TODAY'S GAME: San Francisco's 10-game road trip continues tonight with the first of four games against the Miami Marlins...the Giants are coming off a 2-1 series win at Washington in which they defeated RHPs Stephen Strasburg and Max Scherzer...SF's 2-0 win yesterday marked their seventh shutout of the season.

WINNING WAYS: The Giants have won eight of their last 10 games and enter tonight tied with the Dodgers for second place in the NL West, just 2.5 games behind the first-place Diamondbacks.

ON THE MOUND: LHP Madison Bumgarner, who missed the first two-plus months of the season because of a broken pinkie finger on his pitching hand, will make his second start of the season tonight...Bumgarner is 2-1 with a 4.70 ERA in four career starts here at Marlins Park.

INSIDE THE SERIES: The Giants went 1-5 against Miami last season and have lost 12 of their last 19 to the Fish since 2015...SF is 9-10 all-time here at Marlins Park, losing seven of the last 10 games.

HOT SINCE MAY: Beginning May 1, **IF Brandon Crawford** has hit safely in all but five of his last 36 games, batting a MLB-best .439 (58-for-132) with 16 doubles, five homers and 27 RBI...he's raised his batting average by 149 points from .189 to his current .338 mark, which ranks as the fourth-best in the National League.

SELECT COMPANY: Crawford is one of only five Giants since 1920 to have a 36-game span of hitting .439 or higher...should Crawford raise his average, he would become the sixth Giant hitter since 1920 to hit at least .440 over a 37-game span, joining **Barry Bonds** (2002 & 1993), **Willie Mays** (1958), **Freddie Lindstrom** (1930), **Bill Terry** (1930), and **Ross Youngs** (1920) (*Stats, LLC*).

IN THE BULLPEN: Giants relievers are sporting a 1.13 ERA (5er, 40.0ip) during an 8-2 run...during this stretch **RHP Sam Dyson**, **RHP Hunter Strickland**, **LHP Tony Watson** and **LHP Will Smith** have combined for zero earned runs in 20.0 innings while allowing eight hits and recording 24 strikeouts.

KEEP VOTING: MLB announced the first ballot update for the 2018 MLB All-Star Game and four Giants are among the leading vote-getters...**C Buster Posey** leads all NL catchers with 281,331 votes and **IF Brandon Crawford** paces all NL shortstops with 466,021 votes...**IF Brandon Belt** is third among first basemen with 162,750 votes and **IF Joe Panik** ranks fifth among second basemen with 62,325 votes.

SCORE AT LEAST FOUR: The Giants are 29-7 (.806) this season when they score four-or-more runs in a game...SF is 22-4 (.846) when scoring at least five runs.

ON THE MOUND: Giants starting pitchers have totaled just 22 quality starts this season, tied for the fifth-fewest in the Majors...SF is 14-8 (.636) when receiving a quality start and 19-24 (.442) when they don't get a quality outing.

This Date in Giants History: June 11, 1989

The Giants defeated the Padres, 3-1 in 12.0 innings at Candlestick Park...**Will Clark** broke a 1-1 tie in the 12th with a two-run homer off Mark Davis to give the Giants a walkoff win...starting pitcher **Rick Reuschel** logged 9.0 innings with seven strikeouts while throwing 136 pitches but didn't factor into the decision.

• Returned from his rehab assignment and was reinstated from the 60-day DL last Tuesday, June 5...made just two rehab starts - one with triple-A Sacramento (3.2ip, 1bb, 8so, 47 pitches) and one with Class A Advanced San Jose (4.2ip, 2h, 1r, 1er, 7so). before returning to the big leagues.

• Missed the Giants' first 60 games with a broken pinkie finger on his left hand, an injury he suffered on his final start in spring training at Scottsdale, Arizona on March 23 after Royals' hitter Whit Merrifield hit a line-drive comebacker off of his left hand.

• The outing was supposed to be the final tuneup for Bumgarner before he started on Opening Day.

• Had three pins inserted into the broken pinkie March 24 and had them removed April 19.

• Made his 2018 debut last Tuesday versus Arizona was logged 6.0 innings, allowing a pair of runs on eight hits with three strikeouts on 82 pitches.

• According to Baseball Info Solutions, Bumgarner threw 20% changeups in his last start, the second-highest rate he's thrown it in his career (he had another 20% start on Aug. 31, 2010 against the Rockies)...Bumgarner got eight outs with his changeup (no hits, walks, HBP, the most he's ever gotten with it in a regular-season start.

• Faces Marlins for the eighth time in his career...is 2-3 with a 4.73 ERA (three quality starts) in seven starts.

• Had never been on the disabled list in his first eight Major League seasons but has now twice been placed on the DL the last two years, missing a total of 135 games.

• SF is 59-76 (.437) with Bumgarner on the DL.

• Went 4-9 with a 3.32 ERA in 17 starts last season, with the Giants going 4-13 in those games.

• Missed three months (mid-April, May, June, mid-July) - 85 days, 75 games) with a left shoulder AC sprain... sustained the injury during a dirt bike accident on the team's off day in Denver, CO on April 20.

• Has 32 double-digit K games, the second-most in Giants franchise history behind **Tim Lincecum** (36).

• Is 15 strikeouts shy of 1,500 for his career...ranks ninth on the Giants' all-time strikeouts list.

HITTING NOTES: Batted .206 with three homers and five RBI last season... has hit 17 homers in his nine-year career, the most of any active player and the most in Giants franchise history...is the first pitcher to total at least three homers in four consecutive seasons since Earl Wilson achieved the feat in five-straight seasons between 1964 and 1968.

TOMORROW'S STARTER: RHP CHRIS STRATTON

2018: 7-3, 4.63 ERA / Career: 12-7, 4.15 ERA

NOTES: The 27-year-old right-hander is making his 14th start of the season... the Giants are 10-3 in his outings this year, going 6-1 at home and 4-2 on the road...San Francisco has won each of his last five trips to the hill...his seven wins are tied for the third-most in the NL behind Washington's Max Scherzer (10)... has won his last four decisions, going 4-0 with a 4.68 ERA (13er, 25.0ip) in his last five outings...this is the longest winning streak of his career...last pitched Wednesday versus Arizona and did not factor into the decision after allowing three runs on seven hits in just 4.0 innings...marked his seventh start of the season with 5.0-or-fewer innings pitched...the Giants won 5-4 in 10.0 innings on Brandon Crawford's game-ending run-scoring single.
