CHICAGO CUBS NOTES

WILLSON CONTRERAS (4-for-5, 2 2B, 2 HR, 7 RBI, 2 R) recorded a career-high seven RBI as he notched two doubles and two homers, including his second-career grand slam ... marked the most RBI by a Cub since Aramis Ramirez, July 20, 2010 vs. Houston (seven RBI).

- © To recap his last two games, he has gone 7-for-10 with three doubles, two triples, two homers, eight RBI and four runs scored ... all his hits have been of the extra-base variety.
- © According to STATS Inc., he is the first Cubs player since at least 1913 to record seven extra-base hits in a two-game span.
- © STATS Inc. also notes that he is the fourth MLB player since at least 1913 to record at least two doubles, two triples and two homers in a two-game span, joining Colorado's Larry Walker (May 1996), Milwaukee's Hank Aaron (Sept. 1960) and New York's Dusty Rhodes (August 1954).
- © Is only the second Cub since at least 1908 to record at least four extra-base hits and seven RBI in a single game, joining George Mitterwald, April 17, 1974 vs. Pittsburgh (2B, 3 HR, 8 RBI).
- © Became the first Cubs player with at least three extra-base hits in consecutive games since Billy Williams, September 8-10, 1968 ... Randy Hundley in August of 1966 is the only other Cub since at least 1908 to accomplish the feat.
- © Is the second MLB player this season with seven RBI in a game, joining Didi Gregorius, April 3 vs. Tampa Bay (eight RBI).
- © Was the fourth multi-homer game of his career (last, August 6, 2017 vs. Washington).
- © His 12 doubles are the most on the team.

KRIS BRYANT (2-for-3, HR, 2 RBI, 3 R, HBP, 2 BB) reached base five times and hit a solo home run in the fourth inning, his seventh of the season ... has gone deep in five of his last eight contests ... he's batting .471 (8-for-17) with four home runs, two doubles, seven RBI and 11 runs scored in his last five home games.

- © Has scored at least two runs in a career-high four-straight games.
- © Has been hit by an MLB-leading nine pitches this season.

ANTHONY RIZZO (1-for-3, RBI, 2 R, 2 BB) drove in the first run of the game with an RBI-single in the first inning ... hitting .353 (12-for-34) with 11 RBI in the month of May.

TYLER CHATWOOD earned his third win of the season and improved to 2-0 in interleague play this year ... since starting 0-3, he is 3-0 with a 2.45 ERA (6 ER/22.0 IP) and 20 strikeouts in his last four starts.

- © Walked five batters while allowing just three hits ... has walked at least five batters in five of his seven starts this season.

NOTES: The Cubs have won four-straight games and improved to 10-2 in their last 12 games at Wrigley Field ... are 6-1 in their last seven games against the White Sox.

- © The Cubs notched 10 extra-base hits Wednesday and seven extra-base hits today ... marks the first time the club has recorded consecutive games with at least seven extra-base hits since September 11-12, 2011.
- © The Cubs scored five first inning runs and four seventh inning runs ... have scored 28 runs in both the first and seventh innings, their most in any innings this season ... have scored at least one run in the first inning in four of their last five games.
- © The Cubs have scored 10-or-more runs in three of their last four games and in a major league-most eight games this season.
- © Have outscored their opponents 42-11 in four games this homestand.
- © Ben Zobrist (3-for-6, 2B, 2 R) recorded his third three-hit game of the season ... hit a double to lead off the first inning, his fourth of the season and second in the last three games.
- © Mark Zagunis (1-for-1, 2B) hit a pinch-hit double, his first career extra-base hit.

CHICAGO WHITE SOX NOTES

CARSON FULMER picked up his third loss of the season and first career interleague loss ... surrendered a season-high five earned runs in 1.2 innings ... allowed his first career grand slam.

DANIEL PALKA (2-for-4, 2B, RBI) hit an RBI-double in the fourth inning to give the White Sox their first run of the game ... his third double of the season.

NOTES: The White Sox have lost six-straight games and are 1-10 in their last 11 games ... are 0-5 in Interleague games this season

- © The White Sox have allowed 32 runs in the first inning, the most of any inning.
- © Yolmer Sanchez (1-for-4) recorded the White Sox first hit in the fourth inning.
- © José Abreu (2-for-3, BB, R, RBI) hit an RBI-single in the fifth inning ... is batting .338 (22-for-65) in 18-career games against the Cubs.
- © The White Sox have allowed five or more runs in each of their last seven games.
