The Mariners and Padres meet for the final (0-3) of 4 games this season...the Mariners lead the all-time Vedder Cup vs. the Padres 55-50, including going 28-24 at Safeco Field.

TODAY'S TILT...the Mariners conclude their penultimate homestand of the season – a 10-day, 8-game, 3-team set – with the finale (0-1) of 2 games vs. the San Diego Padres...won 2-of-3 vs. the Orioles and went 1-2 vs. the Yankees to open the homestand...following today's game, will embark on the final road trip of the season, an 11-day, 10-game, 3-city, 2-state trip to Los Angeles-AL (4 G), Houston (3 G) and Texas (3 G)...today's game will be televised on **ROOT SPORTS NW** and broadcast live on **710 ESPN** and the Mariners Radio Network.

ODDS AND ENDS...the Mariners are 14-15 in their last 29 games dating back to Aug. 9...are 24-34 in their last 58 games since July 4 after winning a season-high 8 straight games, spanning June 25 – July 3...the Mariners are 39-41 in their last 80 games since June 10...Seattle is 65-54 in its last 119 games (4/28-c) and 70-57 over its last 127 games (4/20-c)...Seattle is 24-24 during the day and 55-41 at night...Seattle is 41-32 at Safeco Field, 38-33 on the road.

- **Double Up** - since Aug. 4, **Mitch Haniger** is T2nd in MLB with 15 doubles, trailing only Matt Chapman-OAK (17).
- **Four Score** - the Mariners are 56-18 when scoring 4-or-more runs, but are 23-47 when scoring 3-or-fewer runs.
- **Get Through 8** - the Mariners are 1 of 2 Major League clubs with a 1.000 winning percentage (68-0) when leading after 8 innings this season, joining Oakland (73-0).
- **Home Sweet Home** - the Mariners are 41-32 at Safeco Field this season and with only 8 home games remaining, are assured of a winning season at home...marks the 22nd time in club history to finish a season .500-or-better at home, including the 3rd time in the last 5 seasons and 5th time since 2006 (also: 2006, 2009, 2014 and 2016).
- **Best vs. the West** - following today's game vs. the Padres, the Mariners will play their final 17 games of the season vs. AL West opponents...the Mariners are 31-28 (.525) vs. the AL West this season (8-8 vs. HOU, 8-7 vs. LAA, 9-7 vs. OAK and 6-6 vs. TEX).

WADE TO THE RESCUE...Wade LeBlanc has an active scoreless innings streak of 18.0 consecutive innings, dating back to Aug. 25...LeBlanc's current streak is the 3rd-longest active streak in the Majors and tied for the 2nd-longest streak by a Mariners pitcher this season (also: **James Paxton**, 5/2-13), trailing only **Alex Colomé's** 20.0 consecutive scoreless innings from June 30 – Aug. 15...over his last 3 starts (8/25-c), LeBlanc is 1-0 with a 0.47 ERA (1 ER, 19.0 IP) with 14 strikeouts and 6 walks.

DON'T WALK...Mariners pitchers did not walk a Padres batter last night, marking the 22nd game this season in which Seattle hurlers did not issue a free pass...the Mariners 22 games issuing 0 walks are tops in the American League and 2nd-most in the Majors this season...they trail only the Dodgers (26), while ranking ahead of Washington (15), Oakland (13) and Cleveland (12)...the 22 games with 0 walks issued by Mariners pitchers are the most in single-season club history, surpassing the previous mark of 17 such games set by the 2002 Mariners.

ALEXANDER THE GREAT...in his last 29 appearances, dating back to June 30, **Alex Colomé** is 4-0 with 17 holds and a 1.52 ERA (5 ER, 29.2 IP)...during this span, he has recorded 36 strikeouts and 9 walks, while limiting opposing batters to a .194 (21x108) average against...since making his Mariners debut on May 27, Colomé leads the Major Leagues with 26 holds...overall, he is 4-0 with 1 save, 26 holds and a 2.83 ERA (13 ER, 41.1 IP) with 46 strikeouts and 11 walks in 42 relief appearances with the Mariners...he has recorded at least 1 strikeout in each of his last 10 games (8/18-c), including 5 outings with multiple strikeouts; has tallied 17 strikeouts over this span.

999 AND COUNTING...Nelson Cruz has 999 career RBI in 1,552 career games...with 1 more RBI will become the 11th active player to record at least 1,000 RBI, joining Albert Pujols (1,982), Adrián Beltré (1,697), Miguel Cabrera (1,635), Matt Holliday (1,220), **Robinson Canó** (1,215), Adrián González (1,202), Victor Martínez (1,176), Edwin Encarnación (1,144), Ryan Braun (1,041) and Chase Utley (1,025)...Cruz will also become the 6th player to record his 1,000th career RBI in a Mariners uniform, joining Ken Griffey Jr. (9/15/98 at MIN), Edgar Martínez (8/8/01 vs. TOR), John Olerud (6/22/02 at HOU), Bret Boone (5/10/05 at NYY) and **Robinson Canó** (4/26/16 vs. HOU).

GOOD TO BE HOME...**Nelson Cruz** has hit 19 home runs at Safeco Field this season, which is T2nd-most all-time at Safeco Field, trailing only Richie Sexson's 21 home runs at Safeco Field in 2005...Cruz, who also hit 19 home runs at Safeco Field in 2017, is joined by Bret Boone (2001) and Edgar Martínez (2000) as the only other players to hit 19 home runs at Safeco Field in a single season...overall this season, Cruz's 19 home run at home are T4th-most in the American League (also: José Ramírez-CLE), trailing only J.D. Martínez-BOS (23), Khris Davis-OAK (21) and Joey Gallo-TEX (21).

ELECTRIC EDDIE...**Edwin Díaz** is 4 strikeouts shy of recording his 300th career strikeout...his 296 career strikeouts are currently 7th-most in club history by a reliever, trailing only Jeff Nelson (471), Mike Jackson (383), Bobby Ayala (374), J.J. Putz (337), Arthur Rhodes (315) and Tom Wilhelmson (307)...Díaz's 296 strikeouts are 3rd-most among Major League relievers since his debut season of 2016, trailing only Dellin Betances (332) and Brad Hand (314), while ranking ahead of Craig Kimbrel (295) and Kenley Jansen (284).

THE EDWIN DÍAZ REPORT...in 69 games this season, **Edwin Díaz** is 54-for-58 (93.1%) in save opportunities with a 1.95 ERA (15 ER, 69.1 IP) with 119 strikeouts and 16 walks...he has limited opposing batters to a .161 (39x242) average against with a 0.79 WHIP (16 BB, 39 H, 69.1 IP)...here are some notes on Díaz's standout season:

- Leads the Major Leagues with 54 saves...Wade Davis-COL is 2nd with 39.
- Is the 14th pitcher (done 17x) in ML history to record at least 50 saves in a season.
- Ranks 2nd among Major League relievers with 119 strikeouts...Josh Hader-MIL is 1st with 127.
- Is 27-for-30 (90.0%) in one-run save opportunities with a 0.89 ERA (3 ER, 30.1 IP) with 55 strikeouts and 5 walks...the Mariners are 30-0 this season when he enters with a one-run lead.
- Has struck out 45.2% (119 K, 263 BF) of batters faced this season, the 2nd-best mark by a reliever this season and the 5th-best single-season strikeout rate by a reliever in Major League history.

AS YOU KNOW...**Mitch Haniger** is batting .306 (38x124) with 20 runs, 13 doubles, 1 triple, 6 home runs, 13 RBI, 2 HBP, 11 walks, a .372 on-base percentage and a .573 slugging percentage (.945 OPS) in 29 games batting leadoff, dating back to Aug. 9...**BUT DID YOU KNOW?**...that Haniger's .945 OPS is 2nd-best among American League leadoff batters this season?...he trails only Boston's Mookie Betts (1.066).

ABOUT LEBLANC...

- 34-year-old left-hander is making his 29th appearance and 24th start of the season, his 205th career appearance, 103rd career start and 2nd career start (7th appearance) vs. San Diego today.
- Signed with Seattle on March 25, 2018 after being released by New York-AL at his request.
- Previously played with Seattle in 2016...acquired on June 22, 2016 from Toronto in exchange for a player to be named later or cash considerations...was traded to Pittsburgh on Sept. 13, 2016 in exchange for a player to be named later or cash considerations.
- Selected by San Diego in the 2nd round of the 2006 MLB First-Year Player Draft.
- Native of Lake Charles, LA...attended Alfred M. Barbe High School.
- Made his Major League debut with the Padres on Sept. 3, 2008 at Los Angeles-NL (L, 4.0, 8, 5, 5, 3, 1, HR-2).
- Pitched for the University of Alabama, 2004-06...was 24-9 with a 2.81 ERA (100 ER, 320.1 IP) and 334 strikeouts in 46 career G/45 GS...holds Alabama's all-time record for strikeouts with 334...National Freshman of the Year (*Baseball America*) and SEC Freshman of the Year in 2004 after going 8-4 with a 2.08 ERA (26 ER, 112.2 IP) with 98 strikeouts in 16 G/15 GS while posting 8 complete games, including 2 shutouts.
- Went 2-5 with a 4.23 ERA (21 ER, 44.2 IP) in 8 starts with the Seibu Lions in the Japan Pacific League in 2015.
- Is 9-7-1 with a 3.70 ERA (59 ER, 143.1 IP) in 42 career games (20 starts) in September.

LAST OUTING...tossed 6.0 scoreless innings but did not factor into the decision in a 3-5 Mariners loss to Baltimore on Sept. 4...allowed just 6 hits and 1 walk while striking out 4 batters...marked his 5th scoreless start of the season and his 4th start of 6.0-or-more scoreless innings pitched (also: 5/14 at MIN, 6/16 vs. BOS & 8/30 at OAK).

SCORELESS IN SEATTLE...has not allowed a run over his last 18.0 innings pitched (8/25-c), tied with James Paxton (5/2-5/13) for the longest scoreless innings streak among Mariners starters this season.

FOR STARTERS...since moving into the Mariners rotation on May 3, is 8-3 with a 3.45 ERA (49 ER, 128.0 IP) with 100 strikeouts and 30 walks in 23 starts...the Mariners are 15-8 in those starts...among American League leaders during that span, ranks 7th in ERA, 8th in WHIP (1.13/30 BB, 114 H, 128.0 IP), 8th in BB/9.0 IP (2.11/30 BB, 128.0 IP) and 15th in K/BB (3.33/100 K, 30 BB).

START IT UP...in 31 career starts with the Mariners, is 11-3 with a 3.70 ERA (71 ER, 172.2 IP) with 134 strikeouts and 39 walks...the Mariners are 22-9 in his 31 starts with the club...made 8 starts with Seattle in 2016, going 3-0 with a 4.43 ERA (22 ER, 44.2 IP) with 34 strikeouts and 9 walks.

HE'S A WINNER...made 21 career starts with the Mariners before suffering a loss (6/24/16-7/8/18)...only 1 American League pitcher in the live-ball era had a longer such streak to begin a tenure with a single club (Whitey Ford-NYY, 22, 7/6/50-6/12/53)...among all pitchers in the live-ball era, LeBlanc's streak trailed only Ford and Kirk Rueter-MON (22, 7/7/93-6/15/94)(STATS).

MAKE YOURSELF AT HOME...signed to a contract extension through the 2019 season with annual club options through 2022 on July 3.

THAT'S NEAT!...turned in one of the best starts of his career June 16 vs. Boston, allowing 2 hits and striking out 9 across 7.2 scoreless innings...faced just 1 over the minimum, thanks to a 1st-inning double play...retired 22 straight batters after allowing a leadoff single in the 1st inning, ending with a 2-out single in the 8th...his 7.2 innings and 9 strikeouts were both his most since 2011 with San Diego.

A MAY TO REMEMBER...in 6 starts in the month of May, went 1-0 with a 1.72 ERA (6 ER, 31.1 IP) with 23 strikeouts and 6 walks...among American League leaders for the month of May, ranked 4th in ERA and 9th in WHIP (0.99/6 BB, 25 H, 31.1 IP)...the Mariners went 5-1 in those 6 starts.

WELCOME (BACK) TO SEATTLE...signed with Seattle on March 25 after being released by New York-AL at his request...became the 43rd player in club history to have spent at least two different stints with the Mariners...Mike Blowers (1992-95, 1997, 1999), Raúl Ibañez (1996-2000, 2004-2008, 2013), Norm Charlton (1993, 1995-97, 2001) and Jeff Nelson (1992-95, 2001-03, 2005) are the only players who spent three separate stints with the Mariners.

2017 SEASON...went 5-2 with 1 save and 4 holds in 50 relief appearances with a 4.50 ERA (34 ER, 68.0 IP), 54 strikeouts and 17 walks with Pittsburgh...held right-handed batters to a .217 (38x175) batting average against with a .270 OBP and a .389 slugging percentage (.658 OPS against).

CAREER...10-year MLB veteran with 7 clubs (San Diego, Miami, Houston, Los Angeles-AL, New York-AL, Pittsburgh & Seattle)...overall, is 38-38-3 with a 4.23 ERA (338 ER, 718.1 IP) in 204 career appearances/102 starts...in 102 career starts, is 30-34 with a 4.30 ERA (266 ER, 557.0 IP) with 394 strikeouts and 177 walks...in 102 career relief appearances, is 8-4-3 with a 4.02 ERA (72 ER, 161.1 IP) with 125 strikeouts and 43 walks...appeared in 11 games (8 starts) with the Mariners in 2016, going 3-0-1 with a 4.50 ERA (25 ER, 50.0 IP).
