#### CLEVELAND NOTES:

- The **CLEVELAND INDIANS** maintain a 28-16 record at Progressive Field this season and are 56-24 at home since the 2017 All-Star Break, the best record in that span in MLB...Tribe is now 7-5 vs. the National League this season.
- MIKE CLEVINGER** took the loss, allowing a season high-tying five runs on seven hits (one home run) over 6.0+ innings...**fanned 11 batters, matching his career-best done on June 14, 2018 at Chicago-AL**...also marked his fourth career game with 10-or-more strikeouts, all of which have come this season (May 6 at NYY, June 14 at CWS & June 19 vs. CWS)...Indians starting pitchers have recorded 18 starts with 10-or-more strikeouts, 2<sup>nd</sup>-most in MLB (Houston - 19).
  - Clevinger struck out 11 batters, giving him 110 punchouts in the first half of the season...**with Clevinger, Trevor Bauer (156), Corey Kluber (123) and Carlos Carrasco (103), the Indians are now one of three teams (also Boston and Houston) to have four pitchers with 100-or-more strikeouts before the All-Star Break (STATS, LLC)**...became one of just five teams to achieve the feat, including the 2015 Indians (Kluber - 154, Carrasco - 122, Bauer - 102 & **Danny Salazar** - 116).
- YONDER ALONSO** got the Tribe on the board with a solo shot in the 4<sup>th</sup>...his 13 home runs in the first half are his 2<sup>nd</sup>-highest career total (20 in 2017), while his 48 first-half RBI are a career-best...Alonso has hit safely in six of his last seven home games, batting .346 (9-26) with a double, two home runs, eight RBI and six runs scored in that span.
- YAN GOMES** went 2-for-4 with a single in the 2<sup>nd</sup> inning and a double in the 9<sup>th</sup>...Gomes has 30 hits at home this season, which ranks T2nd-most among American League catchers entering play tonight.
- JASON KIPNIS** doubled in the 7<sup>th</sup> and homered in the 9<sup>th</sup>, extending his home on-base streak to 23 games...marks the 3<sup>rd</sup>-longest active home on-base streak in MLB, behind Boston's **J.D. Martinez** (33G) and Texas's **Shin-Soo Choo** (25G)...Kipnis is also hitting .387 (12-31) with two doubles, four home runs, nine RBI and eight runs scored in his last 10 home games.
- FRANCISCO LINDOR** went 1-for-4 with an 8<sup>th</sup>-inning double, his 51<sup>st</sup> extra-base hit of the season...his 51 extra-base hits through 89 team games are the most by an Indians hitter since **Jim Thome** had 54 at this point in the 1998 campaign.

#### CINCINNATI NOTES:

- The **CINCINNATI REDS** improved to 9-2 in Interleague play this season...the Reds' nine Interleague victories are tied with Washington for the 3<sup>rd</sup>-most by a National League club this season...Cincinnati is now 37-36 since **Jim Riggleman** became manager on April 19.
- ANTHONY DeSCLAFANI** notched his fifth win of the season, holding the Indians to one run on five hits (one home run), with two walks and three strikeouts over 7.0 innings...marked his first start of 7.0-or-more innings since September 2, 2016 vs. St. Louis...he improved to 2-2 with a 4.60 ERA (24ER/47.0IP) in eight career Interleague starts.
- TUCKER BARNHART** doubled in the Reds' first run in the 2<sup>nd</sup> and finished the game 2-for-4, recording his sixth multi-hit game of the season...entered tonight T4th among National League catchers in multi-hit games...Barnhart now has hit safely in four consecutive games vs. Cleveland, hitting .545 (6-11) with two doubles, two RBI and a run scored in those outings...his 2<sup>nd</sup>-inning double tonight marked just his third career hit (second career double) at Progressive Field.
- SCOTT SCHEBLER** went 4-for-5, tying his career high with four hits (second time, also June 8, 2018 vs. St. Louis)...marked his 19<sup>th</sup> multi-hit game of the year...Schebler has a hit in 16 of his last 18 road games, batting .355 (22-62) in that span.
- JOEY VOTTO** extended the Cincinnati lead with a 5<sup>th</sup>-inning solo shot...marked Votto's 14<sup>th</sup> career home run against the Indians, which is tied with **Aramis Ramirez** (14 vs. Chicago-AL) for the 4<sup>th</sup>-most by a hitter vs. a single Interleague opponent since the advent of Interleague play in 1997...Votto is a career .314 (54-172) hitter vs. the Tribe, with 15 doubles, 14 homers, 34 RBI and 31 runs scored.
  - The longball also marked Votto's 266<sup>th</sup> career home run, breaking a tie with **Matt Stairs** (265) for the 2<sup>nd</sup>-most in MLB history by a player born in Canada (**Larry Walker** - 383).
- EUGENIO SUÁREZ** singled in the 8<sup>th</sup> and extended his current hit streak to 12 games, one shy of his career-long run of 13 games set earlier this year from June 6-June 23...Suárez is batting at a .381 (16-42) clip during his current run, with three doubles, three home runs, 10 RBI and 10 runs scored...his current streak dates back to June 27.
- JESSE WINKER** went 2-for-3 with a double, an RBI and a run scored...now has 20 multi-hit games on the season and entered tonight T2nd among National League rookies in the category...his 37 RBI are the 3<sup>rd</sup>-most by any N.L. rookie hitter this season.
- BILLY HAMILTON** finished the night 2-for-4 with a pair of runs scored...has multiple hits in three of his last four games, batting .643 (9-for-14) in that span...he is also hitting .337 (28-83) over his last 26 games, with 12 stolen bases and 23 runs scored.
