**THE TWINS:** The Twins have gone 2-5 through seven games on their nine-game roadtrip, going 1-2 in Cleveland, 1-2 in Texas and 0-1 in Houston...tonight the Twins will continue the trip with the second of three at Houston...following tomorrow night's finale with the Astros, the Twins will travel to Minneapolis for an off-day on Thursday then play three vs. the Royals over the weekend and three vs. the Yankees next Monday-Wednesday.

**TWINS GET TAKEN IN TEXAS AGAIN:** The Twins lost to the Astros yesterday afternoon by a score of 4-1 at Minute Maid Park, suffering their third straight loss in Texas (2 in Arlington last weekend)...Kyle Gibson (7-12) was the starter and loser, allowing four runs (2 earned) on four hits in 7.0 innings pitched...the four total hits allowed by Twins pitching marked the fourth time this season losing when allowing fewer than five hits...the offense recorded eight hits, two from Joe Mauer, his third straight two-hit game and fifth time in his last eight.

**TWINS AND ASTROS:** The Twins are playing the fifth of six games against the Astros this season...the Twins have gone 2-2 vs. the Astros this season...the Twins are 27-28 all-time against the Astros, including a record of 16-19 since the Houston joined the American League in 2013...they have won just three times in their last 13 meetings with the Astros.

☞ Joe Mauer has hit safely in each of his last 12 games vs. Houston, hitting .333 (16-for-48) in that span.  
☞ Jorge Polanco is hitting .325 (13-for-40) in 10 career games vs. Houston.  
☞ Tyler Duffey was born in Houston and was a 2009 graduate of Bellaire High School, roughly 12 miles southwest of Minute Maid Park...Duffey also pitched for Rice University from 2010-2012.  
☞ Kohl Stewart was born in Houston and was a 2013 graduate of St. Pius X High School, roughly eight miles north of Minute Maid Park.

**ROSTER MOVES:** Twins have recalled right-handed pitchers Chase De Jong and John Curtiss from Triple-A Rochester and have selected the contract of infielder Gregorio Petit:

☞ De Jong, 24, was acquired by the Twins from the Seattle Mariners in exchange for Zach Duke on July 30 and appeared in seven games (5 starts) for the Red Wings posting a 2-3 record with a 3.20 ERA (39.1 IP, 14 ER)...prior to the trade, De Jong started 21 games for Double-A Arkansas (Seattle), going 5-5 with a 3.80 ERA (120.2 IP, 51 ER), 34 walks and 89 strikeouts...he went 0-3 with a 6.35 ERA (28.1 IP, 20 ER), 13 walks, and 13 strikeouts in seven games (4 starts) with Seattle last season.  
☞ Curtiss, 25, appeared in 38 games for the Red Wings this season posting a 2.77 ERA (55.1 IP, 17 ER) with 61 strikeouts while converting 10 saves in 12 opportunities.  
☞ Petit, 33, appeared in 79 games for the Red Wings this season, hitting .268 (76-for-284) with 12 doubles, one triple, one home run, 29 RBI and 31 runs scored...Petit hit .308 (8-for-26) with four walks in 12 games for the Twins earlier this season.  
☞ To make room for Petit on the Twins 40-man roster, they have transferred first baseman/designated hitter Logan Morrison to the 60-day disabled list...Morrison had surgery on his left hip last month, ending his season.  
☞ The Twins now have active 34 players on their major league roster...only players on the 40-man that are not with the Twins are Ervin Santana (DL), Aaron Slegers (DL), Byron Buxton, Fernando Romero, Zack Granite and Lewis Thorpe.

**TWO-HIT JOE:** In 11 games, since August 21, Joe Mauer is hitting .333 (16-for-48) with four doubles and six two-hit games...he has three straight two-hit games...Joe Mauer is hitting .329 (26-for-79) with 15 walks and a .436 on-base percentage lifetime against Justin Verlander...only Billy Butler has more hits off Verlander in his career and nobody has walked more than Mauer.

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 2010, Jim Thome hit his 583rd and 584th career home runs to pass Mark McGwire and take over ninth place on baseball's all-time list in a Twins 12-4 win over Texas...Thome currently ranks eighth on baseball's all-time list.

☞ Jake Cave is hitting .400 (6-for-15) with three home runs and four RBI in his last four games.  
☞ Taylor Rogers enters tonight with a 14.2 scoreless innings streak.  
☞ Joe Mauer leads baseball in batting average with runners in scoring position (.406), ahead of J.D. Martinez (.405) and Yuli Gurriel (.395).  
☞ The Twins have gone just 2-8 in their last 10 games overall.
