**THE TWINS:** After completing their six-game homestand with a record of 4-2 (1-2 vs. Cleveland and 3-0 vs. Kansas City), the Twins began their seven-game roadtrip with a loss to the Indians last night...tonight they will play the second of four at Progressive Field...following this series, they will travel to Detroit for three vs. the Tigers over the weekend...the Twins are 17-11 in 28 games since July 5.

**TWINS SUFFER BAUER OUTAGE:** The Twins lost to the Indians and Trevor Bauer last night at Progressive Field by a score of 10-0, their sixth time being shutout this season and third time in their last eight games...Kyle Gibson was the starter and loser, allowing a season-high six runs allowed (4 earned) on seven hits and three walks...the offense recorded just three hits and struck out 13 times...the last time the Twins lost by 10-plus in a shutout was August 20, 2016 at KC (10-0)...a 10+ to zero loss has happened 35 times in club history (since 1961).

**TWINS AND TRIBE:** The Twins are playing the Indians for the 14th of 19 scheduled meetings this season and for the fifth time of 10 scheduled games at Progressive Field...they have gone 7-6 vs. the Tribe, 4-3 at Target Field, 1-1 in Puerto Rico and 2-2 at Cleveland...seven wins are tied with Chicago-AL for most vs. any opponent this season.

☞ The Twins are 13-9 in their last 22 at Progressive Field and 8-5 in their last 13.  
☞ Eddie Rosario is hitting .330 (76-for-230) with 10 doubles, three triples, 15 home runs, 34 RBI and 39 runs scored in 61 career games vs. Cleveland; the homers, hits and RBI all being his personal most vs. any opponent...his 76 hits vs. CLE since 2015 lead baseball...in 29 career games at Progressive Field, he is hitting .363 (41-for-113); in his last seven games here, he has four hits twice and three hits once.  
☞ Miguel Sanó has reached safely in each of his last 11 vs. the Indians.

**MAUER, THAT'S PROGRESSIVE:** Joe Mauer is hitting .317 (116-for-366) with 34 doubles, 48 walks and a .395 on-base percentage in 94 career games at Progressive...he's hitting .372 (29-for-78) in his last 19 here...Mauer is hitting .319 (232-for-727) with 51 doubles, 14 home runs, 78 RBI, 101 walks, 110 runs scored and .401 on-base percentage in 191 career games vs. the Indians...232 hits are his second most vs. any opponent (247 vs. KC)...among actives vs. Cleveland, he ranks first in doubles and walks and second in hits...below are all-time ranks at Progressive Field for opponents:

**HOME SICK:** The Twins have gone 19-35 on the road this season...only Detroit (18-39) and Baltimore (14-43) have less road wins in baseball this season...they are 5-10-2 in series play away from Minnesota...they have lost four straight on the road and are 4-13 since the start of their series at Wrigley Field (June 29).

**CAVE, MAN:** Since July 1, Jake Cave is hitting .306 (26-for-85) with seven doubles, two triples, two home runs, 15 RBI and 16 runs scored...since that date, he leads all current Twins in RBI and tied with Robbie Grossman for first in doubles...additionally, he has hit in eight of his last nine games.

**SANÓ STORMING:** Miguel Sanó is hitting .364 (8-for-22) with three doubles, three RBI, five walks and a .481 on-base percentage in his last seven games...since being recalled on July 28, he is hitting .276 (8-for-29) with five walks and a .382 on-base percentage, compared to .203 (30-for-148) with a .270 on-base percentage prior to being optioned to the minor leagues on June 14.

**KIRILLOFF GOING OFF:** Minor League Baseball yesterday announced the Player of the Month Award winners for each of the 16 leagues for the month of July...Single-A Ft. Myers outfielder Alex Kirilloff led the Florida State League in average (.396), hits (40), total bases (62), extra-base hits (16), slugging (.614) and OPS (1.036)...he finished second in runs (20) and third in RBI (20)...Kirilloff had 13 multi-hit games in July, including six straight, and had a 13-game hitting streak from July 13-29...he also won the Midwest League Player of the Month Award in May with Cedar Rapids...Kirilloff, 20, was selected by the Twins in the first round (15th overall) of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of Plum High School in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania.

**RBI WORLD SERIES:** 24 baseball and softball teams, including baseball squads from Uganda and Curaçao, have advanced to the 26th edition of the Reviving Baseball in Inner Cities (RBI) World Series, which will once again be hosted by the Twins in Minneapolis & St. Paul...the Twins hosted the RBI World Series from 2011-2013...the tournament began yesterday and runs through Thursday, August 16.

**REMEMBERING DON BAYLOR:** Former Twin Don Baylor passed away on this day in 2017 at age 68 after his battle with cancer...the Twins acquired Baylor on August 31, 1987 in exchange for pitcher Enrique Rios...Baylor played 20 games for the Twins during the '87 regular season, hitting .286 (14-for-49) with six RBI...he hit .389 (7-for-18) in seven postseason games in '87, including a two-run homer and three RBI in Game 6 of the World Series vs. St. Louis.

LAST START: Mejía did not factor into the decision in his last start on August 1 vs. Cleveland opposite Carlos Carrasco, did not allow a run on one hit with three walks through 5.0 innings with two strikeouts...third career scoreless start and his first since June 28, 2017 vs. Boston when he went 5.2 scoreless...left the game with the score tied 0-0...tied his season high for walks.

IN THE MINORS: In 14 games (11 starts) with Triple-A Rochester this year, Mejía is 5-23 with a 3.32 ERA (62.1 IP, 23 ER) with 20 walks and 61 strikeouts...spent nearly a month on the DL from April 26-May 22 with a blister on his left middle finger...before his loss on July 17, had won four starts out of five with one no decision, going 4-0, 0.84 ERA (32.0 IP, 3 ER) with nine walks and 21 strikeouts over that stretch.

AGAINST THE INDIANS: Mejía is making his fourth career start against Cleveland, is 1-2, 1.96 ERA (18.1 IP, 4 ER) with 14 walks and 12 strikeouts...making consecutive starts against Cleveland as his last start against the Tribe was August 1...last loss against the Indians was September 27, 2017, suffered the loss after allowing two runs on five hits and three walks with three strikeouts over 3.2 innings...his only career win was June 23, 2017, shut out the Indians on two hits and five walks with four strikeouts over 5.0 innings.

2017 RECAP:

- Started 2017 with the Twins, going 0-1, 5.79 ERA (9.1 IP, 6 ER) in three appearances before being optioned to Triple-A Rochester.
• Went 0-1, 3.48 ERA (20.2 IP, 8 ER) in four starts with the Red Wings.
• Added as 26th man in doubleheader vs. Kansas City May 21, earned first win as a big leaguer in, going 7.0 IP and allowing three runs on five hits and two walks with three strikeouts.
• Became part of Twins starting rotation after being recalled to Minnesota May 26.
• Placed on 10-day DL August 9 with left arm brachialis strain, made rehab starts with Rochester and Double-A Chattanooga.
• Pitched in Double-A Division series, earned no decision after throwing five scoreless innings.
• Made three more big league starts upon activation from DL, none lasting longer than 4.2 IP.

WANT TO GET AWAY?: In eight road starts in 2017, Mejía was 2-2, 2.70 ERA (36.2 IP, 11 ER) while he was 2-5, 5.58 ERA (61.1, 38 ER) in 13 starts at Target Field...opposing hitters hit .234 against Mejía on the road while they hit .308 at Target Field with a .512 slugging percentage...Mejía's three appearances in 2018 have all come on the road, is 1-0, 3.65 ERA (12.1 IP, 5 ER).

LONG INNINGS: Mejía threw 17.9 pitches per inning in 2017, which was tied for 13th most in baseball...no other Twins starter threw more than 16.5 pitches per inning among starters who threw more than 75 innings...averaging 16.7 pitches per innings this year.

COOL UNDER PRESSURE: In 2017, Mejía held opponents to a .229 average (44-for-192) with 47 strikeouts with runners on base, a .240 average (24-for-100) with 26 strikeouts with runners in scoring position and a .167 average (2-for-12) with four strikeouts with the bases loaded...opponents hit .332 (66-for-199) vs. Mejía with nobody on base...in 2018, he is holding opponents to hit .222 (4-for-18) with RISP while he's allowing opponents to hit .276 (8-for-29) with no one on base.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - JAKE ODOORIZZI, RHP (SEASON: 4-7, 4.60 ERA // CAREER: 44-45, 3.94 ERA)

Odorizzi is making his 24th start of the season, is 4-7, 4.60 ERA (115.1 IP, 59 ER) with 47 walks and 120 strikeouts...last start was Aug. 3 vs. KC, allowed two runs in 3.1 innings and was removed after a 1:39 rain delay...making his eighth career start against Cleveland, is 1-3, 6.47 ERA (32.0 IP, 23 ER) with 14 walks and 34 strikeouts...last start against Cleveland was June 17, suffered the loss after allowing four runs on six hits and four walks with five strikeouts over 5.0 innings...in 2018, is 0-2, 9.88 ERA (13.2 IP, 15 ER) with seven walks and 14 strikeouts in three starts vs. CLE.
