FISH BITES

The Marlins continue a seven-game road trip with game three of this four-game series against the Philadelphia Phillies tonight at 7:05 p.m. RHP **José Ureña**, making his team-leading 22nd start of the season, is facing the Phillies for the 12th time in his career (eighth start), having gone 1-3 with a 5.22 ERA (39.2 ip/23 er); is 0-1 with a 4.91 ERA in two starts this season. Philadelphia is countering with RHP Zach Eflin, who in two career starts against the Marlins is 0-1 with a 6.55 ERA (11.0/8); in one start this season allowed one run on three hits over 6.0 innings on May 1 at Marlins Park. The Marlins concluded a 3-3 homestand Sunday, splitting a two-game series with the Braves and a four-game set against the Nationals. The current road swing began with Miami dropping two games to the Atlanta Braves, with the final game being postponed due to weather. Tonight's game continues a stretch of 12 straight games (3-7) against NL East opponents. Miami plays 34 of their remaining 50 games (71%) against division foes. Following this series, the Marlins will return to Miami for a six-game homestand against St. Louis (Monday-Wednesday) and the Mets (Friday-Sunday).

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP

Miami's offense was slow to get started, recording just one hit over the first six innings of last night's 5-1 loss to the Phillies. **Brian Anderson** was the first Marlin to reach base, drawing a walk in the fourth, and **Miguel Rojas** tallied the first hit with a single to left in the fifth. Down 2-0 heading into the eighth, **Magneuris Sierra** reached on an infield single with one out. Two batters later, and with two down, **Starlin Castro** singled to left to put runners at first and second for Anderson, who drove home Sierra with a single to center. Anderson finished 2x3 with a walk to give him 36 multi-hit games this season, tied with Freddie Freeman and Scooter Gennett for fourth in the NL. Despite allowing just one run on four hits and two walks, **Trevor Richards** was handed his sixth loss of the season. He also recorded seven strikeouts, including the first three of the game.

SETTLING EAST

José Ureña has gained familiarity with National League East venues over the last two seasons. In seven appearances (six starts) in NL East ballparks since the start of 2017, he has posted a 4-2 record with a 3.35 ERA and four quality starts. Prior to 2017, he owned a 2-2 record and 8.58 ERA (28.1/27) with one quality start in 13 appearances (four starts) at NL East ballparks.

GIVE ME A SECOND

Starlin Castro has recorded 123 hits in 108 games played this season, all at second base. He leads all Major League second basemen in games played, ranks second in hits (Jose Altuve-128), tied for third in doubles (23), and tied for fourth in runs scored (62).

HIT TO THE NINES

With seven more hits this season, **Starlin Castro** will reach the 130 hit mark for the ninth time in his Major League career. He would join a list of five others who debuted in the last 20 years to record 130+ hits in each of his first nine Major League seasons. See list at right provided by *Stats LLC*.

RUN ALONG, ROOKIE

Adding to what has already been a breakout season, **Brian Anderson** is continuing to be one of the main contributors to Miami's offense. He has accounted for 14.9% of the Marlins run total, which is the fifth-highest percentage by a rookie in the last 50 years. Mike Trout accounted for 16.8% of the Angels team run total in 2012, while Hanley Ramirez owned 15.7% of the Marlins total in 2006. Ron Gant had 15.3% of Atlanta's runs in 1988, and Ryne Sandberg accounted for 15.2% of the Cubs total in 1982. - *Stats LLC*

HISTORY REPEATS ITSELF

Miami began the season with just a .225 team average over its first 28 road games, which ranked 27th in the Majors. Over their last 26 road games since June 1, the Marlins have hit at a .266 clip to rank third in the Majors behind Oakland (.273) and Atlanta (.269). Since 2014, Miami leads the Majors in road average with a .261 mark, ahead of Houston (.259) and Kansas City (.256).

MAKING ADJUSTMENTS

When facing a pitcher for the third time in a game, the Marlins have hit .307, which leads the National League and ranks second in the Majors to only Boston (.326). The .307 average when facing a pitcher for the third time would equal the best such mark in club history (also 2001). - *Stats LLC*

ROAD WELL TRAVELED

The Marlins have two of the best road hitters in the National League in **Derek Dietrich** and **J.T. Realmuto**, as Dietrich ranks 10th in the NL with a .319 average and Realmuto 14th at .308. Dietrich has hit in 12 of his last 15 road contests, batting .407 (22x54) with five doubles, five home runs, and nine RBI in that span. He has scored 35 runs in visiting ballparks this season, tied for 10th in the NL, while his .393 OBP ranks 11th and .538 SLG ranks 12th. Realmuto has hit in 14 of his last 17 road games with an average of .319 (23x72), seven doubles, three home runs, and 14 RBI. The All-Star catcher ranks ninth in the NL on the road this season with a SLG of .555, T-14th in runs with 34, and 24th with an OBP of .367.

PROVING HIS WORTH

In his final game before the break, **Brian Anderson** recorded his sixth three-hit game of the season to run his season hit total to 109. His hit total prior to the break tied Rocco Baldelli for the second-most by a Major League rookie since 2003, behind only Hideki Matsui (114 in 2003). He is the only Marlins rookie in franchise history to record 100+ hits prior to the break.

- Anderson recorded 101 hits over his first 92 games of the season, becoming the 142nd rookie since 1958 to record 100+ hits in 92-or-fewer games. Of those, 34 went on to win Rookie of the Year honors, including most recently Aaron Judge (2017), Corey Seager (2016), Carlos Correa (2015), José Abreu (2014), Mike Trout (2012) and Buster Posey (2010). - *Stats LLC*
- He leads all MLB rookies in games (110), at-bats (426), hits (122), multi-hit games (36), three+-hit games (7, tied), average with RISP (.404), runs (63), on-base percentage (.367), and RBI (52); ranks second in doubles (25), walks (44), and slugging (.423); ranks third in average (.286); is tied for third in triples (3); and tied for 10th in HR (9).
- He is on pace for 177 hits this season, which would rank as the second-most by a National League rookie since 2010, behind Corey Seager's 193 in 2016, and would tie Troy Tulowitzki for the fifth-most by an NL rookie since 2000. He is also on pace to score 92 runs, which would rank as the ninth-most by a rookie since 2000.

THIS DAY IN MARLINS HISTORY

AUGUST 4

Dan Uggla reached base five times, including four walks, and Josh Johnson homered in the fourth, but it was not enough to overcome the Nationals in a 6-4 loss in Washington in **2009**. Johnson tossed 7.0 scoreless innings before allowing four runs in the eighth. The four walks in the game by Uggla tied for the second-most in Club history (17th time...has been done three times since), behind a five-walk game for Ivan Rodriguez on April 8, 2003.

YOUNG GUNS

Of the Marlins' 46 wins this season, 23 have been recorded by rookie pitchers (50.0 pct.). Overall, have 10 different rookies own a win. The 10 different rookies to record a win are tied with three teams for fifth-most in a single season in MLB history. The 2017 Reds, '07 Yankees, '03 Tigers and '02 Padres each had 11. - *Stats LLC*

José Ureña will make his team-leading 22nd start of the season in game three of this four-game set against the Philadelphia Phillies.

Over his career, has gone 1-3 with a 5.22 ERA (39.2 ip/23 er) in 11 appearances (seven starts) against the Phillies. Has made two starts against the Phils this season, both at Marlins Park, having allowed seven runs (six earned) over 11.0 innings for a 4.91 ERA. In five career appearances (three starts) at Citizens Bank Park, owns a 1-1 record and 7.36 ERA.

Suffering from the lowest run support average of any starter in the National League (min. 15 GS), and second lowest in the Majors, at 2.96. Michael Fulmer has the lowest at 2.81. Only four starts this season has he left the game with more run support than runs allowed, and he has allowed three-or-fewer runs 12 times.

Tonight's start will mark his first on the road since June 20, a span of five starts. In seven road starts has gone 2-2 with a 4.61 ERA (41.0/21). Went on DL following last road start with right shoulder impingement.

Snapped streak of 14 consecutive home starts without a win in last start, July 29 vs. Washington. Allowed just one hit and four walks, with five strikeouts, over 6.0 scoreless innings.

The stretch of 14 home starts without a win was the longest such streak in Franchise history. Anibal Sánchez previously owned the longest stretch when he made 13 straight home starts without a win from June 1, 2011 to May 24, 2012. The win also snapped an eight-game home losing streak, which was also the longest such streak in Club history. Jack Armstrong (7/22-10/3/93), Livan Hernández (7/9/98-4/6/99), Vladimir Núñez (8/5/99-4/22/01), and Dontrelle Willis (5/9-8/3/07) all had seven-game home slides. - Stats LLC

Was placed on 10-day DL on June 21 with right shoulder impingement, following his start at San Francisco the previous day (L, 5.2 ip, 8 h, 5 r, 5 er, 2 bb, 1bb, 5 so).

In his start prior to that outing in SF, he fired off 8.0 shutout innings on June 15 at Baltimore to pick up his second win of the season (3 h, bb, 4 so, hb). It was his fourth career game tossing at least 8.0 innings, and fell 0.2 inning shy of his career-long outing. Also threw a career-high 112 pitches.

Picked up his first win of the season on June 5 at St. Louis. It snapped a skid of 14 consecutive team losses in his starts, dating back to September 26, 2017, the longest streak in Club history. Picked up the win despite allowing a season-high 10 hits, and surrendering four runs.

Left in line for win on April 21 vs. Milwaukee, but ended up with no decision after Brewers scored two late runs. Allowed four runs on four hits and two walks, while striking out three, over 5.0 innings.

On April 3, held Boston to one run on four hits over 7.0 innings. Walked one while striking out a career high-tying seven. It was third career seven-strikeout game; added a fourth in his start on May 25 vs. Washington.

Earned Opening Day start against Cubs on March 29 at Marlins Park. Was seventh different OD starter in last seven openers for Miami. Took loss, allowing five runs on six hits over 4.0 innings. Hit three batters in first inning, becoming only second Marlins pitcher to ever tally three HBP in a single inning (Sergio Mitre on Aug. 31, 2007 vs. PHI).
