TODAY'S GAME: The Giants and Brewers play the final game of this four-game series...Milwaukee has outscored San Francisco 17-7 in the first three games...the Brewers lead the Giants by 8.5 games in the NL Wild Card standings.

THE GIANTS: Enter today's game having lost four-straight, six of their last seven and eight of their last 10 games...the Giants are a season-high 7.5 games behind the first-place Dodgers in the NL West standings.

IN NEED OF A WIN: The Giants need a win today to avoid being swept by the Brewers in a four-game series for just the second time in team history...the Brewers' only four-game sweep of the Giants took place from Sept. 21-24, 2006 at Miller Park...the Brewers haven't recorded a sweep of the Giants in San Francisco since a three-game brooming July 18-20, 2008.

AT THE HELM: Bench coach **Hensley Meulens** will serve as the Giants' manager for today's game as **Bruce Bochy** traveled to Cooperstown last night to support Trevor Hoffman at today's Baseball Hall of Fame induction ceremony...Bochy managed Hoffman in San Diego for 12 seasons.

MANAGERIAL WINS: Giants manager **Bruce Bochy** (1,905 wins) needs one more managerial victory to move past Hall of Famer Casey Stengel (1,905) for sole possession of 11th-place on the all-time wins list...if the Giants win today, Bochy would still get credited with a victory.

ON DECK: Following today's game the Giants will travel to San Diego where they'll begin a six-game, two-city road trip against the Padres (two games) and Diamondbacks (four games)...the Giants are 25-24 against NL West opponents this year...they are 6-5 against San Diego and 7-5 against Arizona.

PANIK AT SAC: IF Joe Panik, who's missed the last 16 games with a groin strain, started a rehab assignment Thursday with triple-A Sacramento and in three games has gone 3-for-10 with a run scored and walk while playing 21.0 innings.

WITH RISP: The Giants are hitting .251 overall this season with runners in scoring position (10th in NL), however are batting .299 in these situations this month, the fifth-highest clip in the Majors...SF is just 4-for-21 (.190) with RISP in the first three games of this series.

TODAY'S STARTER: **LHP Andrew Suárez** seeks his first win since June 29...the rookie left-hander has allowed two runs or fewer in six of his last eight outings, posting a 2.89 ERA in that span...his 3.99 ERA overall is the seventh-lowest among NL rookies while his 83 strikeouts are the fourth-most.

ON THE MOUND: Giants pitchers have the lowest ERA in MLB beginning June 1, fashioning a 3.29 figure...the Yankees are second with a 3.30 ERA followed by the Dodgers (3.35), Red Sox (3.50) and Astros (3.61).

TOUGH LOSSES: Of the Giants' last nine losses, they've been leading or tied at the end of the 6th inning or later in seven of them: July 10 vs. Cubs (tied at end of 6th), July 14 vs. A's (led at end of 6th), July 15 vs. A's (led at end of 3rd), July 21 at A's (tied at end of 10th), July 22 at A's (tied at end of 9th), July 25 at Mariners (tied at end of 7th) and July 26 vs. Brewers (tied at end of 7th), July 27 vs. Milwaukee (tied at end of 6th) (Baseball Info Solutions).

6-0, 187, 25 years old (September 11, 1992)
3-6 Record, 3.99 ERA

- The 25-year-old left-hander is slated to make his 18th career Major League start...has gone 3-6 with a 3.99 ERA (42er, 94.2ip) in 17 outings, with the Giants going 7-10 in those games.
- Among NL rookie leaders he ranks second in innings pitched (94.2), fourth in strikeouts (83) and seventh in ERA (3.99).
- Received a no decision in the Giants' 4-3 win at Seattle on Tuesday...allowed three runs on eight hits with two walks and a career-low one strikeout over 5.2 innings.
- Has posted a 2.89 ERA (15er, 46.2ip) over his last eight starts.
- Has struck out 83 batters while issuing just 23 walks in his first 17 career Major League starts.
- Opponents have 24 hits in 72 at-bats (.333) off him with runners in scoring position...is holding opponents to a .111 average (3-for-27) with RISP and two outs.
- With one out in an inning opponents are hitting .317 off him with an OBP of .351 and a SLUG pct. of .661... however, with two outs in an inning opponents are hitting .198/.267/.283 (Baseball Info Solutions).
- Has received three or fewer runs of support in 12 of his 17 starts.
- Has a 3.35 ERA (18er, 48.1ip) in eight starts at home.
- Lefties are hitting .193 (17-for-88) off him and are just 8-for-their-last-47 (.170).
- Has never faced the Brewers...is 0-2 with a 5.63 ERA (11er, 16.0ip) in three starts against the NL Central.
- Was selected in the second round of the 2015 MLB Draft by San Francisco (No. 61 overall).

NOTES: The 31-year-old left-hander is slated to make his 20th start (23rd appearance) this season...has posted a 5-8 record with a 3.92 ERA (47er, 108.0ip) over his 23 outings...started the season in the Giants rotation, but was moved to the bullpen following his start on July 1 at Arizona to make room in the rotation for **Johnny Cueto**, who was being activated from the DL...has moved back and forth between the bullpen and the starting rotation since then...has posted a 2.43 ERA (8er, 29.2ip) over his last eight games (four starts, four relief appearances)...has made three career starts against San Diego, going 1-1 with a 7.04 ERA (12er, 15.1ip)...has posted a 5.59 ERA (6er, 9.2ip) in two starts against the Padres this season.
