THE TWINS: After completing their six-game homestand with a record of 4-2 (1-2 vs. Cleveland and 3-0 vs. Kansas City), the Twins began their seven-game roadtrip with a loss and a win against the Indians this week...tonight they will play the third of four at Progressive Field...following this series, they will travel to Detroit for three vs. the Tigers over the weekend...the Twins are 18-11 in 29 games since July 5.

THREE-RUN JACK ALL TWINS NEED: The Twins beat the Indians last night by a score of 3-2 at Progressive Field...Adalberto Mejía (2-0) was the starter and winner, pitching 5.0 shutout innings with one hit allowed and one walk...he exited the game early with a left wrist strain...the offense recorded 11 hits, four from Eddie Rosario...Mitch Garver gave the Twins their only runs, hitting a three-run homer in the second inning.

TWINS AND TRIBE: The Twins are playing the Indians for the 15th of 19 scheduled meetings this season and for the sixth time of 10 scheduled games at Progressive Field...they have gone 8-6 vs. the Tribe, 4-3 at Target Field, 1-1 in Puerto Rico and 3-2 at Cleveland...eight wins are their most vs. any opponent this season.

☞ The Twins are 14-9 in their last 23 at Progressive Field and 9-5 in their last 14.

☞ Eddie Rosario is hitting .340 (80-for-235) with 12 doubles, three triples, 15 home runs, 34 RBI and 39 runs scored in 62 career games vs. Cleveland; the homers, hits and RBI all being his personal most vs. any opponent...his 80 hits vs. CLE since 2015 lead baseball...in 30 career games at Progressive Field, he is hitting .381 (45-for-118); in his last eight games here, he has four hits three times and three hits once.

☞ Miguel Sanó has reached safely in each of his last 12 vs. the Indians.

☞ Joe Mauer is hitting .315 (117-for-371) with 34 doubles, 48 walks and a .393 on-base percentage in 95 career games at Progressive...he's hitting .361 (30-for-83) in his last 20 here...Mauer is hitting .318 (233-for-732) with 51 doubles, 14 home runs, 78 RBI, 101 walks, 110 runs scored and .400 on-base percentage in 192 career games vs. the Indians...233 hits are his second most vs. any opponent (247 vs. KC)...among actives vs. Cleveland, he ranks first in doubles and walks and second in hits.

☞ Mauer is 5-for-11 (.455) with a walk lifetime vs. Mike Clevinger.

ROSIE RAKES: Eddie Rosario is hitting .299 (135-for-452) with 28 doubles, 20 home runs, 66 RBI, 72 runs scored and a .339 on-base percentage in 111 games this season...he has 43 multi-hit games this season, fourth most in baseball, trailing Francisco Lindor (45), Nick Markakis (45) and J.D. Martinez (44)...he leads the Twins in hits, runs, home runs and RBI.

GARVER GOING GOOD: Mitch Garver is hitting .325 (27-for-83) with four doubles, one triple, four home runs, 17 RBI, 12 walks, 13 runs scored, a .411 on-base percentage and a .953 OPS in his last 30 games, since June 21...since that date, he ranks eighth in the AL in batting average (minimum 80 plate appearances), and 10th in on-base percentage.

SANÓ STORMING: Miguel Sanó is hitting .320 (8-for-25) with three doubles, three RBI, six walks and a .452 on-base percentage in his last eight games...since being recalled on July 28, he is hitting .250 (8-for-32) with six walks and a .368 on-base percentage, compared to .203 (30-for-148) with a .270 on-base percentage prior to being optioned to the minor leagues on June 14...he has reached safely in eight straight games overall.

IT'S A MIDWEST THING: The Midwest League and MiLB.com announced recently that Kernels pitcher Jhoan Duran and catcher Ryan Jeffers have been named the Midwest League Pitcher and Player of the Week for the period ending August 6th...Duran made two starts last week, posting a 1-0 record and not allowing an earned run in 13.1 innings pitch...he scattered five hits and struck out 17 while walking just three...he was acquired by the Twins in a trade with the Diamondbacks on July 27 as one of three minor league prospects for Eduardo Escobar...Jeffers hit .538 (14-26) in seven games last week, with three home runs and eight RBI...he also added six doubles, drew four walks and posted a 1.115 OBPS...he was selected by the Twins in the second round of the 2018 First Year Player Draft out of UNC Wilmington...Duran and Jeffers join Jose Miranda, Jordan Balazovic and Alex Kirilloff as the five Kernels to earn MWL weekly honors this season.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1998, Paul Molitor stole his 500th base against Baltimore, becoming the sixth player in baseball history with 500 steals and 3,000 hits (7 now - Henderson, Cobb, Collins, Wagner, Suzuki & Brock)...in 2004, the A's beat the Twins, 6-5, in 18 innings, marking the second-longest game in the 23-year history of the Metrodome.

RBI WORLD SERIES: 24 baseball and softball teams, including baseball squads from Uganda and Curaçao, have advanced to the 26th edition of the Reviving Baseball in Inner Cities (RBI) World Series, which will once again be hosted by the Twins in Minneapolis & St. Paul...the Twins hosted the RBI World Series from 2011-2013...the tournament began Monday and runs through Thursday, August 16.

LAST START: Odorizzi did not factor in the decision in his last start against Kansas City on August 3...his start was cut short by a rain delay in the top of the fourth inning as he did not re-enter the game after the delay...did not allow a walk and struck out two in the start...allowed his 18th home run of the season to Salvador Perez in the top of the third inning...is still in search of his first division win of the season.

AGAINST CLEVELAND: Odorizzi is making his eighth career-start against the Indians and fourth of the season...is 0-2 with a 9.88 ERA (13.2 IP, 15 ER) with seven walks and 14 strikeouts...his last start against the Indians came at Progressive Field on June 17 where he suffered the loss after 5.0 innings and four runs on six hits, four walks and five strikeouts...has not recorded a quality start against Cleveland in any of his seven career starts...only win came at Cleveland on May 16, 2017 after 6.0 innings and four runs on seven hits.

ON THE FIRST PITCH: Through his 23 starts this season, Odorizzi has allowed a .500 (22-for-44) average on the first pitch against a batter...on the 0-0 count, five of the 21 hits have been home runs and seven have been doubles...his .500 average is the highest of any full season in his career.

- On the contrary, when Odorizzi gets two strikes on a batter he is holding hitters to a .191 (51-for-267) average.

QUALITY NOT QUANTITY: Over his 23 starts this season, Odorizzi has averaged just over 5.0 innings/start...of starters with at least 23 starts, his 115.1 innings ranks as the fewest in MLB...his 19.1 pitches/inning ranks highest in MLB...he averages 4.35 pitches/batter faced which is most in MLB...though his starts have been on the short side, his 59 earned runs allowed ranks 10th fewest in the American League among qualified pitchers who have started at least 23 games.

HOME AND ROAD: Has gone 3-3, 5.13 ERA (52.2 IP, 30 ER) in 11 home starts this season, compared to 1-4, 4.16 ERA (62.2 IP, 29 ER) in 12 road starts...his .200 winning percentage on the road ranks fifth lowest in MLB among starters with at least 10 road starts.

STILL NEED HELP: In Odorizzi's 23 starts in 2018, the Twins offense has supplied 56 total runs, good for a run support average of 4.37 runs per game...the 56 runs of support rank third fewest in baseball among starters with at least 23 starts.

FLY AWAY: In 2017 Odorizzi ranked fourth among all major league pitchers in Fly Ball Percentage (min. 140.0 IP) with a rate of 47.3%...he trailed Ariel Miranda of Seattle (52.2%), Marco Estrada of Toronto (50.3%), and Ian Kennedy of Kansas City (47.7%)...since 2014 Odorizzi has ranked in the top-10 in fly ball percentage every season: 2014 (2nd, 48.7%), 2015 (10th, 40.6%), and 2016 (9th, 44.4%)...in 2018, Odorizzi has allowed 149 fly balls, eighth most in baseball.

A BRIGHT START: Odorizzi pitched in his first career Opening Day start and first career start for the Twins...he went 6.0 innings and allowed just two hits, while not allowing a run and striking out seven...only five other times in his career has he notched seven or more strikeouts while not allowing a run in 6.0-plus innings, the first since April 8, 2015 vs. Baltimore...he became the eighth different pitcher to start Opening Day for the Twins in the last 12 seasons.

2017 RECAP:

- In his fourth full professional season, Odorizzi started 28 games and tossed 143.1 innings...with a 10-8 record, this marked his third season of a .500 or better record
- His 7.97 K/9.0 IP ranked T-2nd best in his career (other, 2015 and best, 2014 with 9.32).
- On September 23, Odorizzi recorded nine strikeouts, a season high, while allowing just one run on three hits in 6.0 innings.
- Odorizzi held right-handed batters to a .228 average and lefties to a .210 average against.

- Selected by Milwaukee in the first round (32nd overall) of 2008 First-Year Player Draft, traded to Kansas City in 2010, then in 2012 traded to Tampa Bay where he remained until his trade to Minnesota on February 17, 2018.
- 2017 marked his fourth straight year of at least 28 starts.
- On May 29, 2016 vs. New York-AL, retired his first 16 batters-faced, tied for third-longest perfect game bid in Rays history.
- Established career-highs in 2016 for starts (33) and innings pitched (187.2).
- In 2016 allowed 2 ER or fewer in 13 of his no-decisions, a mark reached by only one other pitcher since 1913.
- Earned his first major league win in his season debut on April 4, 2014 vs. Texas.
