**TONIGHT'S TILT**...the Mariners continue a 7-day, 7-game homestand with the second (1-0) of three games vs. the Los Angeles Angels...will also face the Boston Red Sox for a four-game series beginning Thursday... Seattle recently wrapped a 6-day, 6-game road trip, going 4-2 vs. the Astros (1-1) and Rays (3-1)...tonight's game will be televised on **ROOT SPORTS NW** and broadcast live on **710 ESPN Seattle** and the Mariners Radio Network.

**ODDS AND ENDS**...the Mariners have won 9 of their last 11 games, 13 of their last 17, 18 of their last 23 and 20 of their last 27...Seattle is 28-13 in its last 41 games, 33-16 over its last 49 games and 38-20 in its last 58 games...Seattle is 13-11 during the day and 30-12 at night...Seattle is 21-12 at Safeco Field, 21-12 on the road.

- **Batter Up** - **Jean Segura** is batting .343 (91x265), 2nd-best in the Majors, trailing Mookie Betts-BOS (.354/67x189)...Segura's 91 hits are also 2nd-most in MLB, behind Jose Altuve-HOU (93).
- **Happy Totals** - since June 4, the Mariners are averaging 4.86 runs per game (34 R, 7 G), posting a record of 5-2...from May 20 to June 3, the Mariners averaged 3.36 runs per game (47 R, 14 G); the Mariners went 11-3 during that span.
- **Three Up, Three Down** - of **Edwin Díaz's** 24 saves this season, 22 have been 1.0-inning outings...**Díaz** has faced the minimum 3 batters in 12 of his 22 saves of 1.0 innings, the 2nd-most such outings in the Majors this season, behind Craig Kimbrel-BOS (15).
- **Multi-Hit Madness** - **Jean Segura** leads the Major Leagues with 30 multi-hit games, ahead of Nick Markakis-ATL (27), Jose Altuve-HOU (26) and Nicholas Castellanos-DET (26)...Segura leads the Majors with 13 games of 3+ hits, ahead of Castellanos (11).
- **Four Score** - Seattle is 30-8 when scoring 4-or-more runs, but 12-16 when scoring 3-or-fewer runs.
- **Series Stuff** - the Mariners have won or tied 19 of their first 22 series, posting a series record of 14-3-5.
- **It's a Dee Thing** - the Mariners are 12-1 when **Dee Gordon** starts at second base this season.

**HIGH-WATER MARK**...the Mariners are a season-high 18 games over .500 at 42-24...marks the first time the Mariners have been 18 games over .500 since being 73-55 after game #128 on Aug. 26, 2007...with a win tonight, the Mariners would improve to 19 games over .500 for first time since being 73-54 after game #127 on Aug. 25, 2007.

**RARE COMPANY**...**Jean Segura** is one of five Major Leaguers batting at least .340, joining Mookie Betts-BOS (.354/67x189), Jose Altuve-HOU (.342/93x272), Scotter Gennett-CIN (.340/82x241) and Freddie Freeman-ATL (.340/85x250)...Segura is one of two Major Leaguers with at least 90 hits, joining Altuve (93)...Segura is one of six Major Leaguers with at least 50 runs, joining Mike Trout-LAA (54), Ozzie Albies-ATL (52), Betts (52), George Springer-HOU (51) and Charlie Blackmon-COL (50)...**Segura is the only player in the Majors to be batting at least .340 with 90 hits and 50 runs.**

**ELECTRIC EDDIE**...**Edwin Díaz** is off to one of the best starts to a season by a Mariners closer in club history...his 24 saves are tied with J.J. Putz in 2007 for 3rd-most in club history prior to the All-Star Break, trailing only Kazuhiro Sasaki in 2001 (29) and Fernando Rodney in 2014 (27)...Díaz is averaging 14.40 strikeouts-per-9.0-innings (56 K, 35.0 IP), the top mark by a Mariners pitcher before the All-Star Break in club history...he leads the Majors in saves, ranking ahead of Craig Kimbrel-BOS (21) and Wade Davis-COL (20)...Sasaki (29 saves, 2001) is the only Mariners pitcher in club history to lead the Majors in saves at the All-Star Break (tied with Mariano Rivera-NYY).

**SOMETIMES IT IS HOW YOU START**...with a 5-3 win over the Angels last night, the Mariners have won the opening game of a series on 16 occasions this season...following a win in the first game of a series, the Mariners have a series record of 11-1-4...dating back to their series at Oakland on May 22-24, the Mariners have won the opening game of a series in 7 consecutive series...during that span, the Mariners are 4-0-2 in series, with two games remaining in this 3-game series vs. the Halos.

**WATER PROOF**...over his last 6 starts (5/10-c), **Mike Leake** is 3-0 with a 2.79 ERA (13 ER, 42.0 IP) with 24 strikeouts and 2 walks...during this span, he has posted a 0.98 WHIP (39 H, 2 BB, 42.0 IP), while limiting opposing batters to a .248 (39x157) average against...the Mariners are 6-0 in **Leake's last 6 outings**...during this span (5/10-c), Leake ranks 2nd in the American League in walks-per-9.0-innings pitched (0.43/2 BB, 42.0 IP), while also ranking 2nd in strikeout-to-walk ratio (12.00/24 K, 2 BB), 3rd in innings pitched, 7th in WHIP, T12th in wins and 14th in ERA.

**CRUZ CONTROL**...**Nelson Cruz** has hit safely in 14 of his last 18 games, dating back to May 24...during this span, he is batting .338 (22x65) with 11 runs, 2 doubles, 8 home runs, 18 RBI, 3 HBP, 7 walks, a .421 on-base percentage and a .738 slugging percentage (1.160 OPS)...Cruz leads the Major Leagues in home runs since May 24, while also ranking T2nd in RBI, 6th in slugging, 8th in OPS and T12th in extra-base hits...he has homered in 7 of his last 16 games (5/26-c), belting 8 home runs during that span.

**HOT START**...the Mariners are 42-24 (.636), their 3rd-best record through the club's first 66 games of a season in club history, trailing only 2001 (52-14/.788) and 2003 (44-22/.667)...the Mariners currently lead the American League West by 0.5 games over the Houston Astros (42-25/.627)...prior to this season, the last time the Mariners led the AL West outright after May was at the end of play on Aug. 24, 2003.

**AS THE STARTING PITCHING GOES**...since May 16, the Mariners starters are 13-2 (team is 18-7 overall) with a 2.60 ERA (46 ER, 159.0 IP) with 122 strikeouts and 34 walks in 25 games...Seattle **starters** lead the Major Leagues in ERA during that span, ranking ahead of Chicago-NL (2.70/40 ER, 133.1) and New York-NL (2.82/42 ER, 134.0 IP)...the 159.0 innings pitched by Mariners **starters** are the most in the Majors since May 16...during this same stretch, Mariners relievers are 5-5 with 11 saves and a 2.71 ERA (22 ER, 73.0 IP).

**AS YOU MAY KNOW**...**Jean Segura** leads the Major Leagues with 13 games of at least 3 hits this season...**BUT DID YOU KNOW?**...that Segura is the first Mariners player in club history to record 13 games with 3+ hits in the club's first 66 games of the season?...three Mariners tallied 12 games of 3+ hits in the club's first 66 games: Alex Rodriguez (1996), Bret Boone (2001) and Ichiro Suzuki (2006)...the last player to accomplish this feat was **Dee Gordon**, who had 14 games of 3+ hits through the Miami Marlins first 66 games in 2015...the last American Leaguer to accomplish this feat was Placido Polanco, who had 13 games of 3+ hits through the Detroit Tigers first 66 games in 2007.

**ABOUT LEAKE...**

- Michael Raymond Leake.
- 30-year-old right-hander is making his 14th start of the season, 19th Mariners start, 252nd career appearance (247th career start) and 4th career start vs. Los Angeles-AL tonight.
- A native of San Diego, California, graduated from Fallbrook (CA) High School.
- Played in 3 seasons (2007-09) at Arizona State University...went 16-1 with a 1.71 ERA (27 ER, 142.0 IP) with 162 strikeouts and 24 walks in 19 games (18 starts) in his junior season (2009), earning *Baseball America* First-Team All-American Pac-12 Pitcher of the Year and First-Team All-Pac-12.
- Selected by Oakland in 7th round of the 2006 MLB First-Year Player Draft... did not sign.
- Selected and signed by Cincinnati out of the 1st round (8th overall pick) in the 2009 MLB Draft.
- Is 18-11 with a 3.52 ERA (119 ER, 304.1 IP) in 47 career games (all starts) in June.

**LAST OUTING...**earned his 6th win of the season in a 5-4 Mariners win at Tampa Bay on June 7...allowed 2 runs on 8 hits and 1 walk while striking out 3 batters in 8+ innings pitched (pitched to one batter in the 9th inning)...first run allowed came on a solo home run in the 3rd inning...gave up a double to the leadoff batter in the 9th inning, who came around to score after Leake was relieved by Alex Colomé.

**NO FREE PASSES...**has allowed just 1 walk in his last 5 outings...has not allowed a walk in 5 starts this season, T3rd among Major League starters, trailing only Kluber (8) and Ivan Nova-PIT (6)...Leake's 1.90 walks per 9.0 innings are the 7th best among AL pitchers (12th in the Majors).

**GETTING LOOSE...**through Leake's first 25 pitches in a game, opponents are batting .361 (30x83) with a .384 on-base percentage and a .530 slugging percentage, but in pitches 26 through 100+, Leake has limited batters to a .242 average (56x231) with a .293 OBP and a .446 slugging mark.

**GIVE 'EM A CHANCE...**has exited 10 of his 13 starts with a lead (8 games) or a tie score (2 games)...in 2 of his other 3 starts, exited trailing 1-3 after 6.0 IP, and 0-3 in the 6th inning...the Mariners are 10-3 in his 13 starts this season.

**HELLO, SEATTLE...**since making his Mariners debut on Sept. 1, 2017, is 9-4 with a 3.91 ERA (49 ER, 112.2 IP) in 18 starts (11 quality starts)...during that span, Leake leads Mariners starters in wins and innings pitched and is tied with James Paxton for most quality starts...in 14 of his 18 Mariners starts, Leake has gone at least 5.0 innings and allowed 3 or fewer earned runs...the Mariners are 13-5 in Leake starts.

**FOUR SCORE...**is 11-1 with a 3.43 ERA (42 ER, 110.1 IP) in his last 17 starts in which he has received 4 or more runs of support, dating back to April 23, 2017...his clubs are a combined 14-3 in those 16 games (7-3 w/STL, 7-0 w/SEA)...for his career, Leake is 67-4 with a 3.44 ERA (245 ER, 641.1 IP) in 99 career starts when he has received 4+ runs of support; his clubs are 80-19 in those 99 starts.

**TAKING HIS TURN...**since making his Major League debut in 2010, has made 246 starts, 14th-most among all pitchers...among all pitchers since 2010, ranks 15th in innings pitched (1527.0).

**DAY AND NIGHT...**is 4-0 with a 3.12 ERA (9 ER, 26.0 IP) in 4 day games this season, while going 2-3 with a 5.10 ERA (31 ER, 54.2 IP) in 9 night starts...opponents are batting just .194 (18x102) with a .255 on-base percentage against Leake when the sun is out, while batting .308 (68x221) with a .343 on-base percentage after dark.

**2017 SEASON RECAP...**went 10-13 with a 3.92 ERA (81 ER, 186.0 IP) with 130 strikeouts and 37 walks in 31 starts...was acquired along with cash considerations and international slot money from STL on Aug. 30, 2017 in exchange for minor league infielder Rayder Ascanio...went 3-1 with a 2.53 ERA (9 ER, 32.0 IP) with 27 strikeouts and 2 walks in 5 starts with Seattle.

**DURABLE...**made 30 starts in each of the past 6 seasons...is one of 4 pitchers in the Major Leagues to make at least 30 starts in every season from 2012-17, joining Jon Lester, Max Scherzer and Ian Kennedy.

**GOING FOR DISTANCE...**recorded 3 starts in 2017 of at least 8.0 innings pitched and 1-or-fewer runs allowed (4/7 vs. CIN, 5/24 at LAD and 6/30 vs. WAS)...only 6 pitchers in MLB made more such starts last season (Corey Kluber, 8, Chris Sale, 4, Carlos Martinez, 4, Zach Greinke, 4, Jacob deGrom, 4 and Carlos Carrasco, 4).

**QUICK RISE...**became the 21st player since the MLB Draft began in 1965 to appear in the Major Leagues before playing in a minor league game (last: Xavier Nady, SD, 2000)...became just the 13th pitcher to reach the Majors before appearing in the minor leagues (last: Ariel Prieto, Oakland, 1995)...made his MLB debut on April 11, 2010 vs. Chicago-NL with Cincinnati after being selected by the Reds with the 8th overall pick in the 2009 MLB First-Year Player Draft...appeared in 6 games (5 starts) with the Peoria Saguaros in the Arizona Fall League in 2009.

**CAREER...**has appeared in 9 Major League seasons with Cincinnati (2010-15), San Francisco (2015), St. Louis (2016-17) and Seattle (2017-c)...has a career record of 89-80 with a 4.01 ERA (680 ER, 1527.0 IP) with 1,035 strikeouts and 359 walks in 251 career games (246 starts)...made his Major League debut in a start on April 11, 2010 vs. Chicago-NL with Cincinnati...selected by Oakland in the 7th round of the 2006 MLB First-Year Player Draft but did not sign...selected and signed by Cincinnati in the 1st round (8th overall pick) of the 2009 MLB Draft out of Arizona State University.

**TOMORROW'S PROBABLE STARTING PITCHER: LHP MARCO GONZALES (7-3, 3.28 ERA)**

26-year-old left-hander is scheduled to make his 14th start of the 2018 season tomorrow vs. Los Angeles-AL...has allowed just 3 earned runs in his last 5 starts combined (0.81 ERA, 33.1 IP, 21 H, 3 ER, 21 K, .183 batting average against)...has tossed 6.0+ innings in 8 of his last 9 starts (4/24-c), going 6-1 with a 2.04 ERA (13 ER, 57.1 IP) with 6 quality starts over that span...W#7 in his last start, a 4-3 Mariners win on 6/8 at TB (7.1,5,2,2,0,3,HR-1)...**SPRING TRAINING:** went 1-1 with 2.08 ERA (6 ER, 26.0 IP) in 6 Spring Training starts...**CAREER:** Drafted by St. Louis with 19th overall pick in the 2013 MLB Draft out of Gonzaga University...made MLB debut with the Cardinals on June 25, 2014 at Colorado...is 12-6 with a 4.40 ERA (74 ER, 151.1 IP) with 126 strikeouts in 35 games (27 starts) in parts of 4 Major League seasons with St. Louis (2014-15, 2017) and Seattle (2017-c)...missed the 2016 season while recovering from ligament replacement surgery on his left elbow...vs. LAA: Has made 3 career starts vs. the Angels, going 0-0 with a 4.40 ERA (7 ER, 14.1 IP)...did not factor into the decision in his start vs. the Angels on May 5 (6.0,9,4,4,1,7,HR-1).
