## NATIONALS NEWS

### FINAL STAND

The Washington Nationals topped the Miami Marlins, 7-3, on Monday night behind strong offensive outputs from **Anthony Rendon** (2-for-4, 2B, HR, 4 RBI, R), **Juan Soto** (2-for-4, HR, RBI, R) and **Adam Eaton** (1-for-3, 2 BB, 2 R)...The Nationals are looking to finish the 2018 home slate at or above .500 for the ninth consecutive season (2010-pres.).

- Following this three-game series, Washington will enjoy an off day on Thursday before heading to Colorado for a three-game weekend set to cap the 2018 season.

### HE'S STREAKING

**Anthony Rendon** has reached base safely in a career-high 32 straight games dating to Aug. 21...It is the longest active streak in Major League Baseball and is the third-longest streak in the National League this season...**Matt Carpenter** is second on the list with a 35-game streak (7/8-8/17) and **Odubel Herrera** had the longest streak in the NL this year (40 G, 3/30-5/19)...During the streak, Rendon is hitting .354 with a .439 on-base percentage and a .622 slugging percentage.

- Rendon has also hit safely in 10 straight games, going 18-for-39 (.462) with three doubles, four homers, 16 RBI, six walks and eight runs scored.
- He recorded his career-high 42nd double of the season on Monday night...He has 66 extra-base hits (42 2B, 3B, 23 HR), one shy of his career-high of 67 in 2017.
- On the season, Rendon ranks in the NL in doubles (T2nd, 43), OPS (5th, .903), average (6th, .308), slugging percentage (8th, .529) and extra-base hits (10th, 66).
- According to FanGraphs.com, Rendon ranks second in the NL in Wins Above Replacement (5.8).

### EVERYDAY TREA

**Trea Turner** has played in each of Washington's 157 games this season, making 153 starts and four appearances off the bench...The only player in Nationals history (2005-pres.) to appear in all 162 games in a season was **Ryan Zimmerman**, who started all 162 games in 2007.

- If Turner starts each of the five games left on the schedule, he will tie **Alfonso Soriano** (158 in 2006) for second on the list behind Zimmerman's 162 starts in 2007.
- Turner enters Tuesday riding a career-long 24 game on-base streak and a 12-game hitting streak...His career-best hitting streak is 13 games earlier this season (5/19-6/1).

### CHASING 100-100-100

**Bryce Harper** enters Tuesday with 99 runs scored, 100 RBI and 126 walks in 2018...He is looking to become the seventh player since 2014 to record at least 100 runs, RBI and walks in a season...He would join **Jose Ramirez** (2018), **Joey Votto** (2017), **Aaron Judge** (2017), **Mike Trout** (2016), **Paul Goldschmidt** (2015) and **Jose Bautista** (2015, 2014).

- With one more run scored, he will become the 22nd player in Major League history to record a season of at least 100 runs, 100 RBI and 125 walks.
- On the season, he ranks in the National League in HR (T2nd, 34), OBP (6th, .390), runs (T6th, 99), RBI (6th, 100), extra-base hits (11th, 65) and OPS (11th, .885).
- Harper recorded his career-high 100th RBI on Monday night...He is one of just six National League players to record at least 100 RBI in 2018.

### BEST OF THE BEST

Since the All-Star break, Washington's offense ranks in the National League in on-base percentage (1st, .348), batting average (1st, .263), doubles (1st, 120), stolen bases (1st, 47), runs (2nd, 322), walks (2nd, 255), OPS (2nd, .786), slugging percentage (3rd, .438) and home runs (5th, 75).

- Washington's second-half surge has placed them among the top five NL offenses in 2018 in on-base percentage (2nd, .332), OPS (2nd, .748), runs (4th, 739), home runs (5th, 187) and slugging percentage (5th, .416).

### ALL HANDS ON DECK

The Nationals have used 53 players in 2018, tied for the third-most in the National League this season and the fourth-most in Nationals history (2005-pres.)...The 2006 Nationals used 57 players, while the 2009 and 2005 Nationals each used 55.

## NATIONALS HISTORY

### September 25 (5-7 on this date)

2007 — **Austin Kearns**, **Tony Batista** and **Justin Maxwell** all homered to power the Nationals past the New York Mets, 10-9. Before Kearns and Batista went deep in the first inning, **Tom Glavine** hadn't been touched for a homer by a National in 58.2 innings (9+ starts). Down 10-3 in the 9th, **Jon Rauch** staved off The Mets' furious rally and grabbed the save by retiring **Carlos Delgado** (K) and **Paul Lo Duca** (F-9) with the tying run in scoring position.

In 2004, he was named the Florida Marlins Minor League Player of the Year...**Ryan Zimmerman's** 35 home runs are third-most all-time against the Florida/Miami Marlins...**Bryce Harper** (24) is tied for 11th on that same list.

## DAVE MARTINEZ

Nationals manager **Dave Martinez** was named the seventh field manager in Nationals history on Oct. 30, 2017. He joined the Nationals for what will be his 30th season in professional baseball. A 16-year Major League outfielder, Martinez has been a Major League coach for the last 10 seasons, serving as Cubs manager **Joe Maddon's** bench coach and right-hand man in Chicago (2015-17) as well as Tampa Bay (2008-14). This is the first Major League managerial assignment of Martinez's career.

## #31 - MAX SCHERZER - RHP

Polished veteran right-hander, three-time Cy Young Award winner and five-time consecutive All-Star signed a historic seven-year contract with Washington on Jan. 21, 2015...Joined the Nationals after seven Major League seasons with Detroit (2010-14) and Arizona (2008-09)...Is one of just 10 pitchers in Major League history to take home the Cy Young Award three or more times.

**AGAINST THE MARLINS:** Is 4-0 with a 2.67 ERA (8 ER/27.0 IP) in four starts against Miami this season...Has a five-game winning streak across five starts dating back to Aug. 28, 2017, pitching to a 2.38 ERA.

**LAST START:** Struck out 13 batters and walked just two in 7.0 innings...Allowed three earned runs on five hits in Washington's 5-4 loss against the New York Mets on Sept. 20.

### 2018 NOTES

- Recorded his 285th strikeout of the season on Sept. 20, a new career-high and a new Nationals (2005-pres.) record for most strikeouts in a season, breaking his previous record of 284 set in 2016.

- Leads NL pitchers in SO (290), SO/9.0 IP (12.22), H/9.0 IP (6.11), WHIP (0.92), SO/BB (5.69), opp. AVG (.188), opp. OBP (.248) and wins (T1st,17)...Ranks in the NL in ERA (3rd, 2.57), opp. OPS (3rd, .583) and opp. SLG (5th, .335).
- Tossed 20.0 consecutive scoreless innings from Aug. 7-23...It is the longest streak by a Nationals pitcher in 2018.
- Had a six-game winning streak in eight from July 7-Aug. 17...Posted a 2.00 ERA (13 ER/54.0 IP) and 60 SO.
- Has tossed at least 7.0 innings in 18 starts, the third-most in MLB and second-most in the National League.
- Recorded his 200th strikeout of the season on July 27 at MIA (Bour)...Per *Elias*, his streak of seven 200+ strikeout seasons is tied for second in MLB history behind **Tom Seaver** (NYM, 9, 1968-1976), and with **Roger Clemens** (BOS, 7, 1986-1992) and **Walter Johnson** (WSH, 7, 1910-1916).
- Recorded his 1,000th strikeout w/WSH on July 2 vs. BOS, becoming the 11th pitcher in MLB history to collect at least 1,000 strikeouts with two different clubs...The list, according to *Elias*: **Jim Bunning** (DET/PHI), **Roger Clemens** (BOS/NYY), **Randy Johnson** (ARI/SEA), **Mark Langston** (ANA/SEA), **Greg Maddux** (CHI/ATL), **Mike Mussina** (BAL/NYY), **Nolan Ryan** (CAL/HOU), **CC Sabathia** (CLE/NYY), **Luis Tiant** (BOS/CLE) and **Cy Young** (BOS/CLE)
- Recorded a nine-game winning streak from (4/9-6/5) which tied the second-longest streak of his career (13 G; 4/6-7/3/13 and 9 G; 8/20/16-4/7/17)...It is the longest winning streak in Major League Baseball in 2018.
- Did not earn the win, but struck out a season-high 15 batters on May 6 vs. PHI...It was his fifth career 15+ strikeout game...He became the first pitcher in Major League history (since 1913) to strike out at least 15 batters in no more than 6.1 IP according to Baseball-Reference.com.
- Was named National League Pitcher of the Month for April (5-0, 1.62 ERA, 57 SO, 9 BB, .165 opp. AVG) and May (4-0, 2.21 ERA, 63 SO, 10 BB).
- Was named National League Player of the Week for the week of April 9 through 15 (2-0, 1.13 ERA, 21 SO, BB, 3 H).

### CAREER NOTES

- His 81 games of 10+ SO rank eighth in MLB history (since 1913) and most among active pitchers...H.O.F. **Steve Carlton** (7th, 84).
- His 41 games of 10+ SO and one ER or fewer rank seventh in MLB history (since 1913) and most among active pitchers...**Curt Schilling** (6th, 47).
- His 22 games of 10+ SO and zero ER rank seventh in MLB history (since 1913) and second-most among active pitchers...**Clayton Kershaw** (6th, 23)
- Scherzer's five career games with 15 or more strikeouts are the most among active players and tied for seventh-most all-time.
- Leads all active starters and ranks second in MLB history with a career 10.40 strikeouts per 9.0 IP (**Randy Johnson** - 10.61).
- His career .198 opp. AVG vs. right-handed batters is fourth-best all-time and second among starting pitchers (**J.R. Richard** - .186).
