NATIONALS NEWS

WHAT A RELIEF!

The Washington Nationals topped the Atlanta Braves, 5-3, in a wild extra-inning affair on Saturday at SunTrust Park. **Juan Soto's** solo home run in the seventh inning tied the game at 3-3...Each club was held scoreless over the next six innings before the Nationals scored two runs in the 14th inning...Pinch hitter **Max Scherzer** singled and scored on a triple by **Wilmer Difo** to give the Nationals the lead.

- It marked the first time in franchise history that a pitcher collected a pinch hit and scored the game winning run.
- Washington's bullpen combined to toss 7.0 innings of perfect relief, striking out seven batters along the way...**Justin Miller** tossed a career-high 3.0 innings (5 SO) to earn the win.

ROSTER MOVE

The Nationals placed **Tim Collins** on the paternity list and recalled right-handed pitcher **Jeffry Rodriguez** from Double-A Harrisburg...Rodriguez is 4-3 with a 3.88 ERA in 11 starts for the Senators...He has struck out 60 batters including nine in his last start on May 31 at Hartford (COL).

MORE ON THAT 'PEN

Over the last 12 games, **Henry Blanco's** bullpen has tossed 34.0 innings of relief, striking out 36 batters, walking just five and surrendering just two earned runs along the way (0.53 ERA)...Nationals relievers have inherited 17 runners during this stretch and have not allowed any to score.

- Washington's 0.53 bullpen ERA is the best in Major League Baseball since May 21.
- On the season, Washington relievers rank among National League 'pens in strikeout-to-walk ratio (2nd, 3.02), strikeouts per 9.0 IP (2nd, 9.62), and inherited runners scored percent (2nd, 18.8%).

WINNING WAYS

Since April 29, the Nationals are 22-8 and have outscored their opponents, 128-81...The 22-8 (.733) record is the best in Major League Baseball during this stretch.

- At 21-10 (.677), the Nationals own the best road record in Major League Baseball.

START ME UP

Washington's starting rotation leads the National League in ERA (2.91), strikeouts (395), opp. AVG (.212), opp. OBP (.275), hits per 9.0 IP (6.99), WHIP (1.06)...The staff ranks second in strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.87), opp. SLG (.358), and opp. OPS (.634).

- Since April 28, Nationals starters have allowed three earned runs or fewer in 30 of 32 starts.
- The Nationals boast four starters in the top 16 in the National League in ERA...No other team has more than two: **Max Scherzer** (2nd, 1.92), **Gio Gonzalez** (6th, 2.27), **Stephen Strasburg** (14th, 3.20) and **Tanner Roark** (16th, 3.38).

DINGERS OF THE DAY

The Nationals are tied with the Milwaukee Brewers for the most home runs in the National League with 74... **Bryce Harper** (1st, 18) and **Matt Adams** (T6th, 12) rank in the top 10 in the National League...Harper's 18 home runs are tied for second in Major League Baseball.

- Since joining the Nationals on May 13, **Mark Reynolds** ranks tied for second in the NL (T5th in MLB) with six home runs.

NATIONALS HISTORY

June 3 (3-8 on this date)

2005 - **Livan Hernandez** tossed 9.0 innings, threw 150 pitches and allowed two earned runs on seven hits while walking five and striking out three, but that effort was not enough as the Nationals and Marlins battled into extra innings. Tied at 2-2 in the bottom of the 11th inning, **Ryan Church's** bases loaded sacrifice fly plated **Jamey Carroll** and propelled the Washington to the 3-2 win.

OPPONENT

ATLANTA BRAVES

Dave Martinez capped his 16-year Major League career with Atlanta in 2001, hitting .287 in 12 games...**Matt Adams** clubbed 19 home runs in 100 games for the Braves in 2017...The Braves made Nationals pitching coach **Derek Lilliquist** their first-round selection (6th overall) out of the University of Georgia in the 1987 Amateur Draft.

DAVE MARTINEZ

Nationals manager **Dave Martinez** was named the seventh field manager in Nationals history on Oct. 30, 2017. He joined the Nationals for what will be his 30th season in professional baseball. A 16-year Major League outfielder, Martinez has been a Major League coach for the last 10 seasons, serving as Cubs manager **Joe Maddon's** bench coach and right-hand man in Chicago (2015-17) as well as Tampa Bay (2008-14). This is the first Major League managerial assignment of Martinez's career.

#58 - JEREMY HELLICKSON - RHP

A veteran of eight Major League seasons joined the Nationals on a Minor League deal with an invite to Major League Spring Training in mid-March... Was the 2011 American League Rookie of the Year for Tampa Bay...Took home the Gold Glove in 2012...Has made more than 27 starts in six of his eight Major League seasons...Pitched for Tampa Bay from 2010-14 while Nationals manager **Dave Martinez** served as the club's bench coach.

AGAINST THE BRAVES: Is 2-0 with a 3.21 ERA in five previous starts against the Atlanta Braves...Tossed 7.0 innings of three-hit, two-run ball in his lone start against the Braves in 2017...Earned the win as Philadelphia topped Atlanta, 4-3.

LAST START: Was again efficient in 5.0 innings of work...Allowed two earned runs on six hits...Earned his second win of the season and the Nationals improved to 6-2 in his starts, including five straight wins.

2018 NOTES

- Has allowed just four earned runs in 27.2 innings spanning his last five starts (1.30 ERA)...He's fanned 25 batters, walked two, and opposing batters are just 19-for-75 (.200) against him.
- Among pitchers with at least eight starts, ranks eighth in the National League with a 2.30 ERA...Also ranks among National League pitchers (min. 8 GS) in opp. OBP (4th, .261), WHIP (2nd, 0.93), walks per 9.0 IP (2nd, 1.26), and strikeout-to-walk ratio (6th, 5.67).
- Allowed just one earned run on three hits in 5.0 innings of work in his second start of the season against the Diamondbacks...He struck out five batters while walking just one.
- Allowed one earned run for the second consecutive start on May 22 vs. San Diego...Allowed five hits, struck out five batters and issued just one walk in 5.1 innings of work...Did not factor in the decision as the Nationals walked-off the Padres.
- On May 8 at San Diego, he took a perfect game into the seventh inning to earn his first win of the season...A single by **Franchy Cordero** in the seventh inning broke up the bid...Tossed 6.2 scoreless innings, giving up just two hits and striking out a season-high eight batters.
- Tossed 5.2 scoreless innings on May 3 against Pittsburgh to help Washington complete the four-game sweep...Surrendered just three hits while striking out four...Did not issue a walk.
- In his third start for the Nationals allowed two earned runs on five hits in 5.1 innings of work as Washington fell to Arizona, 4-3, on April 28...Both earned runs came via the home run.
- Allowed three earned runs on three hits in 5.2 innings on April 22 at LAD...Did not factor in the decision as the Dodgers took the lead in the 7th inn.
- Made his Nationals debut on April 16 at NYM...Allowed two earned runs on seven hits in 4.2 innings in Washington's 8-6 victory.

2017 NOTES

- Began his second season in Philadelphia by going 6-5 with a 4.73 ERA in 20 starts before being acquired by Baltimore on July 28.
- While with Philadelphia, he went 3-1 with a 3.64 ERA (19 ER/47.0 IP) in eight starts against National League East opponents.
- His 47 walks on the season were the third fewest of his career (min. 15 starts).
- Did not issue a walk in eight of his 30 starts between the two clubs.

2016 NOTES

- Made his Phillies debut on Opening Day, becoming the first starting pitcher to make his Phillies debut on Opening Day since Roy Halladay in 2010.
- Ranked tied for third in the NL in shutouts (1), tied for fifth in GDP (21), tied for eighth in starts (32) and ranked ninth in walks per 9.0 IP (2.14)
- Set career highs in strikeouts (154) and starts and tied his career high in innings (189.0).
