THE TWINS: After completing their 10-game, 11-day roadtrip with a record of 7-3 (3-1 at Chicago-AL, 2-0 at St. Louis and 2-2 at Los Angeles-AL), the Twins began their nine-game homestand with a loss to the Mariners on Monday and a win over the Cardinals last night... today they will play the second of two vs. St. Louis...they will enjoy an off-day tomorrow, followed by three vs. Milwaukee this weekend and three vs. Detroit next week May 21-23... the Twins have won eight of their last 11 overall...they are seeking their second sweep this season, the other was also against the Cardinals in two games May 7-8 at Busch Stadium.

TWINS ONCE AGAIN CHANNEL THEIR INNER '87: The Twins beat the Cardinals last night by a score of 4-1...José Berríos (4-4) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on two hits in 7.1 innings pitched, one walk and 10 strikeouts...Fernando Rodney converted his sixth straight save opportunity with a perfect ninth inning...the offense recorded nine hits, including a two-run homer from Bobby Wilson in the seventh inning.

IL PLAY, FOR THE RECORD: The Twins have gone 5-3 in Interleague Play this season, going 1-1 at Pittsburgh, 1-2 vs. Cincinnati and 3-0 vs. St. Louis...they have won 15 of their last 18 vs. the NL, dating back to August 2...the Twins next IL matchup will be this weekend with Milwaukee for three games at Target Field...the Twins have won five straight against the Cards...below are their longest streaks ever against a single NL opponent:

TWINS AND CARDS: The Twins have gone 13-12 all-time against the Cardinals...they are seeking their second sweep of the Cardinals this season and third straight sweep over them, dating back to June of 2015 (all 3 coming in 2 games).

☞ Today's starter Lance Lynn was drafted by the Cardinals in the first round (39th overall) of the 2008 First-Year Player Draft...he pitched in 183 games (161 starts) for the Cards from 2011-17, going 72-47, 3.38 ERA (977.2 IP, 367 ER), including an All-Star appearance in 2012 en route to 18 wins.

☞ Cardinals Third Base Coach José Oquendo and Assistant Coach Willie McGee played against the Twins in the 1987 World Series as McGee made the final out in game seven, grounding out to third baseman Gary Gaetti as the Twins won their first ever World Championship.

MAKING A RUN: After going 2-12 in 14 games from April 20-May 3, the Twins have gone 8-3 in their last 11 since...during that 11-game span, the Twins have out-scored opponents 51-30 and out-hit them 95-75...during that time the offense has recorded 22 doubles and 13 home runs while the pitching has posted a 2.69 ERA (100.1 IP, 30 ER) with an opponent batting average of .209, nine home runs allowed, 33 walks and 95 strikeouts.

☞ Individuals during that 11-game span: Robbie Grossman is hitting .364 (8-for-22)...Eddie Rosario is hitting .356 (16-for-45) with four doubles, four home runs, 11 runs scored and 10 RBI...Brian Dozier is hitting .311 (14-for-45) with three home runs.

ARROWS FLYING: Fernando Rodney has converted each of his last six saves after beginning the season 2-for-5 in save opportunities...he has posted eight consecutive scoreless appearances, holding opponents to a .080 batting average with two hits allowed (0 extra-base hits) and five walks in that span...he has converted 26 of his last 30 save opportunities dating back to early July.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2010, Jason Kubel hit an eighth inning grand slam off Mariano Rivera for a 6-3 win at New Yankee Stadium...Rivera had converted a record-tying 51 consecutive save opportunities at home and had not given up a grand slam since 2002; the runs were also the first he allowed that season.

HAPPY BIRTHDAY, BLACK JACK: Hall of Famer Jack Morris is celebrating his 63rd birthday today...during his 18-year major league career, he pitched one game on his birthday, that coming in 1987, pitching a complete game over Cleveland at Tiger Stadium, allowing three runs on five hits with 11 strikeouts...he shares a birthday with University of Minnesota baseball coach John Anderson (64), actress Megan Fox (32), pop singer Janet Jackson (52), actor Pierce Brosnan (65), and former Nirvana bassist Krist Novoselic (53).

MLB'S JUNE DRAFT RELEASED: Major League Baseball will hold day one of the 2018 MLB Draft on Monday, June 4 at MLB Network's Studio 42 in Secaucus, New Jersey...this year's Draft will begin live on MLB Network and MLB.com at 6:00 pm (CT)...the Twins draft three times in the first 74 selections, including the 20th pick in the first round, the 59th in the second round, and 74th in the Competitive Balance Round B...the last time the Twins drafted 20th overall was in 2006 selecting first baseman/outfielder Chris Parmelee out of Chino Hills High School...they have also selected 20th overall six different times including drafting Torii Hunter in 1993, Denard Span in 2002 and Trevor Plouffe in 2004...last June draft, the Twins selected first overall, taking shortstop Royce Lewis out of JSerra Catholic High School.

LAST START: In his seventh start of the season, Lynn lasted just 4.2 innings and surrendered four runs on eight hits, walking two and striking out three...he did not factor in the decision, as the Twins scored three runs to take the lead in the top of the ninth inning to win 5-4...in his second career-start against the Angels, Lynn is now 0-1 with a 7.59 ERA against the Angels, both games being played in Anaheim.

A FAMILIAR FOE?: Today's start marks Lynn's first career appearance against his former team...Lynn was a first-round pick for the Cardinals in 2008 First-Year Player Draft...over his six years with the Cardinals, he ranked first among starters on the team in games started (161) and ERA (3.38) and second in wins (72) and innings pitched (977.2), despite missing all of 2016 due to "Tommy John" surgery.

MILESTONE ALERT: Lynn eclipsed the 1000.0 inning mark for his career in his start on April 30 against Toronto...there are 71 active players in MLB that have 1,000-or-more innings, 12 of those have 2,000+ IP and just two have 3,000 IP or more...Lynn ranks 72nd in innings among active with 1012.0 innings.

- First pitcher in Twins uniform to reach 1,000.0 innings pitched since Phil Hughes in April of 2015.
- Lynn currently has 955 career-strikeouts, 45 short of the 1,000 strikeout mark.

AGAINST THE OTHER CENTRAL: Lynn has never faced his former team but this will mark his second start this season against the National League Central...his previous start came on April 2, 2018 at Pittsburgh where he suffered the loss after a five-run first inning, however did not allow another run to score in the start...as a former member of the NL Central, Lynn has a lot of experience in the division, going 38-21 in 89 career appearances...of those 89 appearances, Lynn has started 78 of them going 37-20 with a 3.67 ERA (441.0 IP, 180 ER)...against the central at home Lynn is 20-7 in 37 starts with a 3.17 ERA.

APRIL SHOWERS BRING MAY FLOWERS: Lynn had an uncharacteristic April, posting a 8.37 ERA, a .290 opponent average, and failing to record a win...previously Lynn's highest April ERA was 3.60 in 2014 and the highest opponent average against him was .267 in 2015...throughout his career in the month of May, he owns a 3.21 ERA and a .239 opponent batting average...he has a 13-7 record in this month and the second-lowest slugging percentage (.354) of any month...Lynn also has the most innings-pitched of any month in his career in May (187.2) and has allowed the second fewest home runs (13).

ALL OR NOTHING: In his six starts this season, Lynn is boasting an 9.44 SO/9, which is 18th best in the AL and second-best on the Twins among pitchers with at least five starts...on the other end of the charts, Lynn has a 6.55 BB/9 ratio, which is the second-highest in the AL behind Lucas Giolito among pitchers with five-or-more starts and highest of his career...his next highest BB/9 was in 2013 with a 4.03 ratio and his best walks-per-nine mark was in 2012 with 2.00 BB/9.

2017 RECAP:

- Lynn ranked tied for first in the NL in games started (33) sixth in AVG (.223), sixth in fewest H/9 (7.29), and seventh in ERA (3.43).
- Lynn had five starts of 7.0 or-more innings and 19 starts of 6.0 or-more innings, going 9-2 across those starts with 92 strikeouts.
- On May 5 against Los Angeles-NL, Lynn went 8.0 innings pitched while allowing just two hits, one run and 10 strikeouts.
- From April 17-May 5 Lynn had a season-high four-game win-streak posting a 0.72 ERA (25.0 IP, 2 ER) while striking out 23.

TOUGH TO HIT: In 2017 Lynn was among the top-10 pitchers in average against...batters hit .219, ranking him ninth in MLB and sixth in the NL...Lynn ranked 10th in the NL for lowest average against righties with a .203 mark...lefties had more success against Lynn with a .245 average against.

WALK-A-LOT: In 2017 Lynn ranked second in MLB and in the NL for most BB/9 (3.77) behind Arizona's Robbie Ray who had a 3.94 BB/9...his 3.77 mark was the highest of his career (2015 - 3.49, 2014 - 3.18, 2013 - 3.39, and 2012 - 3.27)...in his first season back from "Tommy John" surgery Lynn issued 78 walks in 186.1 innings...Lynn issued 44 walks on the road vs. 34 walks at home and of his 78 walks last season 53 came against left-handed batters...Lynn is among the league leaders in walks in 2018, yielding 25 free passes in five starts, which is second-most in baseball.

LUCKY LYNN: Last season Lynn was tied for first in the NL in opponents batting average on balls in play (.248), a mark he shared with Cy Young Award winner Max Scherzer (WAS) and Jeremy Hellickson (PHI-BAL)...he has only had two years where opponent's BABIP was below .300, and has a career opponent BABIP of .304, which ranks as the 11th highest in the NL since 2011.
