RECENT REDBIRDS: The Cardinals are 33-18 post All-Star Break and 34-18 under manager **Mike Shildt** since he took the post on July 15. The Cardinals have the most wins in the NL since the All-Star Break (33), while St. Louis .647 winning percentage ranks 3rd in MLB over that period. St. Louis has won 23-of-its-last-32 games overall. Entering July 15, the Cardinals had 9th-most wins in the NL (47) and currently have 3rd-most wins (81) in the NL.

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals are a season-high 17 games over .500 entering play today (2nd time this season) and currently reside in 3rd place in the NL Central, 3.5 games out of first place, and hold the 2nd spot in the NL Wild Card standings, trailing Milwaukee by 1.5 games. The Cardinals have six games remaining against teams ahead of them in the standings, the Cubs and Brewers.

GYORKO ACTIVATED FROM D.L.: The Cardinals activated INF **Jedd Gyorko** (left groin strain) from the 10-day disabled list prior to today's game...Gyorko had been sidelined since August 29, missing 13 games.

EARLY BIRDS: The Cardinals are playing their 53rd day game of the season this afternoon, and currently have 60 day games on their schedule...this year is the just the 2nd time since 1985 that the Cardinals will have played 60 or more day games (61 in 2003)...St. Louis is 29-23 in natural lighting this season.

THE HOME STRETCH: The Cardinals, who have matched the Cubs for fewest home games played (70) amongst all N.L. teams, will be home for 11 of their remaining 17 regular season games...the Cardinals 39-31 (.557) home mark is 4th among N.L. teams.

WINNING SEASONS: The Cardinals need one win to record their 11th consecutive winning season, something they've done just once previously in franchise history, when they compiled 15 consecutive winning seasons from 1939-1953.

CENTRAL CASTING: The Cardinals 40-29 (.580) mark against N.L. Central teams, the top winning pct. amongst divisional foes. In addition to this week's three-game series with Pittsburgh, the Cardinals have three games remaining with both the Brewers & Cubs...they're 8-8 vs. Milwaukee and 9-7 vs the Cubs this season.

THE HUNT FOR A RED OCTOBER: The Cardinals have 13 games (LAD-4, at ATL-3, MIL-3, at CHI-3) remaining with teams currently in contention for playoff positions...the SF Giants (3 games) are the only remaining team on the Cardinals slate that is under .500.

COMEBACK CARDS: The Cardinals used a four-run 8th inning Monday night to overcome a 6-4 deficit, as they posted their 9th win of the season when trailing after seven innings...the Cardinals 9 wins when trailing after 7 innings is 2nd to Washington (10) for the most amongst N.L. teams...the Cardinals are tied with Milwaukee for the N.L. lead in walk-off wins with 10 and St. Louis is 43-16 (.729) when scoring last this season, trailing only Atlanta (48-15, .762) and Milwaukee (51-17, .750) in win pct.

BACK TO THE FUTURE: With his 2nd save in as many days on Monday, **Carlos Martínez** upped his save total to three (5 career)...Tsunami closed out a 7-6 win at Washington with 2.0 scoreless innings last Wed. (9/5) and since joining the bullpen last month, Martínez is 1-0 with a 1.74 ERA (10.1 IP/2 ER) with 3 saves & 4 holds...Carlos appeared in 20 games as a reliever during his rookie season of 2013 and appeared in 12 games during the Redbirds postseason run, going 0-1 with a 3.55 ERA (12.2 IP/5 ER), appearing in five of the six games during the 2013 World Series.

THE BIG BEAR: In eight games since Sept. 3, **Marcell Ozuna** leads the National League in total bases (29) and go-ahead RBI (5), is 2nd in home runs (5), ranks 4th in .OPS (1.224), 2nd in slugging (.853), and 15th in batting average (.382). Ozuna has 11 home runs and is slugging .538 in 42 games since the All-Star Break (10 home runs w/ .385 slugging pct. in 90 games before).

PITTSBURGH CONNECTIONS

Carlos Martínez was teammates with Pirates **Ivan Nova** and **Starling Marte** and **Gregory Polanco** for the Dominican Republic in the 2017 World Baseball Classic.

Paul DeJong was originally selected by the Pirates in the 38th round of the 2014 MLB Draft, but did not sign.

Matt Adams was born in Philipsburg, Pa...graduated from Philipsburg-Osceola High School...attended Slippery Rock University (2007-09).

Pitching coach **Mike Maddux** signed with the Pirates in April 1995 and pitched in eight games before being released in May.

Miles Mikolas spent one month as a Pirate during the 2013 offseason...traded by San Diego with infielder **Jaff Decker** to Pittsburgh in exchange for outfielder **Alex Dickerson** (Nov. 25, 2013), then traded by Pittsburgh to the Rangers in exchange for infielder **Chris McGuiness** (Dec. 30, 2013).

Francisco Pena's father, **Tony**, was an All-Star catcher for the Pirates (1980-86)...later traded by Pittsburgh to the Cardinals for pitcher **Mike Dunne**, catcher **Mike LaValliere** and outfielder **Andy Van Slyke** (April 1, 1987.)

First base coach **Oliver Marmol** was originally selected by the Pirates in the 31st round of the 2004 MLB draft, but did not sign.

Jedd Gyorko was born in Morgantown, WV...played at West Virginia University (2008-10).

Yadier Molina (June 3, 2004), **José Martínez** (September 6, 2016) and **Austin Gomber** (June 2, 2018) made their MLB debuts against Pittsburgh.

Manager **Clint Hurdle** was selected by St. Louis from the Mets in the 1985 Rule 5 Draft and played in 86 games for the Cardinals in 1986.

Pitching Coach **Ray Searge** was selected by St. Louis in the 22nd round of the 1976 MLB Draft...later traded to the Mets for catcher **Jody Davis** in 1979...began coaching career in the Cardinals minor league system as Pitching Coach with Madison (1994), Peoria (1995-96) & Prince William (1997).

Pirates Baseball Operations Senior Advisor **Nick Leyva** was drafted by St. Louis in the 24th round in 1975...played three minor league seasons in the Cardinals system (1975-77)...managed six minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization (1978-83)...served as St. Louis' First Base Coach (1984-85) and Third Base Coach (1986-88).

Cardinals Baseball Information & Media Services Coordinator **Chris Tunno** graduated from nearby Canfield (Ohio) High School.

Pirates Manager of Business Communications & Social Media **Terry Rodgers** previously worked as a Public Relations Specialist in the Cardinals Communications department (2010-11).

TODAY'S GAME

- Rookie is making his fourth Major League start and 10th career appearance.
- Has made three starts for St. Louis this season: 0-1, 2.51 ERA, 14.1 IP, 5 BB, 15 K, .189 average against (10-53).
- His first nine appearances with St. Louis were all night games. This season for Memphis (AAA), was 3-1 with a 1.11 ERA (24.1 IP) and 28 strikeouts in four matinees.
- Limiting the opposition to a .200 average against (19-95), including a .167 mark against left-handed batters (8-for-48).
- He's one of 11 different pitchers to make a start for St. Louis this season (most since 2014-15 seasons). 13 is the single-season team record (1910, 1913, 1959, 1980).

- Threw 2.0 scoreless frames in relief in St. Louis' 4-2 defeat in Detroit last Saturday.

- Made six relief appearances following his ML debut, five of which that have gone multiple innings (T4th-most on the Cardinals).
- Returned to the rotation on 8/21 at Dodger Stadium when he fanned a career-high 8 batters in 4.0 innings and a 5-2 Cardinals victory.
- Earned his first career save with 3.0 scoreless IP (44 pitches) in 7-0 combined shutout on 8/10 at KC (STL's third 3.0 inning save in 2018)...the last Cardinal to record a 3.0 IP save in his first 5 career games was Brad Thompson (5/8/2005 vs. SD).
- Threw 7.0 no-hit innings in his Major League debut on 7/23 at CIN, leaving the game with a 1-0 lead after 116 pitches. The Cardinals lost the game 2-1 on a walk-off home run by Eugenio Suárez in the 9th inning.
- Was the first Cardinals pitcher to throw 7.0 no-hit innings in his MLB debut and one of five pitchers since the Expansion Era (since 1961) to carry a no-hitter through 7.0 innings in his MLB debut joining Ross Stripling (LAD, 2016), Rudy May (CAL, 1965), Billy Rohr (BOS, 1967) and Bill Slayback (DET, 1972).
- Joined Michael Wacha (6/3 vs. PIT) and Austin Gomber (7/24 at CIN) as Cardinals pitchers to carry a no-hitter 6.0 or more innings deep into a game this season.
- Made a relief outing for his second MLB appearance (7/30 vs. COL) and pitched 2.1 innings, allowing two runs on two hits with two walks and two strikeouts.
- His first MLB hit allowed was a grand slam to Nolan Arenado. Was the first Cardinal in franchise history (dating to 1900) whose first hit allowed (7/30) was a grand slam (*Elias*), and the first pitcher since PHI's Daniel Stumpf, who surrendered a slam to Eugenio Suárez for his first MLB hit on (4/7/2016 at CIN).
- He was the 13th player in franchise history to make his MLB debut in a start against the
