BLUE JAYS NOTES:

- Improved to 9-4 in extra-inning games and 13-12 in one-run contests...Now have 7 walk-off wins, 3 of which have come in their last 5 games against the Orioles...Have won 5 straight games against the O's, their longest win streak against them since a 12G stretch in 2010...Are back to .500 at home (25-25)...Improved to 13-4 when hitting 3+ HRs...Hit back-to-back home runs for the 3rd time this season (Martin/Grichuk - 5th inning)...Surrendered 4 home runs in a game to match a season high (also 5/10 vs. SEA).
- SAM GAVIGLIO** set career-highs with 8 strikeouts and 7.2 innings pitched...Threw 103 pitches, including a career-best 71 strikes...Allowed 4 runs on 7 hits...Now holds a 2.55 ERA (10 ER/35.1 IP) through his first 6 home starts as a Blue Jay (7.92 ERA in 6 road starts).
- ALEDMYS DIAZ** had the game-winning hit in the 10th inning, his 3rd career walk-off hit (last: 6/7 vs. BAL)...Opened the scoring with a solo home run in the 3rd inning...Was his 9th homer of the season, his 4th at home and his 4th against an AL East opponent...Finished with a pair of singles, a double and a HR for his 3rd career 4+ hit game (last: 5/5/17 at ATL - 4H)...Has gone 37-for-132 (.280) with 8-2B, 3-HR and 12-RBI since coming off the DL on 6/1 (.216 AVG before DL stint).
- RUSSELL MARTIN** tied the game, 2-2, as he led off the 5th inning with a first-pitch home run...Was his first extra-base hit since a HR vs. BAL on 6/8...The 20 games without an XBH was the 2nd longest such streak of his career (21G from 4/23-5/22/16)...Marked his 61st HR as a catcher for the Blue Jays, 2 back of J.P. Arencibia for 2nd most in team history (Whitt - 127).
- RANDAL GRICHUK** followed up Martin's home run with his 12th blast of the season, forming Toronto's 3rd set of back-to-back homers this year (last: 6/17 vs. WSH - Hernandez/Solarte)...Has hit 10 of his HR since 6/3...Is slugging .561 with a .882 OPS and 23 RBI over that span.
- DEVON TRAVIS** notched his 3rd triple of the season as he drove in a run in the 7th inning...Also walked as part of a 1-for-3 night...Has hit .295 (38-for-129) over his last 41 contests.
- CURTIS GRANDERSON** hit a ground-rule double and scored in the 5th inning to snap a 0-for-15 streak...Added an RBI single in his next at-bat for his 13th multi-hit game.

ORIOLES NOTES:

- Are now 4-7 in extra-inning affairs with 3 of those losses coming in their last 5 games at Rogers Centre...Fall to 1-7 vs. Toronto and 11-26 in divisional games...Have lost each of their last 5 games at Rogers Centre and 7 of their last 8 here...Allowed 3+ HRs for the 15th time, 7th most in MLB (5th in AL)...Hit 4 home runs in a game for the 5th time and are now 4-1 in such contests.
- DYLAN BUNDY** allowed 5 runs on 5 hits over 5.0 innings...Struck out a trio of batters while issuing 1 walk...Has allowed exactly 5 ER in each of his last 3 starts...Came into tonight with a 3-1 record and a 1.17 ERA (4 ER/30.2 IP) over his last 8 starts vs. Toronto.
- TIM BECKHAM** put the O's ahead, 2-1, with a two-run homer in the 5th inning...Was his 3rd HR of the season, all of which have accounted for Baltimore's first run(s) of the game...Marked his first road HR since 9/17/17 at NYY...Has gone 20-for-85 (.235) with 4-2B, 2-HR and 6-RBI since coming off the DL on 6/25.
- CHRIS DAVIS** notched his 10th home run with a two-run shot in the 8th inning...Was his 39th HR against the Blue Jays, his most vs. any team (2nd: 31 vs. NYY)...Has hit 3 HR in his last 10 games and 6 in his last 24 contests.
- CALEB JOSEPH** brought the Orioles to within a run of the Jays with a solo home run in the 9th inning...Was his 2nd HR this year (also 5/8 vs. KC)...Of his 30 career HRs, 5 have come in the 9th inning...Marked his first road HR since 8/8/17 at LAA.
- JONATHAN SCHOOP** tied the game at 7's in the 9th inning with his 11 home run...Is now batting .355 (22-for-62) with 6-2B, 3-HR and 5-RBI in 16 July games (.144 in 25 June games).
- TREY MANCINI** singled and doubled in a 2-for-4 evening...Is now a lifetime .315 (29-for-92) batter against the Jays and .333 (17-for-51) with at Rogers Centre.
