#### The Count

**RHP Corbin Burnes** is the 46th player to appear on the Brewers roster this year.... this ties the Crew with the Mets for the second-most total players used this year....only the Angels have used more players at 50....the franchise record is 53, done by the Seattle Pilots (1969)....the Brewers used a total of 50 players in each of the last two seasons.

#### Nottingham to See Here

**C Jacob Nottingham** begins his second stint with the Brewers today....the team has a 0.47 ERA when he catches (19ip, 1er) and is 2-0 in his starts.

#### One! Singular Sensation...

The Brewers are 21-11 in 1-run games this season....the team's 21 wins lead the National League and is only behind the Mariners' 26 for the most in the Major Leagues.

#### Hit a Homer and it's Over

The Brewers are 46-14 when hitting a home run....the team's .767 winning percentage in such games is the best in the National League and trails only Boston (.769) for the Major League lead.

**ON THE ROAD:** The Brewers are 24-18 on the road, going 8-4-2 in series play....had a season-high 5-game road winning streak from 4/30-5/11....the team went 40-38 on the road last season, going 13-11-2 in series play.

**MANAGER:** **Craig Counsell** is in his fourth season as manager of the Brewers (272-278) and third full season....he was named the 19th manager in franchise history on 5/4/15, replacing **Ron Roenicke**....bio is on p. 44 of the media guide.

**COACHES:** Hitting coach **Darnell Coles** (4th season), pitching coach **Derek Johnson** (3rd season), coach **Jason Lane** (3rd season), bench coach **Pat Murphy** (3rd season), third base coach **Ed Sedar** (12th season, 8th as 3B coach), first base/infield coach **Carlos Subero** (3rd season) and bullpen coach **Lee Tunnell** (6th season) all returned from the 2017 staff.

# TODAY'S STARTER: #41 - RHP JUNIOR GUERRA (16gs, 5-5, 2.87)

**GUERRA AT A GLANCE:** Junior Guerra, 33, will be making his 17th start of the season.... Guerra last started on Tuesday vs. Minnesota and earned a 2-0 win (5ip, 2h, 3bb, 8k, 1wp).... the team is 9-7 in his starts....he has produced 6 quality starts....opponents are batting .217 (70-for-322, 10hr)....Guerra began the season at Triple-A Colorado Springs, where he earned a win in his only start on 4/5 at Omaha....he was claimed off waivers from Chicago-AL on 10/7/15....bio is on p. 97 of the media guide.

**YOU NEVER FORGET YOUR FIRST:** When he was claimed off waivers from the White Sox on 10/7/15, Guerra became the first player acquired under GM David Stearns, who joined the team on 9/21/15.

**LAST SEASON:** Guerra, the Opening Day starter for the Brewers in 2017, went 1-4 with a 5.12 ERA in 21 games / 14 starts....the Brewers went 4-10 in his starts....he produced 4 quality starts....opponents batted .230 (61-for-265, 18hr)....he went 1-4 with a 5.20 ERA as a starter (64ip, 37er) and 0-0 with a 4.26 ERA in relief (6.1ip, 3er)....Guerra had a pair of stints on the disabled list last season, coming from 4/4-5/25 (right calf strain) and 7/9-7/17 (right shin contusion).

**CAREER:** Is 15-12 with a 3.46 ERA in 60 games / 50 starts (283.2ip, 109er)....has pitched for Chicago-AL (2015) and Milwaukee (2016-current).

**CAREER AT MILLER PARK:** Is 7-6 with a 2.77 ERA in 32 games / 26 starts (152.2ip, 47er).... is 2-3 with a 2.67 ERA in 10 starts this season (54ip, 16er).

**CAREER ON THE ROAD:** Is 8-6 with a 4.26 ERA in 28 games / 24 starts (131ip, 62er)....is 3-2 with a 3.21 ERA in 6 starts this season (33.2ip, 12er).

**CAREER vs. ATLANTA:** Made his only appearance in a start on 5/25/16 at Turner Field and received no decision in the Brewers' 3-2, 13-inning win (5ip, 4h, 4bb, 6k, 1wp).

**CAREER AT THE PLATE:** Is batting .114 (8-for-70)....has not homered....has not walked and has 24 strikeouts.

**THIS SEASON:** Is 0-for-19 with 7 strikeouts....has 2 sacrifice bunts.
