NATIONALS NEWS

MOVING ON...

The Washington Nationals fell to the New York Mets, 6-5, in 12 innings on Sunday night, suffering their first sweep of the season and first sweep at the hands of the Mets since Sept. 7-9, 2015 at Nationals Park.

- The Nationals will continue this 10-game homestand tonight against Atlanta (3 G) before welcoming the Colorado Rockies to town for a four-game set starting Thursday.

HARPER'S HOMERS

Bryce Harper clubbed his sixth home run of the season on Sunday, a two-run shot in the first inning off **Matt Harvey**...His six home runs lead Major League Baseball, as does his 1.000 slugging percentage and 1.535 OPS...Harper ranks among National League hitters in walks (1st, 13), RBI (2nd, 12), on-base percentage (3rd, .535) and batting average (10th, .357).

- Of his 10 hits this season, six have been home runs...Moreover, Harper has 13 walks and just five strikeouts through the first nine games of the season.
- With his two RBI on Sunday night, Harper (433) passed **Ian Desmond** (432) for second-most RBI in Nationals history behind **Ryan Zimmerman** (940).

APRIL'S POWER

Harper's hot starts are well documented through the course of his career...In 127 April games, he is hitting .325 with 30 doubles, three triples, 39 home runs, 103 RBI, 95 walks and 101 runs scored.

- Harper has posted a .668 slugging percentage and a 1.109 OPS in his career during the month of April (.446 at bats)...Both are the best in Major League Baseball history (since 1913)...He is ahead of Babe Ruth, who posted a .638 slugging percentage and a 1.090 OPS in 643 career at bats in April.

VOTE FOR PEDRO

Since being recalled on April 2, **Pedro Severino** has reached base safely in 10 of 17 plate appearances (.588 OBP, 5 H, 2 HBP, 3 BB)...In four starts, he is hitting .455 (5-for-11) with one double, three RBI, three walks, one stolen base and two runs scored...He has recorded two multi-hit efforts and driven in runs in three of the four starts.

- Severino recorded his first career stolen base on April 7 vs. NYM.

HOWIE'S DOIN' IT

Howie Kendrick has reached base safely in each of his first eight games of the season...He has hit safely in seven of the games and he was hit by a pitch on April 4 at Atlanta while serving as a pinch hitter...Kendrick has recorded four multi-hit efforts along the way.

IT STARTS AT THE TOP

Through the first eight games, **Adam Eaton** is 10-for-29 (.345) with three doubles, two homers, five RBI, three walks and 10 runs scored...He has reached base safely in all seven of his starts.

- Eaton is tied for second in the National League with 10 runs scored...He ranks eighth in the National League in OPS (1.079), and ninth in slugging percentage (.655).
- Among active players with at least 450 games batting in the leadoff spot, Eaton ranks fifth in Major League Baseball with a .361 on-base percentage and sixth with a .287 batting average when batting first in his career.

STOLEN MOMENTS

Washington stole five bases on Saturday, the most in a game since July 27, 2017 vs. CHI and tied for the fourth most in a single game in Nationals history (2005-pres)...The Nationals lead MLB with 14 stolen bases.

- **Trea Turner** leads the National League (tied for 1st in MLB) with five stolen bases this season.
- **Michael A. Taylor** ranks second in the NL behind Turner and is third in MLB with four stolen bases.

NO INHERITANCE TAX

Nationals relievers have inherited 11 runners so far this season, with only one coming around to score (9.1%)...They are one of six teams in Major League Baseball (one of three in the NL) to allow no more than one inherited runner to come around to score in 2018.

NATIONALS HISTORY

April 9 (3-7 on this date)

2014 – After the Marlins intentionally walked **Anthony Rendon** in the eighth inning to load the bases, **Jayson Werth** hit his fourth career grand slam, first as a National, to cap a 10-7 comeback win over the Marlins at Nationals Park. **Bryce Harper's** fourth-inning three-run home run into the upper deck in right field sparked the comeback. Werth became the first player since **Melvin Mora** (Aug. 11, 2010 at NYM) to hit a go-ahead grand slam in the eighth inning or later after the previous batter was intentionally walked.

The group enjoys a behind-the-scenes look at team operations, a private meet and greet with Rendon as well as special batting practice viewing and tickets complete with NatsBucks.

OPPONENT

ATLANTA BRAVES

Dave Martinez capped his 16-year Major League career with Atlanta in 2001, hitting .287 in 12 games...**Matt Adams** clubbed 19 home runs in 100 games for the Braves in 2017...The Braves made Nationals Pitching Coach **Derek Lilliquist** their first-round selection (6th overall) back in the 1987 Amateur Draft.

THE SERIES

The Nationals went 10-9 against the Braves in 2017...Since 2015, Washington is 40-20 against Atlanta.

DAVE MARTINEZ

Nationals manager **Dave Martinez** was named the seventh field manager in Nationals history on Oct. 30, 2017. He joined the Nationals for what will be his 30th season in professional baseball. A 16-year Major League outfielder, Martinez has been a Major League coach for the last 10 seasons, serving as Cubs manager **Joe Maddon's** bench coach and right-hand man in Chicago (2015-17) as well as Tampa Bay (2008-14). This is the first Major League managerial assignment of Martinez's career.

#31 - MAX SCHERZER - RHP

Polished veteran right-hander, three-time Cy Young Award Winner and five-time consecutive All-Star signed a historic seven-year contract with Washington on Jan. 21, 2015...Joined the Nationals after seven Major League seasons with the Detroit Tigers (2010-14) and Arizona Diamondbacks (2008-09)...Is one of just 10 pitchers in Major League history to take home the Cy Young Award three or more times.

AGAINST THE BRAVES: Faces Atlanta for second time in as many starts...Since joining the Nationals, is 6-4 with a 3.86 ERA in 12 career starts against the Braves...The Nationals are 8-4 in those contests...Has allowed two earned runs or fewer in seven of the 12 starts...Of his 65 career 10+ strikeout games, only one has come at the expense of the Atlanta Braves, July 7, 2017 vs. ATL (10 SO).

LAST START: Suffered his first loss of 2018 on April 4 at ATL...Allowed five runs (just two earned runs) on six hits in 5.0 innings of work...Three unearned runs came after an error extending the first inning...The next batter, Preston Tucker, clubbed a three-run home run.

- Ranks tied for second in the National League with 17 strikeouts through two starts.
- Opened the season in dominating fashion striking out 10 batters in 6.0 shutout innings in Washington's 2-0 win over the Cincinnati Reds on Opening Day...It was his 65th career 10+ strikeout game...Scherzer's 10 strikeouts tied the most on Opening Day in Expos/Nationals history: **Stephen Strasburg** (3/31/14 at NYM) and **Steve Rogers** (4/9/82 at PHI).
- His 65 games of 10+ strikeouts are 11th-most in MLB history (since 1913) and most among active pitchers...Is one of just 13 pitchers in MLB history (since 1913) with at least 35 games of at least 10 strikeouts and one earned run or fewer allowed.
- Leads all active starters and ranks second in MLB history with a career 10.2 strikeouts per 9.0 IP (**Randy Johnson** - 10.6).
- Is the only pitcher in MLB with an active streak of six-plus seasons with at least 200 SO...Is one of 25 pitchers in MLB (since 1913) to post at least six seasons of 200+ strikeouts...The only other active pitchers to do so are **Zack Greinke** (6), **Clayton Kershaw** (6), **Felix Hernandez** (6), and **Justin Verlander** (6).
- Since joining the Nationals in 2015, has taken a no-hitter into the sixth inning 11 times in 100 starts (11%), according to MASN in-game reporter, Dan Kolko.

2017 NOTES

- Was named the National League Cy Young Award winner for the second consecutive season...He joined **Roger Clemens** (7), **Randy Johnson** (5), **Steve Carlton** (4), **Greg Maddux** (4), **Sandy Koufax** (3), **Pedro Martinez** (3), **Jim Palmer** (3), **Tom Seaver** (3) and **Clayton Kershaw** (3) as the only pitchers to bring home three Cy Young Awards...Hall of Famers **Gaylord Perry**, **Martinez**, and **Johnson**, as well as **Clemens** and **Roy Halladay** join Scherzer as the only pitchers to win the award in both leagues.
- Was the first pitcher to win his league's Cy Young Award in back-to-back seasons since **Clayton Kershaw** took home the honors in 2013 and 2014.
- Led the National league in strikeouts (268), WHIP (0.90), Opp. AVG (.178), Opp. OPS (.566), Hits per 9.0 IP (5.65), FanGraphs.com WAR (6.0), Baseball-Reference.com WAR (7.2), quality starts (22), and complete games (2).
- Was historically good in the season's first half...Went 10-5 with a 2.10 ERA in 18 starts prior to the All-Star break...Also posted a 0.78 WHIP...That was the fourth-best mark in MLB history (since 1913) among starting pitchers.
- With 12.02 SO/9.0 IP for the season, was just the fourth pitcher in MLB history to average as many as 12 SO/9.0 IP over a season of 200-plus innings: **Randy Johnson** did it six times (1995, 1997-2001), **Pedro Martinez** (1999) and **Chris Sale** (2017).
- Reached 2,000 strikeouts in 1,784.0 career IP, the third-fastest pitcher in Major League history (in terms of IP) to reach the 2,000-strikeout mark
