The Cardinals recorded a total attendance of 3,403,587 fans this season, averaging 42,020 with 27 sellouts. It marked the 9th-highest total attendance in franchise history. This was the 15th consecutive season with 3 million or more and 22nd overall. Ranked first in MLB in percent of stadium capacity sold (95.6%)

CARDINALS NOTES

- JOHN GANT** made his 19th start (26th app.) of the season, first start (2nd app.) vs. the Brewers in 2018 and third career start (5th app.) vs. the Brewers (0-2)...has not pitched more than 5.0 innings in any of his three career starts vs. MIL.
- PAUL DEJONG** has hit safely in 15 of his last 17 games (20-65, .308)...was hit by pitch for the 12th time this season, ranks second on the club behind **KOLTEN WONG** (14)
- JORDAN HICKS** induced his 12 double play of the season and first since Aug. 28 vs. PIT...entered today ranked 7th among N.L. relievers in GIDP.
- CARLOS MARTÍNEZ** struck out four batters in relief, matching the most strikeouts by a Cardinals reliever this season.
- THE CARDINALS** were swept at home for the second time this season (6/29-7/1 vs. ATL)...were swept by the Brewers for the first time since June 10-12, 2011 and first time at home since October 2-4, 2009...lost the season series to the Brewers 11-8...were 6-9 at home in September and 43-38 at home overall this season...were held to two hits on Opening Day vs. Arizona and on the final home game tonight vs. MIL.

BREWERS NOTES

- JHOULYS CHACÍN** made his team-leading 34th start of the season, fifth against the Cardinals in 2018 (2-2) and 10th career start (11th app.) vs. the Cardinals (2-7)...has won his last two starts after losing his first seven straight decision vs. STL to begin his career; won his last start at Busch Stadium (8/19/18)...has not pitched more than 5.0 innings in any of his last four starts.
- CHRISTIAN YELICH** walked a career-high five times, tying the Brewers franchise record and most recent since **JEREMY BURNITZ** did 9/15/1999 at STL...has scored in each of his last four games...reached base safely in his last 13 straight games vs. the Cardinals dating back to May 28...has drawn 60 or more walks for the 3rd straight season...has hit safely in his last nine games overall (15-32, .484) with 5 doubles, 2 triples, 3 home runs and 15 RBI.
- TRAVIS SHAW** tallied his second 2-RBI game vs. STL this season (last; 6/21 at MIL)...collected his first RBI not via HR since 9/12 at CHI.
- DOMINGO SANTANA** drew his first walk since 9/5 and his second walk since May 24.
- RYAN BRAUN** committed his first error as an outfielder this season (previous two were at first base).
- JEREMY JEFFRESS** has not been scored upon in his last nine appearances (9.2 IP) dating back to 8/31...has locked down his 7th straight save.
- THE BREWERS** clinched a postseason berth for the first time since 2011 and the 5th time in franchise history...held their opponent to a season-low two hits for the 5th game this season.
