mark against left-handed hitters, and ranked 14th among NL relievers (min. 100 BFP) in opponents' batting average against lefties.

THE ROOM IS THINNING: Following last night's game, the Dodgers optioned INF/OF **Tim Locastro**, LHP **Henry Owens**, RHP **Dennis Santana** and RHP **Brock Stewart** to minor league camp. The club also reassigned C **Keibert Ruiz**, C **Shawn Zarraga**, INF **Matt Beaty**, INF **Drew Jackson**, INF **Edwin Rios**, OF **Yusniel Diaz**, OF **DJ Peters**, OF **Henry Ramos**, OF **Travis Taijeron**, RHP **Zach Neal**, RHP **Yaisel Sierra**, RHP **Joe Broussard**, RHP **Daniel Corcino**, RHP **CC Lee**, LHP **Brian Moran** and RHP **Brian Schlitter** to minor league camp.

A LOOK BACK: The Dodgers posted a 104-58 record in 2017, becoming the first team in NL West history to win the division in five consecutive seasons. The team earned a World Series berth after defeating the Chicago Cubs in the NLCS, 4 games to 1, and finished the season with their first NL Pennant since 1988.

- 📌 The Dodgers posted the seventh 100-win season in franchise history (third in Los Angeles history) and first since 1974 (102-60). The Dodgers won 90+ games for the fifth consecutive season, a feat that had only previously been accomplished once in franchise history, 1951-56 (6).
- 📌 Los Angeles finished with the best record in the Majors for the first time since 1974 and the National League's best record for the first time since 2009. The Dodgers set a Los Angeles record for victories with 104 (104-58), tying for the second most in franchise history (also: 1942, 104-50) and finishing one shy of the club record of 105 (105-49), set in 1953.
- 📌 The Dodgers topped the NL in ERA (3.38), opponents' batting average (.228, 1st MLB), strikeouts (1,549), WHIP (1.15, 1st MLB) and shutouts (16). Los Angeles' 3.39 starters' ERA topped the Majors, while the 3.38 ERA by the club's relievers led the NL (4th, MLB).
- 📌 The Dodgers established franchise records with 553 extra-base hits (previous high: 541 in 1953), 312 doubles (previous high: 307 in 2006) and 221 home runs (4th, NL), which topped the club's previous high of 211 set in 2000. The club also set a Los Angeles record with a .437 slugging percentage, outpacing the previous high of .432 set in 2006.

COLLEGE BASEBALL CLASSIC: Today, Dodger Stadium will host the annual College Baseball Classic featuring three of college baseball's top 25 ranked teams. Seventh-ranked Texas Christian University will face 21st-ranked Vanderbilt at 10:30 a.m. followed by the annual local matchup of UCLA (#11) vs. USC at 3:00p.m. Tickets begin at just \$10 for both matchups (student tickets are \$5) and can be purchased at Dodgers.com/classic.

TODAY'S PITCHING PROBABLES

- ⚾ RHP **Wilmer Font** will appear in his fourth outing of the spring this afternoon, after last pitching on March 6 against the Chicago Cubs. In three Cactus League games, he has allowed seven runs in 4.2 innings (13.50 ERA), while striking out six against one walk. Font is entering his 10th professional season and his fourth year in the Majors after seeing his first big league action last season since 2013. In three games with Los Angeles, he allowed seven runs in 3.2 innings of relief (17.18 ERA) with three strikeouts. He spent the majority of the season with Triple-A Oklahoma City, going 10-8 with a 3.42 ERA and holding hitters to a .222 average in 25 starts.
- ⚾ Southpaw **Edward Paredes** will appear in his sixth outing of the spring, after last pitching on March 8 against the Indians, where he allowed three runs in 1.2 innings with four strikeouts. In five Cactus League games, he has allowed three runs in 3.2 innings (7.36 ERA) and struck out nine against three walks. The 31-year-old lefty reliever enters his 10th professional season and his first big league camp with the Dodgers after making his big league debut last season with the club.
- ⚾ Left-hander **Manny Bañuelos** will make his fourth appearance of the spring this afternoon, after allowing six runs in 5.2 innings of relief with seven strikeouts in three Cactus League games. He last pitched on March 6 against the Cubs, allowing one run in 2.0 innings of relief with two strikeouts. Bañuelos, who enters his first season with the Dodgers organization, has appeared in seven career Major League games (six starts), going 1-4 with a 5.13 ERA (15 ER/26.1 IP) in the 2015 season with the Braves.
- ⚾ Ambidextrous pitcher **Pat Venditte** will appear in his sixth game of the spring this afternoon, after making his last appearance against the Indians on March 8 where he allowed one run on two hits in 1.1 innings of relief with two strikeouts. In five Cactus League games, he has allowed just one run in 6.0 innings (1.50 ERA) and has struck out nine without issuing a walk. He enters his first season with the Dodgers after spending 2017 with the Phillies' Triple-A Lehigh Valley, going 9-5 with two saves and posting a 3.36 ERA (26 ER/69.2 IP) in 52 relief appearances.
