WHITE SOX AT A GLANCE

- The Chicago White Sox have lost four of their last five games as they continue their first homestand of the season this afternoon with the finale vs. Detroit ... RHP Reynaldo López, who has thrown at least 6.0 IP in each of his five career starts at Guaranteed Rate Field, takes the mound for the White Sox.
- The Sox have lost the first two games of this homestand, including a 6-1 setback yesterday.
- Following today's game, the White Sox conclude the homestand with three games vs. Tampa Bay (4/9-11) before taking a seven-game trip to Minnesota (4/12-15) and Oakland (4/16-18).
- The Sox went 3-2 on their first trip of the season to Kansas City (2-0) and Toronto (1-2), rallying to win both games of an abbreviated two-game series against the Royals before losing two of three games to the Blue Jays.

TODAY'S STORYLINES

- The Tigers are looking for their first three-game sweep at Guaranteed Rate Field since 9/12-14/11.
- The White Sox lead the major leagues with a .508 slugging percentage and .862 OPS and rank second with 14 home runs.
- Reynaldo López has made six quality starts in his last seven outings dating back to 9/1/17.
- Wellington Castillo is 11-20 (.550) with one homer and five RBI in five career games against Detroit.
- José Abreu is a .371/.438/.543 (52-140) hitter in 37 career home games vs. Detroit.

ROSTER MOVES

- Prior to today's game, the White Sox purchased the contract of RHP Bruce Rondón from Class AAA Charlotte ... Rondón, 27, threw 1.0 scoreless IP on 4/5 at Durham in his only appearance with Charlotte this season.
- He appeared in 123 games with Detroit over parts of four seasons (2013, '15-17), recording seven saves ... Rondón takes the roster spot of RHP Juan Minaya, who was optioned to Charlotte following yesterday's game.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

- The White Sox stranded 11 baserunners in a 6-1 loss to Detroit.
- The Sox went 0-8 with RISP and were unable to score after loading the bases with no outs in the second inning.
- Lucas Giolitto suffered the loss, allowing five runs on four hits, three walks and two hit batters ... Héctor Santiago (2.1 IP) and Gregory Infante (1.0) made scoreless outings in relief.
- Yoán Moncada, Nicky Delmonico and Wellington Castillo each collected two hits.
- The game time temperature of 32 degrees was the Sox coldest at home since 4/9/16 vs. Cleveland (also 32) ... source: STATS.

- Tomorrow's White Sox game vs. Tampa Bay, originally scheduled for 7:10 p.m. CT, has been moved to 1:10 p.m. CT due to anticipated cold weather.
- Fans holding used or unused tickets and parking coupons for the game may redeem them for a comparable ticket to any future White Sox game (excluding the Cubs series) based on availability ... tickets may be redeemed at the Guaranteed Rate Field box office beginning at 10 a.m. on 4/10.
- WGN-TV, WGN Radio AM-720 and WRTO-AM 1200/Univision Radio will broadcast the game.

HAWK'S FAREWELL

- Ken "Hawk" Harrelson, who is in his 33rd and final season in the White Sox television booth in 2018, will call today's game alongside Steve Stone.
- Harrelson will work primarily Sunday home games this season as well as select other contests ... he will serve the organization as a team ambassador throughout the 2019 season, which will mark the beginning of his eighth decade in baseball.

WHO'S HOT?

- Avisail García is hitting .378/.428/.542 (76-201) over his last 53 games dating back to 8/10/17.
- José Abreu is batting .349/.387/.651 (38-109) with seven home runs and 21 RBI over his last 29 games (since 9/9/17).
- Tim Anderson owns a .328 average (43-131) with six homers, 15 RBI and 27 runs scored over his last 32 games (since 9/3/17).

AT THE HELM

- Rick Renteria is in his second season after being named the 40th manager in White Sox history on 10/3/16.
- Renteria was the only Latino manager in the major leagues in 2017 but has been joined by Boston's Alex Cora and Washington's Dave Martinez in 2018.

WHITE SOX VS. DETROIT

- The Tigers lead the season series, 2-0.
- The Sox are batting .260/.341/.411 (19-73) with a 7.11 ERA (15 ER/19.0 IP) and have been outscored by the Tigers, 15-8.
- The White Sox went 10-9 in 2017 for their first season series victory over the Tigers since 2008.
- Chicago is 61-90 against Detroit since 2010 (36-40 at home).
- The White Sox trail in the all-time series, 1,049-1,089 ... they are 562-510 in Chicago (125-95 at Guaranteed Rate Field) and 487-579 in Detroit (78-88 at Comerica Park).

TIGER TAMERS

- José Abreu is a career .337/.404/.575 (96-285) hitter with 19 doubles, 15 home runs and 47 RBI in 75 career games vs. Detroit, including a .373 (46-123) average with six homers and 19 RBI in his last 32.
- Avisail García has 53 RBI in 70 games against his former team, including a 5-5 effort with seven RBI on 9/14/17 at Comerica Park ... Matt Davidson owns a .362 (21-58) average with five home runs and 14 RBI in 17 career games.
- Omar Narváez is batting .375 (18-48) with a .464 on-base percentage in 16 career games ... Yolmer Sánchez is 18-51 (.353) with 10 RBI in his last 14 games.

LOOKING FOR CENTRAL COMMAND

- The White Sox are 2-2 against the American League Central in 2018 after going 33-43 (.434) last season.
- The Sox are 293-379 vs. the AL Central since 2009, posting a losing record every season except 2012 (37-35).

ROSTER QUICK FACTS

- The Sox 25-man roster includes 13 pitchers (three LHP), two catchers, six infielders and four outfielders ... the average age is 27.7, including 28.8 for pitchers and 26.4 for position players.
- LHP Aaron Bummer, OF Nicky Delmonico, OF Adam Engel, RHP Carson Fulmer, RHP Lucas Giolitto, RHP Gregory Infante, RHP Reynaldo López, RHP Juan Minaya and Moncada have made their first career Opening Day roster.

QUALITY IS JOB ONE

- The White Sox have made a major-league leading 1,317 quality starts since the start of the 2003 season, four more than the Mets and 46 more than Oakland, the next-closest American League team.

ABREU IN ELITE COMPANY

- José Abreu is one of three players in major-league history to begin his career with at least four consecutive seasons of 25-plus homers and 100-plus RBI, joining Hall-of-Famer Joe DiMaggio (1936-41) and Albert Pujols.
- Abreu also has joined Al Simmons (11, 1924-34), Pujols (10, 2001-10), Ted Williams (1939-42, '46-49) and DiMaggio (1936-42) as the only players in history to record 100 or more RBI in each of his first four seasons.

CALL TO THE HALL

- Jim Thome, who played for the White Sox from 2006-09 and serves as a special assistant to the general manager, will be inducted into the Baseball Hall of Fame on 7/29/18.
- Thome, who ranks eighth in major-league history with 612 home runs, received 89.8 percent of the votes to become the fifth former Sox player inducted on the first ballot.
- He will join Chipper Jones, Vladimir Guerrero, Trevor Hoffman Jack Morris and Alan Trammell in the Class of 2018.

ON THE FARM

- The White Sox minor-league system is rated by *Baseball America* as the fourth-best in baseball.
- The Sox organization features five of *Baseball America's* Top 100 prospects: OF Eloy Jiménez (No. 4), RHP Michael Kopech (No. 11), RHP Alec Hansen (No. 57), OF Luis Robert (No. 58) and RHP Dane Dunning (No. 82) ... Jiménez (No. 4), Kopech (No. 10), Robert (No. 28), Hansen (No. 54), RHP Dylan Cease (No. 71), Dunning (No. 92) and OF Blake Rutherford (No. 99) are ranked in MLB.com's Top 100.

ON DECK: TAMPA BAY RAYS

- The White Sox conclude the homestand with three games vs. Tampa Bay ... RHP Carson Fulmer (0-0, 5.40) is scheduled to start tomorrow's series opener.
- The Sox and Rays split the 2017 season series, 3-3, with each team winning two of three games at home ... the Sox outscored the Rays, 22-21 ... five of the six games were decided by two runs or less.
- Chicago is 5-2 at home vs. Tampa Bay since 2016.

LÓPEZ AT A GLANCE

- The 24-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his second start of the 2018 season and second career against the Detroit Tigers.
- Went 3-0 with a 4.62 ERA (13 ER/25.1 IP) over his final four starts of 2017 ... made his White Sox debut on 8/11/17 vs. Kansas City, receiving a no decision after allowing two runs with six strikeouts over 6.0 IP.
- Was named the White Sox Minor League Pitcher of the Month for July after posting a 2.10 ERA (7 ER/30.0 IP) with 38 strikeouts and a .183 (20-109) opponents average over five starts.
- Was acquired from Washington with RHPs Dane Dunning and Lucas Giolito in exchange for OF Adam Eaton on 12/7/16 ... originally was signed by the Nationals as a non-drafted free agent on 6/21/12.

LAST START

- Received a no decision despite posting a quality start (1 ER/6.0 IP) on 4/2 at Toronto.
- Allowed a career low two hits including a solo homerun to Josh Donaldson in the sixth ... departed with the Sox and Blue Jays tied, 1-1 after tossing 100 pitches (63 strikes) ... the Sox went on to lose, 4-2.

SPRING 2018 RECAP

- Started five games in the Cactus League, going 1-2 with a 3.86 ERA (8 ER/18.2 IP).
- Went 1-0 with a 0.96 ERA (1 ER/9.1 IP) over his first three starts, compared to a 0-2 with a 6.75 ERA (7 ER/9.1 IP) in his last two starts.

2017 REVIEW

- Made eight starts with the White Sox in his first season with the organization ... went 1-2 with a 3.56 ERA (12 ER/30.0 IP) in five starts at home and 2-1 with a 6.75 mark (13 ER/17.1 IP) over three road starts.
- Five of his seven starts were quality ... went 2-2 with a 3.15 ERA (11 ER/30.1 IP) and 16 strikeouts in those outings.
- Worked a career-high tying 7.0 IP (four runs) in a win on 9/16 at Detroit ... allowed three runs in the second inning before limiting the Tigers to one run on five hits over his final 5.0 IP.
- Suffered his first loss with the White Sox on 8/17 at Texas, allowing six runs on five hits over 4.1 IP before exiting game with soreness on his right side.
- Was placed on the disabled list on 8/19 (retro to 8/18) with a back strain ... reinstated on 9/1, made the start that night vs. Tampa Bay (L; 3 ER/6.0 IP).
- Made 22 starts with Class AAA Charlotte, going 6-7 with a 3.79 ERA (51 ER/121.0 IP) and 131 strikeouts ... allowed two earned runs or less in seven of his final eight starts from 6/29-8/6 before being promoted.
- Entered the season ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 3 Prospect in the White Sox organization and No. 31 in baseball ... was rated by MLB.com as the No. 4 Prospect in the Sox system, No. 38 in baseball and the No. 9 right-handed pitching prospect.

MINOR-LEAGUE CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Was named the White Sox Minor League Pitcher of the Month for July 2017 after posting a 2.10 ERA (7 ER/30.0 IP) with 38 strikeouts and a .183 (20-109) opponents average over five starts.
- Has gone 25-26 with a 3.72 ERA (159 ER/428.2 IP) and 434 strikeouts in 83 games (78 starts) over six minor-league seasons between the White Sox and Nationals organizations.
- Struck out 10-plus batters on four occasions in 2017: 4/11 at Durham (10 SO/5.1 IP), 6/29 vs. Columbus (11 SO/6.2 IP), 7/16 vs. Gwinnett (12 SO/7.0 IP) and 7/26 vs. Columbus (10 SO/5.0 IP).
- Named 2015 Carolina League Pitcher of the Week for 8/10-16 after striking out 11 over 7.0 scoreless IP on 8/12 vs. Winston-Salem ... in 2014 was named the New York-Penn League Pitcher of the Week from 6/23-29 after throwing 5.2 scoreless IP with eight strikeouts on 6/23 vs. Batavia.

PERSONAL NOTES

- His grandfather sold two cows in the Dominican Republic to buy him a used glove, a pair of cleats and an aluminum bat when he started playing baseball.

VS. DETROIT TIGERS

- Is making his second career start against the Detroit Tigers and first this season.
- Received the win in his first career start against the Tigers on 9/16/17 ... allowed four runs on seven hits with one strikeout and two walks over 7.0 IP.

VS. AMERICAN LEAGUE CENTRAL

- Is making his sixth career start against the American League Central and first this season.
- Has gone 3-1 with a 3.45 ERA (12 ER/31.1 IP), 10 strikeouts and a .266 (34-137) opponents average in five starts vs. the AL Central.
- Received the win in his last start on 9/22/17 vs. Kansas City ... allowed six runs on nine hits with zero strikeouts over 6.1 IP.

HOME SWEET HOME

- Is making his sixth career start at Guaranteed Rate Field ... has gone 1-2 with a 3.56 ERA (12 ER/30.1 IP), 22 strikeouts and a .242 (29-130) opponents average in five starts.

TOMORROW'S SCHEDULED STARTER

- RHP Miguel González is scheduled to make his second start of the season and 17th start against the Tampa Bay Rays.
- Suffered the loss in his season debut on 4/3 at Toronto, allowing six runs on eight hits with two walks over 5.0 IP.
- Combined to go 8-13 with a 4.62 ERA (80 ER/156.0 IP) and 100 strikeouts in 27 starts between the White Sox and the Rangers in the 2017 season.
- Has gone 7-4 with a 2.76 ERA (30 ER/97.2 IP) lifetime against the Rays, and 9-7 with a 3.49 ERA (47 ER/121.1 IP) over 19 career starts at Guaranteed Rate Field.
