THE GIANTS: Will try and split this four-game series with a win today after losses in game one on Thursday (11-2) and game three yesterday (3-2)...SF enters today having lost five of their last six games.

GIANTS-RANGERS MAKE TRADE: Earlier this morning, the Giants announced that they have traded **RHP Cory Gearrin, OF Austin Jackson** and minor league **RHP Jason Bahr** to the Texas Rangers in exchange for a player to be named later or cash considerations.

GIANTS ROSTER MOVES: The Giants have purchased the contracts of **RHP Ray Black** (#62) and **OF Steven Duggar** (#6) today, replacing Gearrin and Jackson on the roster...both players will be seeking to make their Major League debuts.

WELCOME RAY: **RHP Ray Black**, 28, was drafted by the Giants in the seventh round of the 2011 draft...between double-A and triple-A this season, the 6-foot-5, 225-pound right-hander has gone 2-0 with a 2.27 ERA in 32 relief outings, recording 58 strikeouts in 31.2 innings...Black is known for his fastball that hits 100 mph on a nightly basis.

AND WELCOME STEVEN: **OF Steven Duggar** (last name is pronounced DUH-ger) hit .272 (86-for-316) with 52 runs scored, 27 doubles, four triples, four home runs, 21 RBI and stole 11 bases in 78 games with the River Cats this season, his fourth professional campaign...the 24-year-old was drafted by the Giants in the sixth round of the 2015 draft out of Clemson University.

2018 ALL-STARS: The 2018 All-Star selections will be unveiled today at 4:00 p.m. PT on ESPN.

ON THE MOUND: **LHP Madison Bumgarner** has allowed three runs (two earned) on 12 hits in 21.0 innings (0.86 ERA) over his last three starts...he's made three starts with Brian O'Nora as the home plate umpire and he's 2-0 with a 0.45 ERA, 26 strikeouts, five walks in 20.0 innings (*Baseball Info Solutions*).

ON THE SHORES OF McCOVEY COVE: The Giants are 27-16 (.643) here at home this season, the third-best home record in the NL behind Philadelphia (30-16, .652) and Chicago (27-15, .643)...SF has won five of their last eight home games and 15 of their last 21...the Giants have gone 9-0-1 (win-lost-split) in their last 10 home series...they haven't lost a home set since dropping two of three to Arizona from April 8-10.

NOT A LOT OF REST: The Giants are currently in a stretch of playing 16-consecutive games before their next off day, which is next Thursday, July 12...beginning June 8 and leading up to the All-Star Break, the Giants will have played 36 games in 38 days.

CLOSE CALLS: The Giants have played 47 games this year that have been decided by two runs or fewer, the fifth-most such games in the Majors...only the Nationals (52), Mariners (51), Rays (48) and Tigers (48) have played more close games.

THE FUTURE: **OF Heliot Ramos** (World Roster) and **RHP Shaun Anderson** (U.S. Roster) will represent the Giants in the All-Star Futures Game, which will be played at 1:00 p.m. (PT) next Sunday at Nationals Park.

TWO OUTS WITH RISP: The Giants with two outs, RISP are hitting .189/.304/.289 (.189 and .289 are NL worsts)...Giants opponents with two outs, RISP are hitting .265/351/.413 (.265 is MLB-high) (*Baseball Info Solutions*).

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

#40 LHP Madison Bumgarner
6-4, 243, 28 years old (August 1, 1989)
1-3 Record, 2.58 ERA

- The four-time All-Star (2013-16) takes the hill today for his seventh start of the season...the Giants are 2-4 in his outings this year.
- Is coming off a 5-2 loss at Colorado last Monday in which he was charged with three runs (two earned) on seven hits in 6.0 innings...had a 2-0 lead going into the 7th inning before allowing three-straight singles to open the frame...was removed from the game with the bases-loaded and no outs and the Rockies scored five runs in the final 2.0 innings.
- Had a 22.0-inning scoreless streak snapped in his last start at Colorado...marked the longest such streak of his career.
- In his last three starts he's had a lot of success with his curveball, recording strikes with it 11 of 15 times...he's gotten five outs in that span with no hits or walks allowed...for the season, opponents are 1-for-27 (.037) with one walk against his curveball...98 curves have netted 26 outs, a hit (a homer) and a walk.
- Is 1-1 with an 0.86 ERA (2er, 21.0ip), .158 average against, 21 strikeouts and seven walks allowed in his last three starts.
- Has received a total of just 11 runs of support in his six starts this season...has a record of 90-8 (.918) in his career when he receives at least three runs of support.
- Is holding left-handed batters to a .133 average against (4-for-30).
- Is 3-5 with a 4.38 ERA in eight career regular season starts against the Cardinals...is just 1-5 with a 5.06 ERA (21er, 37.1ip) in his last six starts against them.
- Was reinstated from the 60-day DL June 5...made just two rehab starts.
- Missed the Giants' first 60 games with a broken pinkie finger on his left hand, an injury he suffered on his final start in spring training at Scottsdale, Arizona on March 23 after Royals' hitter Whit Merrifield hit a line-drive comebacker off of his left hand.
- Had never been on the disabled list in his first eight Major League seasons but has now twice been placed on the DL the last two years, missing a total of 135 games.
- SF is 59-76 (.437) with Bumgarner on the DL.
- Missed three months last year (mid-April, May, June, mid-July) - 85 days, 75 games) with a left shoulder AC sprain...sustained the injury during a dirt bike accident on the team's off day in Denver, CO on April 20.
- Has 32 double-digit strikeout games, the second-most in Giants franchise history behind **Tim Lincecum** (36).

HITTING NOTES: Is hitless in 14 at-bats this season with seven strikeouts... his last hit was a home run against St. Louis' Luke Weaver last Sept. 3... batted .206 with three homers and five RBI last season...has hit 17 homers in his 10-year career, the most of any active player and the most in Giants franchise history...is the first pitcher to total at least three homers in four consecutive seasons since Earl Wilson achieved the feat in five-straight seasons between 1964 and 1968.

TOMORROW'S STARTER: LHP ANDREW SUAREZ

2018: 3-5, 3.92 ERA / Career: 3-5, 3.92 ERA

NOTES: The 25-year-old left-hander is slated to make his 15th career Major League start...has gone 3-5 with a 3.92 ERA (34er, 78.0ip) in 13 outings, with the Giants going 5-9 in those games...was tagged with the loss in the Giants' 1-0 shutout loss at Colorado on July 4...allowed one run on five hits with no walks and six strikeouts...his one run allowed was a solo home run by Chris Iannetta...has pitched better as of late, posting a 2.10 ERA (7er, 30.0ip) over his last five starts...has never faced the Cubs...is 0-2 with an 8.10 ERA (9er, 10.0ip) in two starts against the NL Central.
