### TWINS NOTES:

- **THE TWINS** dropped the third of this four-game series to the White Sox and the second in a row after splitting the double-header yesterday...drop to 26-32 on the season and 12-8 in the division...fall to 5-9 as a team against left-handed starting pitchers and 4-2 in June...the Twins are back to .500 at Target Field with a record of 15-15...with Rosario's outfield assist, the Twins have recorded five outfield assists in their last 13 games after beginning the season with three in their first 45 games.
- **JAKE ODORIZZI** suffered the loss and dropped to 3-3 on the season...lasted 5.0 innings and allowed three runs on six hits...two of the runs credited to Odorizzi were allowed to score when Ryan Pressly gave up a single after relieving Odorizzi in the top of the sixth inning...walked one batter which ties his season-best, done three times previously and last on May 26 at Seattle...his seven strikeouts marked the fifth time this season he has struck out seven or more...did not allow the leadoff man to reach base until the sixth inning when Yolmer Sanchez recorded a single.
- **EDUARDO ESCOBAR** (1-for-2) doubled in the first inning, his 24<sup>th</sup> double of the season, leading MLB...entered the game tied-fifth in baseball in extra base hits with 34...this marks the fourth consecutive game he has recorded at least one double, tying his career-high done on June 17-21, 2017...entering the game his four doubles was tied for most in baseball with Paul Goldschmidt of Arizona.
- **ROBBIE GROSSMAN** (1-for-4) singled in the second inning and has safely hit in six of seven games this homestand...hitting .304 (7-for-23)...since the beginning of 2017 has reached base in 11 of 14 games vs. the White Sox.
- **EHIRE ADRIANZA** (2-for-3) recorded two doubles, for the second time this season (other, May 22 vs. Detroit)...has reached safely in five of six last starts...hitting .318 (7-for-22).
- **BRIAN DOZIER** (1-for-4) singled in the bottom of the ninth to extend his hitting streak to five games, hitting .400 (6-for-15) during the streak.

### WHITE SOX NOTES:

- **THE WHITE SOX** win the third of four against the Twins and improve to 20-39 on the season...are 10-20 on the road and 15-30 vs. right-handed starters...Trayce Thompson and Tim Anderson both stole a base in tonight's game, the White Sox lead the majors with 53 stolen bases.
- **HECTOR SANTIAGO** recorded the win to improve to 2-2 on the season...lasted 5.0 innings and allowed two runs...went for 5.0-or-more innings for just the fourth time this season in seven starts...did not allow a home run for just the second time as a starter this season...his two strikeouts mark the fourth time this season he has struck out two-or-fewer as a starter.
- **KEVAN SMITH** (2-for-4) since being called up on June 5 from Triple-A Charlotte, has recorded a hit in both games...extended his hitting streak against Minnesota to six games, hitting .364 (8-for-22) during the streak...recorded his first multi-hit game of the season and 20<sup>th</sup> of his career

- **JOSE ABREU** (1-for-4) recorded a single in the sixth inning to extend his current hitting streak to six games, hitting .320 (8-for-25) during the streak.
- **YOLMER SANCHEZ** (1-for-5) recorded a single to lead off the sixth inning, extending his hitting streak to 10 games...hitting .317 (13-for-41) in that span...also extended his hitting streak against the Twins to nine games, hitting .368 (14-for-38).
- **TIM ANDERSON** (2-for-4) recorded his 13<sup>th</sup> stolen base of the season in the sixth inning, leads the team and entering the game ranked tied-fifth with Jean Segura for most stolen bases in baseball, Dee Gordon leads MLB with 19...recorded his 13<sup>th</sup> multi-hit game of the season.
- **MATT DAVIDSON** (1-for-3) recorded his seventh double of the season and first since May 18 vs. Texas.
- **YOAN MONCADO** (0-for-5) struck out four times, the second time he has recorded four strikeouts in a game this season and fifth time in his career...he leads the team in strikeouts with 79.
