- ◆ The D-backs lost a member of their family this week when **Joe Gilmartin** passed away at the age of 88...the NBA Hall of Fame sportswriter was also a fixture in the Chase Field press box...his son, Leo, has worked for the D-backs as a radio producer/engineer since 1998.

### SNAKEBITES

- ◆ LHP **Robbie Ray** threw 2.0 hitless, scoreless innings (1 BB, 3K) on Feb. 26 @ Reds.
- ◆ OF **Steven Souza Jr.** will make his second start.
- ◆ INF **Ketel Marte** is batting .300 (3-for-10) with 1 triple, 1 RBI and 1 walk in 4 games.
- ◆ C **Jeff Mathis** is making his third start...he caught Zack Greinke on Feb. 25 vs. Brewers and Patrick Corbin on Feb. 28 vs. Rockies.

### NL BEST

- ◆ The D-backs will face the Dodgers in the first of 2 spring matchups (also March 16)...the teams will meet during the opening homestand April 2-4.
- ◆ This is the sixth of 12 NL West matchups (2-3).
- ◆ The 2017 NL West featured 3 of the NL's 5 Post-season teams with the D-backs, Dodgers and Rockies.

### POSTSEASON PROWESS

- ◆ The D-backs have made the postseason 6 times in 20 years (30.0 pct.), the second-best pct. in baseball history, trailing only the Yankees (46.9; 53-for-113) [source: Elias Sports Bureau].

### OFFSEASON ACQUISITIONS

- ◆ Acquired, RHP **Brad Boxberger** and OF **Steven Souza Jr.**; signed C **Alex Avila**, OF **Jarrod Dyson** and RHP **Yoshihisa Hirano**; selected RHP **Albert Suarez** in the Rule 5 Draft.

### ROSTER ROUNDUP

- ◆ Arizona opened the spring with 59 players in Major League camp: 31 pitchers (8 left-handed), 6 catchers, 12 infielders and 10 outfielders.
- ◆ The D-backs returned 30 players from its 40-man roster at the start of last Spring Training...Arizona returned 24 in 2017, 22 in 2016, 23 in 2015 and 26 in 2014.

### D-BACKS TO CELEBRATE 20TH ANNIVERSARY

- ◆ The D-backs will celebrate their 20th anniversary all season with a series of events allowing fans to look back at the club's first 20 years while focusing on the next generation...elements include:
  - Vote for the D-backs All-Time Team at [dbacks.com/20](http://dbacks.com/20).
  - The logo (top L corner) features the team's historic and current colors (Purple and Sedona Red) and 6 stars, each representing a D-backs playoff team (1999, 2001, '02, '07, '11 & '17);
  - A commemorative patch, featuring the logo, will adorn the team's jerseys throughout the season and caps during the first homestand;
  - The "D-backs 20th Anniversary Experience," a 2,000 square-foot exhibit at Chase Field, located on the Main Concourse in right field behind the Coors Light Strike Zone, will feature historic artifacts, memorabilia and photography celebrating the team's history and a wall featuring baseballs signed by nearly all D-backs players and coaches.

### D-BACKS ACQUIRE SOUZA AND WIDENER...

- ◆ On Feb. 20, the D-backs acquired OF **Steven Souza Jr.** from the Rays and RHP **Taylor Widener** from the Yankees.
- ◆ Souza was named the Rays' Most Valuable Player by the Tampa Bay Chapter of the BBWAA in 2017 after he set career highs in most offensive categories, including runs (78), hits (125), doubles (21), homers (30), RBI (78), walks (84), slugging pct. (.459), OPS (.810) and stolen bases (16).

### HERE COMES 2

- ◆ **Torey Lovullo** is in his second season as D-backs' manager after leading the club to a Wild Card win vs. Rockies and a berth in the NLDS vs. Dodgers in 2017.
- ◆ Lovullo was the seventh manager to garner Manager of the Year honors in his first season at the helm: Hal Lanier in 1986 (Astros), Dusty Baker in 1993 (Giants), Joe Girardi in 2006 (Marlins), Matt Williams in 2014 (Nationals), Jeff Banister in 2015 (Rangers) and Dave Roberts in 2016 (Dodgers).

- ◆ Established a career high in wins and ERA, going 15-5 with a 2.89 ERA (52 ER in 162.0 IP) in 28 starts in 2017...matched his career high with 218 strikeouts (also: 2016).
- ◆ Ranked among NL leaders in strikeouts per 9.0 IP (1st, 12.11), opponent average (2nd, .199), hits per 9.0 innings (2nd, 6.44), strikeouts (3rd, 218), opponent slugging pct. (4th, .356), ERA (4th, 2.89), opponent OPS (5th, .646) and baserunners per 9.0 IP (6th, 10.67).

**2017 SEASON RECAP**

**SEASON NO. 20 RECAP**

- ◆ The D-backs went 93-69 (52-29 at home and 41-40 on the road), and won the NL Wild Card Game vs. Rockies, 11-8.
- ◆ Arizona went 45-31 vs. NL West, 17-16 vs. NL Central, 19-14 vs. NL East and 12-8 in Interleague Play.

**LOVULLO NAMED NL MANAGER OF THE YEAR**

- ◆ **Torey Lovullo** was named the NL Manager of the Year after guiding the D-backs to a second-place finish in the NL West in his first season as manager... he is the third Arizona manager to garner the honor, joining Bob Melvin (2007) and Kirk Gibson (2011).
- ◆ Lovullo's 93 wins were the most by an Arizona manager in his first 162 games, 1 more than Bob Brenly's 92 in 2001.

**IMPROVEMENT IN THE WIN COLUMN**

- ◆ The D-backs' 93 wins were 24 more than their total of 69 in 2016...the 24-win difference from last season was the second largest in the Majors, behind the Twins (26), and fourth-best increase in a single-season in franchise history.

**A DIFFERENT DIFFERENTIAL**

- ◆ The D-backs led the Majors with a +291 run differential increase from 2016...Arizona was a -138 in 2016 and a +153 this season.

**ONE-RUN AND THE WIN**

- ◆ Arizona went 29-23 (.558) in 1-run games, the second-most wins in the Majors, behind only Washington (30), and ahead of the Angels (27).

**WHO DOESN'T LIKE TATERS?**

- ◆ The D-backs' 220 home runs were a single-season, franchise record, surpassing the 216 in 1999.

**NEW D-BACKS ERA RECORD**

- ◆ The D-backs' 3.66 ERA was a franchise best, 0.11 better than the previous mark of 3.77 in 1999, and 1.43 lower than 2016 (5.09).
- ◆ Arizona's 1.43 difference in ERA from 2016 to 2017 was the best in baseball, ahead of Cleveland (0.54) and Minnesota (0.49).

**1...2...3 STRIKES YOU'RE OUT**

- ◆ Arizona established a club record with 1,482 strikeouts, 164 more than its previous record (1,318 in 2016), and 9.26 strikeouts per 9.0 innings (8.17 in 2016).
