BLUE JAYS NOTES:

- Improved to 6-1 in extra-inning contests, one more win than last season (5-14)...Played in back-to-back extra-inning games for first time since 4/25 and 4/27(1) at STL last season...Snapped their seven-game losing streak vs. AL East opponents and are now 9-17 in divisional games...Won for the 2nd time in 9 games...Won for the 2nd time in 12 games at Rogers Center...Was their 14th comefrom-behind win and 4th walk-off victory...Are now 6-7 in one-run games and 19-18 vs. right-handed starters...Recorded 12 hits, their most in a game since 5/16 at NYM (15H)...Have pitched 4 consecutive quality starts, their longest streak since doing so in 7 straight games from Sept. 21-28, 2016.
- ◆ **JAIME GARCIA** allowed a lone run on 4 hits over 6.0 innings...Was his 4th start of one-or-less runs and his 3rd quality start of the season...Now holds a 3.00 (9 ER/27.0 IP) at home (8.20 ERA on the road).
- CURTIS GRANDERSON got the Jays on the board with his 46th career leadoff home run...Tied Jimmy Rollins for 5th most all-time in leadoff home runs, one back of Ian Kinsler for the most among active players...The HR snapped a season-long 0-for-18 drought...Was his 26th home run vs. BAL, his most vs. any opponent (MIN-25).
- ◆ ALEDMYS DIAZ had the walk-off hit, a single in the 10th inning...Marked his 2nd career walk-off hit (also a single on 7/21/16 vs. SD)...Finished 2-for-5 with a double for his 6th multi-hit game.
- RANDAL GRICHUK doubled twice and drove in a pair of runs...Has 5 hits in his last 3 games, 4 for extra bases (3-2B, 1-HR)...Went 3-for-4 for his 1st three-hit game as a Blue Jay...Was his 4th multi-hit game, 3 of which have come in his last 6 games.
- **KENDRYS MORALES** went 2-for-5 on a pair of singles...Was his 6th multi-hit effort in his last 15 games (9th of the season), batting .308 (16-for-52) over that span.
- ◆ **KEVIN PILLAR** tied the game, 4-4, in the 9th inning with an RBI single...Has 2-RBI in his last 3 games (2-RBI in his 15 previous games)...Came into the game as a pinch-hitter in the 8th inning...Has played in all of Toronto's 62 games, the most among all MLB center fielders.
- ◆ **TEOSCAR HERNANDEZ** went 2-for-4 with a walk and a double...Has had 27 of his 47 hits go for extra bases (14-2B, 4-3B, 9-HR) for a 57.4 XBH%...Came into tonight ranked 5th in MLB in XBH%...Was his 13th multi-hit effort (45th game), 3rd most on the team.

ORIOLES NOTES:

- Are now 3-2 in extra-inning affairs...Fall to 9-24 on the road...Are now 9-17 vs. AL East opponents, tied with the Jays for the lowest divisional win% within the AL East (.346)...Hit back-to-back home runs for the 4th time (Valencia/Trumbo)...Homered 3 times and are now 8-4 in games with 3+ HR.
- **DAVID HESS** allowed 1 run over 6+ innings (5H, 2BB, 4K) in his 5th Major-League start...Marked his 4th quality start...The 4 strikeouts matched his personal best (5/20 at BOS)...Improved to 3-2 with a 2.91 ERA (10 ER/29.1 IP).
- AUSTIN WYNNS hit his 1st career home run, a solo shot to put the O's ahead, 2-1, in the 7th inning...Became the 22nd batter in team history to homer within his first 2 career games.
- ◆ **DANNY VALENCIA** hit his 6th home run, his 4th vs. an AL East opponent...Went 2-for-4 and walked...Over his last 24 games, has hit .341 (28-for-82) with 3-2B, 1-3B, 4-HR and 12-RBI.
- ♦ MARK TRUMBO followed up Valencia's HR with one of his own, forming Baltimore's 4th back-to-back HRs this season...Was his 3rd homer of the season...Went 2-for-4 and has gone 31-for-106 (.292) in his 28 games played this season, including 7-2B, 3-HR and 9-RBI.
- ◆ MANNY MACHADO singled and opened the scoring with a sac fly as part of a 1-for-4 night...The RBI was his 13th the 1st inning this season...Came into tonight with the MLB lead in 1st-inning HR (7) and tied for 3rd in the AL in 1st-inning RBI (12) while batting .333 (18-54) in the opening frame.
