**DON'T STEAL MY SERIES, GYPSY:** Yesterday afternoon, the Padres bested the Dodgers 3-0 in the final game of the 2018 Mexico Series in Monterrey...it was the first series win vs. LAD since they took three of four games during Labor Day weekend last year at Petco Park (Sept. 1-3, 2017)...it also was the first time the Friars shut out an opponent in 2018, and it was the first rubber match victory of the season for San Diego (1-5 in such games).

- Starter **Eric Lauer** recorded his first Major League victory, working a career-high 6.0 innings without allowing a run on seven hits.
- 1B **Eric Hosmer** hit his second home run in as many games, marking the first time he's accomplished the feat in Padre uniform.

**ROSTER MOVES:** Today, the Padres reinstated LHP **Matt Strahm** from the 10-day disabled list (torn left patellar tendon) and optioned RHP **Kazuhisa Makita** to El Paso (AAA)...INF **Javy Guerra** (the 26th man for the Mexico series) was returned to El Paso.

**INSIDE THE SERIES:** The Padres look to take Game 1 of the three-game set vs. WSH, having gone 0-6 in series openers at home this season...the last series victory the Padres have claimed over WSH dates back to July 22-24, 2016 in DC, and the last series win in San Diego was from May 28-30, 2010.

**RACE TO THE START LINE:** When the Padres score first in a game, they are 11-1, which is the best record in baseball...the Nationals, however, have scored before their opponents 25 times this season, which is the most in baseball...the Padres have scored first in 12 games, the second-fewest games of any team (ahead of CIN's 10).

**BIG DIFF:** The Padres have the third-largest batting average differential between wins and losses of any club...they've hit .295 in their wins and .187 in losses (a .108 differential)...only the Brewers (.111 dif.) and the Cubs (.109 dif) have a larger differential.

**2 OUTS? NO PROBLEM:** The Padres are the only team this season that has scored more than half of its runs with two outs...they've plated 50.7 percent of their runs in such scenarios.

**ELITE COMPANY:** Since the start of last season, only five batters have a .300+ batting average along with at least 100 runs, 100 RBI and 75 walks...two of them (**Eric Hosmer** and Bryce Harper) will go head-to-head this series (Hosmer with a .315 average, 116 runs, 106 RBI and 87 walks and Harper with a .303 average, 124 runs, 115 RBI and 107 walks)...the full list includes Nolan Arenado, Charlie Blackmon, Joey Votto, Hosmer and Harper.

**¡VAMOS VILLANUEVA!** **Christian Villanueva** has hit 13 home runs through his first 40 big-league games, and only five right-handed batters (Rhys Hoskins, Wally Berger, Gary Sanchez, Jose Abreu and Albert Pujols) have had more through 40 career games since 1913 (most recently since Hoskins in 2017).

**DOUBLE ORDER OF FRANCHFRIES, PLS:** OF **Franchy Cordero** has reached base safely in a career-high 10 consecutive games...he has eight walks in that time, a .452 OBP and is averaging a walk every 5.25 plate appearances.

**YOU'VE GOT A FRAN IN ME:** 22-year-old OF **Franmil Reyes** was named Pacific Coast League's Player of the Week for April 30-May 6...his 17 hits, 11 extra-base hits, eight home runs, 44 total bases and 13 runs all led minor league baseball... he hit .607 (17-for-28) with 14 RBI, 1.571 SLG and a 2.217 OPS, and he has homered in five consecutive games, including a stretch that saw him post three straight multi-homer games.

## STARTING PITCHER NOTES

**#38 RHP TYSON ROSS (2-2, 3.28)** @TysonRoss

**HOME SWEET TYSON:** 31-year-old RHP **Tyson Ross** (who turned 31 on April 22) is set to face the Nationals for the first time since August 26, 2015.

- Is 2-0 with a 2.25 ERA in his two starts at Petco Park this season.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not factor into the win in SD's 3-2 victory on 5/1 at SF, tossing 6.0 IP of one-run ball on four hits and three walks while striking out nine.

**THE TYSON WE KNOW & LOVE:** While battling injuries from 2016-17, Tyson posted a 8.12 ERA, a 1.84 WHIP, a .286 opponent batting average and ratios of 6.79 K/9 IP and 1.08 K/BB across 13 appearances (11 starts).

- Over his 99 games (80 starts) from 2013-15, he posted a 3.07 ERA, a 1.23 WHIP, a .232 batting average, and ratios of 9.16 K/9 IP and 2.63 K/BB.
- Returning to form over his six starts in 2018, Tyson has posted a 3.28 ERA, 1.18 WHIP, .218 average and ratios of 10.09 K/9 IP and 3.08 K/BB.

**TRIPLE DIGITS TYSON:** Ross' 127 pitches on 4/20 at ARI marked his third consecutive game throwing 100 pitches or more...it's the first time he has reached triple digits in three straight since June 10-20, 2015.

- The 127 pitches were the most thrown by a pitcher in the majors so far this season (second-most, 122 by **CLE Trevor Bauer** on 4/30)...teammate **Clayton Richard** threw the single-game high in 2017 (127 on June 13, 2017 vs. CIN).
- His 101.8 pitches per game ranks fifth in the majors.

**NO EXTRA BAGS:** Has allowed just six extra base hits, which is tied for the third-fewest among all pitchers (min. 35.0 IP)

**KEEPIN' IT IN THE YARD:** Has not allowed a home run in five of his six starts...allowed his lone two long balls on 4/8 at HOU.

- Is one of just 13 pitchers to have tossed at least 35.0 innings and allowed two home runs or fewer.
- His 0.50 HR/9 IP is 13th lowest in the majors and eighth lowest in the National League.

**SO CLOSE:** Tyson took a no-hitter in the eighth inning on 4/20 at ARI, tossing 7.2 IP of one-hit, one-run ball behind 10 strikeouts, one shy of his career high in the Padres' 4-1 victory.

- It marked the 21st time a Padre took a no-hitter into the eighth inning (most recently: Odrisamer Despaigne on 7/25/14 vs. NYM)...it was the 29th one-hitter in franchise history.

### TOMORROW'S STARTER

**CLAYTON'S TURN:** LHP **Clayton Richard** is set to make his team-leading eighth start of the season tomorrow night in Game 2 of this three-game tilt against the Nationals.

- His 3.67 ERA against the Nationals is his lowest ERA against an NL opponent that he has made at least eight starts against.
- Allowed a season-high seven runs (six earned) his last time out on 5/2 at SF.
