### CARDINALS NOTES

- **Carlos Martínez** made his 11th start of the season, first against the Cubs in 2018 (0-0) and 15th career start vs. the Cubs (4-4)...still needs one win for 50 in his career...has issued 18 walks in his last three starts...allowed his 2nd home run on the season and first since April 10 vs. MIL (**Eric Thames**)...last HR allowed to a RH batter was **Phil Ervin** (CIN, 9/21/2017)...induced his 11th double play of the season...is the first Cardinals pitcher to walk five or more batters in three straight games since **Jason Marquis** (5/19-30/2005).
- **Carlos Martínez** recorded his 15th career hit with runners in scoring position (15-66, .227)...was his 9th career two-out RBI (21 career RBI).
- **Marcell Ozuna** extended his hitting streak to nine games (13-34, .382) and has hit safely in 13-of-14 games (21-52, .04) in June...has an RBI in seven straight games extending the 2018 club high and established a new career-high...the 7-game RBI streak is the longest streak by a Cardinal since **Matt Holliday** (8/21/27/2013)...homered in three consecutive games joining **Tyler O'Neill** and **José Martínez** for the longest HR streak by a Cardinal this season...400th career RBI.
- **Tommy Pham** extended his hitting streak to 10 games, tying his career-high (1242, .286)...is two games shy of the Cardinals season-high by **Marcell Ozuna** (12).
- **Dexter Fowler** snapped an 0-for-16 with a single in the 4th inning (last hit 6/7 vs. MIA)...has reached base safely in 20-of-25 games vs. CHI since start of 2017...scored his first run since May 31.
- **Yadier Molina** batted No. 3 for the first time this season (last: 5/31/17 vs. LAD)...drew a season-high two walks (last multi-walk game: 9/21/17 at CIN)...has eight walks this season with three in the last two games.
- **Yairo Muñoz** tallied three hits, his 2nd three-hit game (4 hits vs. KC on 5/22)...was his 6th multi-hit game of the season.
- **Jordan Hicks** surrendered his first career home run (**Jason Heyward**, 8th inning).
- **Kolten Wong** has hit safely in 7 of his last 11 home games...is batting .400 (6-15) vs. the Cubs this season with hits in his last 4 games vs. CHI.
- *The Cardinals challenged the Kris Bryant dropped fly ball in the 9th inning. Call stands (Time: 1:07).*
- The **Cardinals** committed two errors for the 14th game this season and second straight game...have lost a season-high four straight games...is the first time this season to drop four straight home games (last: 6/13-24/2017...in 4 games of the same series 5/16-20/2017)...are the 6th National League team to have 3 or more players with double-digit home runs this season (**Tommy Pham**, **Marcell Ozuna**, **Jose Martinez**) joining the Reds (3), Cubs (3), Diamondbacks (3), Dodgers (4) and Rockies (4)

### CUBS NOTES

- **Kyle Hendricks** made his 14th start of the season, first against the Cardinals in 2018 (1-0) and 11th career start vs. the Cardinals (3-2)...had lost his three consecutive starts for the first time in his career receiving a total of three runs of support entering tonight...earned his first win on the road since 4/20 at COL in a 16-5 Cubs win over the Rockies.

- **Kris Bryant** has reached base safely in each of his last 15 games vs. the Cardinals...walked twice in a game for the 5th time this season and first since May 19 at CIN.
- **Addison Russell** hit his first home run against a RHP this season and most recent since 9/27/2017 off **Michael Wacha**.
- **Willson Contreras** ranced out his first bunt single of the season (Cubs 6th as a team)...had two infield hits bringing his total to seven...established a new single-season high two sacrifice bunts.
- **Kyle Schwarber** has 16 career RBI vs. STL, his 2nd highest total against any team (CIN, 23)...has 29 of his 32 RBI this season vs. RHP.
- **Ian Happ** has an extra base hits in consecutive games for the first time since both games of the doubleheader at CIN (5/19)...tallied his 6th go-ahead and 4th game-winning RBI of the season...6 of his 18 extra base hits have come with two strikes this season...was 1-for-40 (33 K's) with no RBI in a "1-2 count situation" this season before his RBI double in the 7th inning.
- **Jason Heyward** hit his 4th home run of the season, with all four including runners on base (last solo HR was 9/2/2017 vs. ATL)...has hit safely in 5-of-6 games vs. STL this season (7-27, .259) with 2 home runs.
- **Randy Rosario** made his first appearance of only one out this season.
- **Steve Cishek** has not allowed a run in five appearances (5.1 IP) vs. STL this season and in his last eight app. vs. STL (7.2 IP).
- Brandon Morrow has locked down 16-of-17 save opportunities this season...has allowed hits to the Cardinals in his last three relief appearances.
- The **Cubs** scored in each of their last five innings in which their lead-off batter reached base...are the 3rd team in the National League and 7th team in MLB to reach 40 wins...tied their season-high at 13 games over .500 for the season...have won a series against the Cardinals this season, lost one (May sweep) and split (April)...have scored 19 runs in two games this series after scoring a total of 11 runs in their last series in St. Louis (5/4-6).
