TODAY'S GAME: The Giants and Braves play the final game of this three-game series with the Giants looking to snap a season-long 10-game losing streak and the Braves seeking to win their fifth in a row...the Giants need a win today to avoid being swept by the Braves for the first time in a series of three-or-more games since April 22-24, 2011.

TODAY'S GAME ON FACEBOOK: Today's Giants-Braves game is an exclusive Facebook/MLB Network telecast...the Giants' **Mike Krukow** will be in the booth along with Rich Waltz and Jason Marquis, representing the Braves.

TODAY'S STARTER: LHP **Derek Holland** has gone 1-0 with a 1.61 ERA (5er, 28.0ip) and a .190 opponents batting average against in his last five starts...however, he's received a total of just six runs of support in that five-start span...Holland has faced the Braves just once in his career on Sept. 12, 2014 while pitching for Texas (7.0ip, 8h, 1r, 1er, 0bb, 6so).

GIANTS ON FOX: Please be advised that FOX Sports has selected the game of Saturday, Sept. 22 (SF at STL)...the game has been dropped from the NBC Sports Bay Area TV schedule and the game time has been changed from 4:15 p.m. PT to 10:05 a.m. PT (12:05 p.m. CT).

SNAP THIS STREAK: Entering today's game, the Giants have lost each of their last 10 contests, their longest losing streak of the season and their longest losing skid since a 10-game losing streak from June 21-30, 1996...SF's current streak matches the longest losing skid in SF-era history (since 1958)...it's just the third time the Giants have lost 10 in a row in San Francisco (also June 20-30, 1985).

SNAP THE STREAK PART II: The Giants have not had a losing streak of 11-or-more games since April 19-29, 1951, when the New York Giants lost 11 consecutive contests...SF's current losing streak is the longest by any NL team this year...the Detroit Tigers lost 11-straight earlier this season from June 19-30.

TOUGH MONTH: The Giants are still looking for their first win this month as they are 0-10 in September...SF has scored a total of just 25 runs in the 10 games (2.5/game) while hitting .190, including a .160 mark with runners in scoring position...the pitching staff has posted a 4.81 ERA, with the starters logging a 4.63 mark and the bullpen posting a 5.20 ERA...SF has 16 games left on its schedule.

RUNS TOUGH TO COME BY: The Giants have scored one run in each of their last four home games and have been held to one run or fewer in six of their last seven home contests...overall, SF has been held to three runs or fewer in 13 of their last 15 games.

SOLID PITCHING: Beginning June 1, Giants pitchers have posted a 3.43 ERA, which ranks as the third-best figure in the Majors behind Houston (3.38 ERA) and Los Angeles-NL (3.40 ERA).

CLOSE CALLS: The Giants have played exactly 100 games this season that have been decided by just three runs or fewer, the most such games of any MLB team this year...SF is 48-52 (.480) in such contests.

SCORE AT LEAST FOUR: San Francisco is 19-61 (.238) when scoring three runs or fewer compared to 49-17 (.742) when plating four-or-more runs.

The Giants defeated the Padres, 6 - 1 to move into a first place tie in the NL West with San Diego...**Tim Lincecum** won his third straight September start and drove in two runs with a single.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

#45 LHP Derek Holland
6-2, 215, 31 years old (October 9, 1986)
7-8 Record, 3.54 ERA

- The 31-year-old left-hander is slated to make his 28th start (32nd appearance) this season...has posted a 7-8 record with a 3.54 ERA (60er, 152.2ip) over his 31 outings.
- The Giants have won five of his last eight starts and are 14-13 in his starts overall this season.
- Did not factor into the decision in his last start on Sept. 7 at Milwaukee...threw 6.0 innings, allowing just two runs on two hits and five walks with eight strikeouts in the Giants' 4-2 loss to the Brewers.
- Has posted a 1.61 ERA (5er, 28.0ip) and a .190 opponents average with 27 strikeouts over his last five starts.
- Since July 7, he's posted a 2.23 ERA (15er, 60.2ip), which ranks as the fifth-lowest figure in the Majors over that stretch.
- Has allowed two-runs-or-fewer in nine of his last 10 starts, posting a 2.37 ERA (15er, 57.0ip).
- Lefties are hitting just .174 (21-for-121) off him, which ranks as the fourth-lowest figure in the National League...he's allowed just two hits in 18 at-bats (.111) to left-handers in his last four games and has allowed just three extra-base hits to left-handers (all doubles).
- Left-handed opponents have just a .198 slugging percentage off him, which is the lowest in the Majors).
- Has pitched better in day games, going 5-1 with a 2.54 ERA (16er, 56.2ip) in 11 games, compared to a 2-7 record with a 4.13 ERA (44er, 96.0ip) in 20 night games.
- Opponents are hitting just .157 (8-for-51) off him with runners in scoring position over his last 11 games.
- He's received three-runs-or-fewer of support in nine of his last 10 outings and has received two-or-less runs of support in 17 of his 27 starts overall this season.
- Has made four relief appearances and allowed two runs on five hits (one home run) with 14 strikeouts in 7.0 innings of work...has struck out 14 of the 28 batters he's faced as a reliever.
- Has made only one career appearance vs. Atlanta and threw 7.0 innings, allowing one run on eight hits with six strikeouts on Sept. 12, 2014.
- Signed by the Giants to a minor league contract in Feb. and made the team as a non-roster invitee.
