WHITE SOX AT A GLANCE

- The Chicago White Sox have lost four consecutive games but won eight of their last 15 games, 14 of 24 and 19 of 35 as they conclude their penultimate homestand today vs. the Angels.
- RHP Reynaldo López, who has allowed just one earned run over 7.0 IP in each of his last two outings, is scheduled to start.
- The Sox are 3-6 on the homestand, losing the first two games vs. Los Angeles-AL after losing two of three vs. Detroit and splitting a four-game series vs. Boston.
- Following this afternoon's series finale vs. the Angels, Chicago will take a nine-game, 11-day trip to Kansas City (8/10-12), Baltimore (8/14-16) and Cleveland (8/18-20).
- The Sox went 5-2 on their last trip to Detroit (3-1) and New York-AL (2-1) on 8/23-29, including their first series win at Yankee Stadium since 2005.

TONIGHT'S STORYLINES

- The White Sox have lost four consecutive games, their longest losing streak since 7/4-10 (six straight).
- Chicago is trying to avoid being swept by the Angels at home for the first time since 4/15-17/11 ... the Sox have lost four consecutive games to Los Angeles-AL by a 40-16 margin.
- White Sox starters have allowed 21 earned runs on 28 hits, including seven home runs and nine walks, over the last four games (13.2 IP), and failed to work into the sixth inning once.
- The Sox have scored four runs or less in each of the last five games (2.8 R/G), batting .214/.272/.327 with four home runs.
- Reynaldo López is 1-0 with a 1.83 ERA (4 ER/19.2 IP), 19 strikeouts, .183 average and 0.92 WHIP in his last three starts.

ROSTER MOVE

- Prior to today's game, the White Sox outrighted RHP Tyler Danish to Class AAA Charlotte ... he went 1-0 with a 7.11 ERA (5 ER/6.1 IP) and five strikeouts in seven relief outings in 2018.
- The Sox 40-man roster decreases to 39.

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP

- The Angels opened up a three-run game by scoring six times in the ninth inning en route to a 12-3 win over the White Sox.
- Shohei Ohtani extended the lead to six with a bases-clearing triple in the top of the ninth to open the scoring run.
- Los Angeles-AL scored three times each in the first and third, including a two-run homer and three-run shot by Mike Trout.
- James Shields suffered the loss after allowing six runs on nine hits, including two home runs, over 4.1 IP ... the Sox bullpen combined to allow six runs (five earned) in 4.2 IP.
- Yolmer Sánchez went 2-3 with two doubles and a RBI and Kevan Smith was 2-4 with a double and RBI.
- Chicago committed two errors and threw five wild pitches.

STARTING STRUGGLES

- Chicago starters have allowed 21 earned runs on 28 hits, including seven homers and nine walks over the last four games (13.2 IP) ... no starter has worked into the sixth inning, and the group has allowed five-plus runs three times during that span.
- By comparison, White Sox starters went 5-1 with a 2.01 ERA (15 ER/67.0 IP), just six homers allowed, a .176 opponents average and seven QS in the previous 11 games from 8/24-9/3.

POSTSEASON VOYAGE

- Advanced Rookie Great Falls last night defeated Billings, 9-2, to complete a sweep in the best-of-three, Pioneer League semis.
- Great Falls will play in the PL championship series for the second straight season (lost to Ogden in 2017) ... the Voyagers will face either Grand Junction or Ogden for the championship.
- Class A Winston-Salem and Class A Kannapolis have been eliminated from their postseason semifinal series.

ON-BASE MACHINE

- Yolmer Sánchez has reached base safely in 24 of his last 25 games, hitting .298 (28-94) with seven doubles, one home run, five RBI, 14 walks, three HBP and seven multihit efforts ... he has hit safely in 21 contests and walked multiple times in three.
- Sánchez reached base safely in a career-high 22 consecutive games from 8/11-9/3, the longest streak by a White Sox since 1B José Abreu (29 games) from 8/2-9/2/16.

WINNING WAYS

- The White Sox have gone 14-10 (.583) since 8/14, tied with Cleveland for the fifth-best record in the American League.
- The Sox are 19-16 since 8/2, moving from 9.0 games behind Detroit to within three games of Detroit in the AL Central.
- Chicago is 23-24 in the second half, including a 17-12 mark in August, its most wins in a month since May 2012 (18-11) ... the club is 9-8 since José Abreu was placed on the DL on 8/22.

WHITE SOX VS. LOS ANGELES ANGELS

- The White Sox are 2-4 vs. the Angels this season and have been outscored by a 45-25 margin.
- The Sox are hitting .236/.305/.432 with 10 home runs, own a 7.62 ERA (34 ER/52.0 IP) and have made two quality starts.
- Chicago is 5-5 in the last 10 games but is 5-12 in the last 17 ... the club is 9-5 over the last 14 games at Guaranteed Rate Field, compared to 3-16 in the last 19 at Angel Stadium.
- Chicago has lost seven of the last eight season series dating back to 2011 ... 2015 marked the only victory (4-3).
- The White Sox trail in the all-time series, 363-372 ... they are 194-171 at home (68-60 at Guaranteed Rate Field) and 169-201 on the road (147-178 at Angel Stadium).

WINDY CITY & CITY OF ANGELS CONNECTIONS

- White Sox manager Rick Renteria is a native of Harbor City, Calif., located approximately 30 miles from Anaheim, Calif.
- Aaron Bummer (Valencia), Ryan Cordell (Sacramento), Dylan Covey (Glendale), Matt Davidson (Yucaipa), Lucas Giolito (Santa Monica) and James Shields (Newhall) are natives of California.
- Sox hitting coach Todd Stevers is a native of Los Angeles.
- Angels bench coach Josh Paul (1999-2003) and bullpen coach Scott Radinsky (1990-95) both played for the White Sox.

WILD WILD WEST

- The White Sox are 10-23 vs. the American League West in 2018, going 6-10 at home and 4-13 on the road ... they have been outscored, 78-56, in the 14 road games.
- The Sox have lost 10 of the last 13 games, 12 of the last 16 and 17 of the last 26 ... the White Sox have won consecutive games vs. the division just twice this season.
- Chicago has lost 13 of 17 games and 19 of 26 on the road ... the club has allowed seven-plus runs 14 times in the last 26.
- The Sox are 188-177 vs. the West since 2008 (80-102 on road).

PALKA POWER

- Daniel Palka, who was claimed off waivers from Minnesota on 11/4/17, ranks among the American League rookie leaders in home runs (3rd, 21), RBI (3rd, 55), extra-base hits (3rd, 38), runs scored (T5th, 47) and total bases (5th, 168).
- Palka's 21 homers are the second-highest total in Sox history by a LH rookie, one behind Pete Ward's club record of 22 in 1963.
- His three pinch-hit homers this season are tied with Oscar Gamble (1977), John Romano (1959) and Ron Northey (1956) for the White Sox franchise record, and his nine RBI are the most by a Sox pinch-hitter since Jerry Hairston in 1987 (10).

POWER AND SPEED

- Tim Anderson (18 HR/26 SB) is one of four players in the major leagues with at least 18 home runs and 26 stolen bases, joining Boston's Mookie Betts, Pittsburgh's Starling Marte and Cleveland's José Ramírez.
- Anderson is attempting to become the first White Sox shortstop to record a 20-HR/20-SB season, and could join Alex Ríos (2010) and Tommie Agee (1966) as the only players in franchise history to post 20 homers and 30 steals in one season.

QUALITY AND QUANTITY

- The White Sox have made 1,379 quality starts since the start of the 2003 season, one behind the New York Mets (1,380) for the highest total in the major leagues and 51 more than Oakland (1,328), the next-closest American League team.
- The Sox are tied with Boston for third in th AL with 64 quality starts this season ... RHP James Shields is tied for seventh in the AL with 17 QS in 2018.

HE NOT GONE YET

- This afternoon's game marks Ken "Hawk" Harrelson's fourth-to-last broadcast of his 33rd and final season in the Sox TV booth.
- Harrelson's final three games will be from 9/21-23 vs. the Cubs.
- The Sox and NBC Sports Chicago have produced a documentary that chronicles the life and career of Harrelson ... "Hawk" premieres on 9/13 at 7:00 p.m. CT, exclusively on NBC Sports Chicago, NBCSportsChicago.com, and on the NBC Sports app.

ON DECK: AT KANSAS CITY ROYALS

- The White Sox begin their penultimate trip of the season with three games at Kansas City ... RHP Lucas Giolito (10-10, 5.85), who leads the Sox with 10 wins, is scheduled to start the opener.
- Chicago leads the season series, 10-6, going 5-4 at Guaranteed Rate Field and 5-2 at Kauffman Stadium.
- The White Sox are 5-6 over the last 11 games after winning the first five in the season series.
- Giolito is 2-0 with a 2.50 ERA (5 ER/18.0 IP) and a .197 opp. average in three starts vs. the Royals this season.

THIS DAY IN SOX HISTORY - 9/9

2017 - José Abreu became just the sixth player in White Sox history to hit for the cycle vs. San Francisco, and the first since José Valentin on 4/27/00 vs. Baltimore ... according to Elias, he was the first Cuban-born player in MLB history to record a cycle ... he hit his 29th home run in the first, recorded a double in the third, a single in the seventh and a triple in the eighth.

LÓPEZ AT A GLANCE

- The 24-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his 29th start of the season, 14th at home and second career against the Los Angeles Angels.
- Is 1-0 with a 1.83 ERA (4 ER/19.2 IP), 19 strikeouts and a .183 (13-41) opponents average over his last three starts.
- Is 0-2 with a 5.91 ERA (23 ER/35.0 IP), 31 strikeouts and a .252 (35-139) opponents average over his last six home starts ... has not recorded a win at home since 6/26 vs. Minnesota.
- Went 3-0 with a 4.62 ERA (13 ER/25.1 IP) over his final four starts of 2017 ... made his White Sox debut on 8/11/17 vs. Kansas City, receiving a no decision after allowing two runs with six strikeouts over 6.0 IP.
- Was named the White Sox Minor League Pitcher of the Month for July 2017 after posting a 2.10 ERA (7 ER/30.0 IP) with 38 strikeouts and a .183 (20-109) opponents average over five starts.
- Was acquired from Washington with RHPs Dane Dunning and Lucas Giolito in exchange for OF Adam Eaton on 12/7/16 ... originally was signed by the Nationals as a non-drafted free agent on 6/21/12.

LAST START

- Received his 14th no decision of the season on 9/3 vs. Detroit ... allowed one run on four hits with six strikeouts over 7.0 IP.
- Allowed a solo home run to Niko Goodrum in the seventh inning, the only run for the Tigers.
- Departed with the White Sox tied, 1-1, after throwing 98 pitches (63 strikes) ... the White Sox went on to win, 4-1 ... Daniel Palka hit a home run and Matt Davidson hit a two-run homer in the ninth.

LOW RISP, HIGH REWARD

- Is limiting opponents to a .221 average with RISP (32-145) and .179 mark with RISP/two outs (12-67) this season ... opponents are 53-239 (.222) with RISP and 21-107 (.196) with RISP/two outs in his career.
- His .221 average with RISP is the fourth-lowest among American League pitchers.

HOME NOT SO SWEET HOME

- Is making his 19th career start at Guaranteed Rate Field ... has gone 3-5 with a 3.95 ERA (49 ER/111.2 IP), 81 strikeouts and a .226 (96-424) opponents average in 18 career starts.
- Is 2-3 with a 4.09 ERA (37 ER/81.1 IP), 59 strikeouts and a .220 (67-304) opponents average in 13 starts this season.
- Received a no decision in his last start on 9/3 vs. Detroit ... allowed one run on four hits over 7.0 IP ... has not recorded a win at home since 6/26 vs. Minnesota.

HELP WANTED

- Owns a 3.26 run support average (59 RS/162.2 IP) in 2018, the second-lowest in the American League and second in the majors behind Andrew Cashner from Baltimore.
- Has received three runs of support or less in 20 of his 28 starts ... the Sox have scored five runs of support over his last four starts.
- Received a 7.55 RSA (40 RS/47.2 IP) in eight starts last season.

NO DECISION MADE

- Is tied for second in the American League and tied for third in the majors with 14 no decisions this season ... owns a 3.28 ERA (31 ER/75.0 IP) in those starts.
- The Sox have scored a total of 20 runs of support in his 14 no decision this season ... including one run three times, two runs three times and three runs once ... the Sox are 6-7 when López receives a no decision.

DAY AND NIGHT

- Is 3-5 with a 3.92 ERA (36 ER/82.2 IP), .221 (68-307) opponents average and .677 opponents OPS in 14 day starts (eight quality) this season ... compared to 2-4 with a 4.84 ERA (43 ER/80.0 IP), .267 (82-307) opponents average and .824 opponents OPS in 14 night starts (six quality).
- Has gone 4-5 with a 4.35 ERA (45 ER/93.0 IP), .229 (80-349) opponents average and .701 opponents OPS in 18 career appearances (15 starts, eight quality) during the day, compared to 9-10 with a 4.63 ERA (83 ER/161.1 IP), .264 (166-628) opponents average and .782 opponents OPS in 29 career games (27 starts) at night.

MAKING HISTORY

- Is the first White Sox pitcher with 6.0-plus IP, two-or-fewer hits allowed, and one-or-fewer runs allowed in each of his first two starts of the season (source: Elias).
- Became the first White Sox starting pitcher since at least 1908 to lose a game in which he threw 7.0-plus IP while allowing two or less hits and one run which was unearned (source: Baseball Reference and STATS LLC) ... the last five pitchers to accomplish this feat:

VS. AMERICAN LEAGUE WEST

- Is making his ninth career start against the American League West and seventh this season.
- Is 2-4 with a 4.57 ERA (23 ER/45.1 IP), 42 strikeouts and a .226 (38-168) opponents average over eight starts lifetime ... is 2-3 with a 3.34 ERA (13 ER/35.0 IP), 29 strikeouts and a .217 (28-129) opponents average over six starts this season ... has allowed two home runs against the American League West this season.
- Suffered the loss in his last start on 7/22 at Seattle, allowing five runs on five hits over 5.0 IP.

VS. LOS ANGELES ANGELS

- Is scheduled to make his second career start against the Angels and first this season.
- Received a no decision in his last start on 9/27/17 after allowing four runs on five hits with seven strikeouts over 6.0 IP.

TOMORROW'S SCHEDULED STARTER

- RHP Lucas Giolito (10-10, 5.85 ERA) is scheduled to make his 29th start of 2018, 15th on the road and sixth career against the Kansas City Royals.
- Is 3-1 with a 4.05 ERA (12 ER/26.2 IP), 30 strikeouts and a .216 (22-102) opponents average over his last five starts.
- Suffered the loss in his last start on 9/4 vs. the Detroit Tigers ... allowing four runs on four hits with three strikeouts over a season-low tying 1.1 IP.
- Is 8-6 with a 4.02 ERA (47 ER/105.1 IP) with 70 strikeouts and a .224 (88-392) opponents average over 18 starts lifetime against the American League Central.
- Is 2-0 with a 2.50 ERA (5 ER/18.0 IP), nine strikeouts and a .197 (12-61) opponents average over three starts against the Royals this season ... is 3-0 with a 2.01 ERA (7 ER/31.1 IP) over five starts lifetime.
