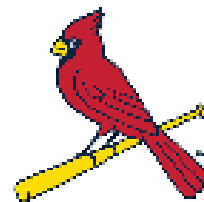

ROAD TRIPPIN' REDBIRDS: The Cardinals continue their a nine-game/10-day road trip to Arizona, San Francisco and Chicago (AL) tonight with the last of three games against the first place Arizona Diamondbacks. Last night, the Cardinals fell to the Diamondbacks 4-2, despite holding a 2-1 lead. **Paul Goldschmidt** hit an opposite field two-strike, three-run home run in the 5th inning to sink the Cardinals as the Arizona bullpen supported **Zack Greinke (W, 9-5)** with 2.1 scoreless innings without allowing a hit for the win. The Cardinals fell to 6.5 games back of first place Milwaukee and 5.5 behind second place Chicago in the N.L. Central...with a win today, the Cardinals would split the season series with Arizona.

FOUR SCORES AND FIVE YEARS AGO... The Cardinals play on the road on the 4th of July for the first time since 2013 when they played the Los Angeles Angels on July 4, 2013 at Angels Stadium. The 'Halos' rallied for three runs in the 9th to win 6-5 on a walk-off single by Erick Aybar scoring Howie Kendrick.

MEMPHIS REHAB PARTY PREVAILS: **Paul DeJong** was 2-for-4 with a home run, a double, two RBI and two runs scored while playing shortstop for all nine innings in his fourth rehab game at Memphis (AAA). DeJong is batting .308 (4-13) with a home run and two doubles in four games. **Matt Bowman** (3rd appearance, 3.0 IP, 5 K) threw a scoreless inning with two strikeouts and **Luke Gregerson** (2nd appearance, 2.0 IP, 3 K) allowed an unearned run with a strikeout in an inning of work.

FOWLER FAMILY FIREWORKS: **Dexter Fowler** and wife Aliya welcomed **Ivy Noor Fowler** to their family yesterday as Maya Fowler became an older sister. Fowler went on Paternity Leave July 2 and has missed the last two games but is expected to rejoin the team soon.

CATCHING SIMBA: **Yadier Molina** has caught 1,770 games over his 15-year career and ranks 16th all-time in Major League Baseball. With a game tonight, Molina will catch **Ted Simmons** for 15th place. The only catcher in MLB with more games caught over a 15-year career is **Jason Kendall**, who caught 2,025 over his 15-year career with the Pirates, Athletics, Cubs, Brewers and Royals.

BARNSTORMING BASHING BACKSTOP: **Yadier Molina** hit his 12th home run of the season Monday night, with 11 of them coming on the road this year. Molina ranks T4th (**Blackmon**, COL) in the National League with 11 road home runs (1. **Albies** 14, ATL; T2. **Desmond** 13, COL; T2. **Goldschmidt** 13, ARI) Last season, Molina hit 11 of his 18 home runs on the road and had his highest total with 13 road jacks in 2012. Molina has hit six home runs over his last nine road games and hit five home runs in his first eight road games of the season.

STARTING SUCCESS: Of the Cardinals 20 road wins this season, 16 have come from the starting pitchers with tonight's starting pitcher **Miles Mikolas** and **Luke Weaver** leading the way with four each. **Jordan Hicks** (2), **Bud Norris** (1) and **Sam Tuivailala** (1) are the only Cardinals relievers to record a win on the road this season.

THE SNAKE CHARMER: Since **Mike Matheny** took the helm as the Cardinals manager in 2012, the team has won or tied 5 of the 6 series played at Chase Field including a three-game sweep in 2012 and a four-game sweep in 2015. The Cardinals are 15-7 at Chase Field under Matheny and his overall record against Arizona is 29-16. As a player, Matheny hit more home runs against the Diamondbacks than any other team, smacking seven of his 67 career vs. Arizona.

LONG TIME GONE: This is the Cardinals longest road trip of the season thus far and tied for longest of the season (9 games, Aug. 3-13 - PIT, MIA, KC). The last time the Cardinals played a nine-game road trip was September 15-24, 2017 (CHI, CIN, PIT).

OUT OF THE NEST: The Cardinals have played 39 road games, the 4th-fewest in the Majors, trailing the Dodgers (37), Phillies (38) and Yankees (38). The Cardinals will play a total of 17 road games in the month of July.

RIDING IN STYLE: **Bud Norris** locked down is 16th save of the season on Monday, and did it in style. The perfect inning came right after Norris rode in from right field on the Diamondbacks bullpen cart. Norris is the 9th pitcher to use the bullpen cart this season in Arizona.

Cardinals pitcher **Dominic Leone** pitched parts of two seasons (2015-16) with Arizona...originally traded by Seattle with catcher **Wellington Castillo** and infielder **Jack Reinheimer** to Arizona for pitcher **Vidal Nuno** and outfielder **Mark Trumbo** (June 3, 2015).

Cardinals assistant hitting coach **Bill Mueller** played parts of two seasons (1995-96) for the Phoenix Firebirds (AAA) as a member of the San Francisco Giants organization.

Cardinals assistant coach **Willie McGee** rehabbed for four games with the Phoenix Firebirds (AAA) as a member of the San Francisco Giants organization in 1991.

Cardinals President of Operations **John Mozeliak** attended the University of Arizona before graduating from the University of Colorado at Boulder.

Cardinals Senior Special Assistant to the General Manager **Bob Gebhard** worked for the Diamondbacks as Vice President & Special Assistant to the GM for 12 seasons (2005-16).

Diamondbacks pitcher **Shelby Miller** pitched parts of three seasons with St. Louis (2012-14)...originally selected by the Cardinals in the first round (19th overall) in the 2009 MLB Draft...later traded by St. Louis with pitcher Tyrell Jenkins to Atlanta for outfielder Jason Heyward and pitcher Jordan Walden (November 17, 2014).

Cardinals pitcher **John Brebbia** was selected by the Cardinals from the Diamondbacks in the Triple-A phase of the 2015 Rule 5 Draft.

Diamondbacks infielder **Daniel Descalso** played parts of five seasons in a Cardinals uniform (2010-14)...appeared in 44 postseason games and was a member of the 2011 World Champion Cardinals...originally selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2007 MLB Draft.

Diamondbacks Outfielder **Jon Jay** played six seasons with St. Louis (2010-15)...member of 2011 World Series Champions, where he was one of six Cardinals to play in all 18 postseason games...appeared on Cardinals postseason roster for five straight seasons (2011-15)...originally selected by St. Louis in the 2nd round of the 2006 MLB Draft...later traded by St. Louis to San Diego for infielder **Jedd Gyorko** and cash (Dec. 8, 2015).

Diamondbacks outfielder **David Peralta** was originally signed by the Cardinals as a non-drafted free agent pitcher (Sept. 26, 2004)...pitched three minor league seasons (2005-07)...underwent pair of left-shoulder surgeries...released in May 2009.

Diamondbacks Vice President, Player Development **Mike Bell** is the younger brother of former Cardinals Bench Coach **David Bell**...Mike also played in eight games for the Memphis Redbirds (AAA) in 2005.

Diamondbacks pitcher **Fernando Salas** pitched parts of four seasons with St. Louis (2010-13)...was a member of the 2011 World Series Champions...converted a team-leading 24 saves for St. Louis in 2011...originally purchased by St. Louis from Triple-A Saffillo Saraperos of the Mexican League (April 5, 2007).

Cardinals Hall of Fame Manager **Tony La Russa** served as the Diamondbacks Chief Baseball Analyst for four seasons (2014-17).

Diamondbacks First Base Coach **Dave McKay** served in the same position for the Cardinals (1996-2011) under La Russa.

Diamondbacks Pitching Strategist **Dan Haren** was drafted by St. Louis in the 2nd round of the 2001 MLB draft...pitched two seasons with St. Louis (2003-04)...later traded by the Cardinals with catcher **Daric Barton** and pitcher **Kiko Calero** to Oakland for pitcher **Mark Mulder** (Dec. 18, 2004).

Diamondbacks Pro Scout **Pete Vuckovich** pitched three seasons in St. Louis (1978-80)...later traded by the Cardinals with pitcher **Rollie Fingers** and catcher **Ted Simmons** to the Brewers for pitchers **Lary Sorensen** and **Dave LaPoint** and outfielders **David Green** and **Sixto Lezcano** (Dec. 12, 1980).

Diamondbacks Player & Media Relations Intern **Sydney Sloas** served as the Cardinals 2017 Spring Training Intern at Jupiter, Fla.

TONIGHT'S GAME

- Makes his 54th career appearance (27th start) tonight in his 17th start of the season.
- Has made three career minor league relief appearances on Independence Day, all as a member of the Padres minor league organization (2010-11, '13).
- Ranks 2nd in MLB with in fewest walks/9 IP (1.11) behind Corey Kluber (0.98), and ranks in the N.L. top-10 in wins (8, T6th), winning pct. (.727, T6th), ERA (2.61, 6th), WHIP (0.99, 2nd), innings pitched (103.1, 9th), strikeout/walk ratio (5.54, 3rd), base-runners/9 IP (9.23, 3rd) and HR/9 IP (0.70, 5th)
- Pitched 7.0 or more innings in six starts (T6th in NL) and at least 6.0 innings in 13 of his 16 starts this season (T5th in the NL).

LAST TIME OUT

- Earned a tough-luck loss in a quality start against the Braves last Friday at Busch Stadium, allowing one run to lose a shutout in the 7th inning, but lowering his ERA to 2.61.
- Four of his five hits allowed did not leave the infield.
- Marked the fourth time in June to receive one run or fewer of support in a start.

- Leads all National League pitchers with the fewest pitches per inning (14.6).
- Sports an 8-0 record with three no-decisions (St. Louis is 9-2) when receiving two or more runs of support in a start.
- Received NL-leading 6.24 runs of support in his first 10 starts to begin the season (3/29-5/31), but just eight runs of support in his last six starts...his 1.95 run support average since June 1 is the 3rd-lowest in the NL.
- Ranks T5th in the N.L. with six starts without issuing a walk, trailing Corey Kluber (CLE, 9), Ivan Nova (PIT, 8), Ross Stripling (LAD, 7) and Alex Wood (LAD, 7).
- Mikolas (13 BB, 16 GS) and CLE's Corey Kluber (13 BB, 17 GS) are the only MLB pitchers to issue fewer walks than games started this season.
- Is 2nd in the National League with a 1.65 ERA in eight home starts (10 ER/54.2 IP), the 5th-lowest home ERA in MLB. He's 4-0 with a 3.70 ERA in 8 road starts.
- Is one of 14 pitchers in MLB and five in the National League with a shutout this season.
- Earned his team-high 8th win of the season on 6/23, as the Cardinals snapped a 3-game losing skid with a 3-2 win at MIL. Allowed two 1st inning runs, then blanked the Crew over his final 5.2 IP, setting down 15-straight from the 2nd to the 7th.
