### BLUE JAYS NOTES:

- Have won consecutive games for the first time since winning three straight from 4/29-5/1...Had gone 33G between consecutive wins, the 3<sup>rd</sup> longest such stretch in team history (2<sup>nd</sup> longest within a season - 49G in 1979)...Have won consecutive games at home for the first time since a 4G streak from 4/17-24...Are now 3-10 in their last 13 contests here and 14-19 at home this season...Are now 10-17 vs. AL East opponents (4-1 vs. BAL)...Have pitched 5 consecutive quality starts, their longest streak since doing so in 7 straight games from Sept. 21-28, 2016...Homered 3 times in a game for the first time since 5/16 at NYM (3HR)...Are now 6-2 when hitting 3+ HR...Had 13 hits in a game for the first time since 5/16 at NYM (15H).
- J.A. HAPP recorded his 100<sup>th</sup> career win**...Allowed one unearned run while recording 3 strikeouts and 2 walks...Allowed just 2 hits to match his season best (5/16 at NYM - also his other ER-free start in 2018) and tied a season high with 7.0 innings (5<sup>th</sup> time)...Threw 105 pitches and has 100+ pitches in 3 straight starts.
- RUSSELL MARTIN** got the Jays on the board in the 2<sup>nd</sup> inning with a solo homer, his 6<sup>th</sup> home run of the season...Was his 60<sup>th</sup> home run as a catcher for the Blue Jays, surpassing Darrin Fletcher (59) for 3<sup>rd</sup> most in team history (Whitt-127, Arencibia-63)...Hit it in a 3-0 count, his 2<sup>nd</sup> 3-0 HR of 2018 and the 4<sup>th</sup> of his career...Added another RBI with a 6<sup>th</sup>-inning single...Was his first multi-RBI effort since 5/10 vs. SEA (2RBI).
- RANDAL GRICHUK** hit his 4<sup>th</sup> home run, a solo shot in the 5<sup>th</sup> inning to put the Jays ahead, 2-1...Marked the 20<sup>th</sup> go-ahead HR of his career...Has 6 hits over his last 4 games, 5 of which have gone for extra bases (3-2B, 2-HR).
- KEVIN PILLAR** hit his 6<sup>th</sup> home run of the season, a solo shot in the 8<sup>th</sup> inning...All 6 HR have come at Rogers Centre and have been solo homers...Was his 7<sup>th</sup> career HR and 26<sup>th</sup> RBI against the Orioles, both personal highs vs. all opponents...Also singled for his 17<sup>th</sup> multi-hit game, tying Yangervis Solarte for the team lead.
- TEOSCAR HERNANDEZ** tripled in a run in 7<sup>th</sup> inning...Was his 5<sup>th</sup> triple of the season, matching the team's entire triple output from last year...The MLB lead in triples coming into tonight was 6...Finished 2-for-4 for his 14<sup>th</sup> multi-hit game...Has had 28 of his 49 hits go for extra bases (14-2B, 5-3B, 9-HR).
- ALEDMYS DIAZ** singled twice and doubled in a 3-for-4 night...The three-hit game matched a season best (4/3 vs. CWS)...Has back-to-back multi-hit games for the 2<sup>nd</sup> time as a Blue Jay, also doing so on 4/13 at CLE (2H) and 4/17 vs. KC (2H).

### ORIOLES NOTES:

- Fall to 9-25 on the road...Their .265 road win% is the lowest in the Majors...Are now 9-18 vs. AL East opponents for the lowest divisional win% within the AL East (.333)...Have been held to one-run or less in 18 occasions, surpassing Miami for the most such games this season.
- ANDREW CASHNER** allowed 3 runs over 6.0 innings...Gave up 9 hits and has allowed 9+ hits in each of his last 3 starts...Recorded 4 strikeouts for the 4<sup>th</sup> straight game...Surrendered 2 home runs after going 3 games without allowing any...Has now received 3-or-less runs of support in 12 of his 13 starts...Came into tonight with a 2.58 run support average, the lowest in the Majors.
- CRAIG GENTRY** went 3-for-3 with a double and had all of Baltimore's hits through the first 7.1 innings...The 3 hits matched a season high (4/8 at NYY)...The doubled was his first extra-base hit since 5/13 vs. TB (2B)...Stole a base and is now 9-for-11 in stolen-base attempts this season.
- ADAM JONES** had an 8<sup>th</sup>-inning single...Has hit .336 (40-for-119) over his last 29 games.
- DANNY VALENCIA** singled and walked...Over his last 25 games, has hit .341 (29-for-85) with 3-2B, 1-3B, 4-HR and 12-RBI.
