WHITE SOX AT A GLANCE

- The Chicago White Sox have won eight of their last 12 games, 14 of 21 and 19 of 32 as they continue a 10-game, 11-day homestand tonight with the finale vs. Detroit.
- RHP Michael Kopech, whose first two major-league starts at home have been shortened by rain, is scheduled to start for the White Sox.
- The Sox are 3-3 on the homestand, splitting the first two games of this series and also a four-game set vs. Boston last weekend.
- Following tonight's game and a day off tomorrow, the White Sox conclude the homestand with three games vs. the Angels (9/7-9) ... they then take a nine-game, 11-day trip to Kansas City (8/10-12), Baltimore (8/14-16) and Cleveland (8/18-20).
- The Sox went 5-2 on their last trip to Detroit (3-1) and New York-AL (2-1) from 8/23-29, including their first series win at Yankee Stadium since 2005.

TONIGHT'S STORYLINES

- The White Sox end a stretch from 8/17-9/5 where they play 20 consecutive days (12-7 so far).
- The Sox have won six of their last eight games vs. Detroit (37-23 margin) after losing nine of the first 10.
- The White Sox own a 3.02 ERA (36 ER/107.1 IP) over the last 12 games, the third-best mark in the American League ... the starters have posted a 2.50 ERA (19 ER/68.1 IP) in that span.
- The Sox are hitting .272/.329/.455 (217-797) with 31 home runs and 119 runs scored over the last 23 games (5.2 R/G).
- Yolmer Sánchez has reached base safely in a career-high 22 consecutive games (.414 on-base percentage), the longest streak by a Sox player since José Abreu (29) from 8/2-9/2/16.

JONES ON ASSIGNMENT

- The White Sox have sent RHP Nate Jones to Class A Winston-Salem on an injury rehab assignment ... Jones, 32, was placed on the 10-day disabled list on 6/13 with a pronator strain in his right arm and transferred to the 60-day disabled list on 9/1.

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP

- Detroit scored five runs in the second inning and went on to record an 8-3 victory over the White Sox.
- Lucas Giolito's career-best, three-game winning streak ended after allowing five runs (four earned) on four hits over 1.1 IP, matching the shortest start of his career.
- The Sox scored all three of their runs in the fourth to pull within 6-3 ... Tim Anderson collected two of Chicago's eight hits.

WINNING WAYS

- The White Sox have gone 14-7 since 8/14, the second-best record in the major leagues behind Tampa Bay (15-5).
- The Sox are 19-13 since 8/2, moving from 9.0 games behind Detroit into a third-place tie with the Tigers in the AL Central.
- Chicago is 12-7 so far during a stretch of playing 20 straight days from 8/17-9/5, and 9-5 since José Abreu was placed on the disabled list on 8/22.

CARLOS MAY ... 50 YEARS LATER

- Tomorrow marks the 50th anniversary of Carlos May making his major-league debut for the White Sox as a 20-year-old at Baltimore ... he went 0-4 as the starting left fielder in a 3-2 win.
- May, who serves as a club ambassador, went on to play nine seasons for the White Sox and was named 1969 American League Rookie of the Year by *The Sporting News*.

HONORING THE CHAMPS

- The Chicago White Sox Reviving Baseball in Inner Cities (RBI) team will be honored tonight in a pregame ceremony as the 2018 RBI World Series champions of the Senior Baseball Division ... their victory marked the second RBI World Series championship victory for Chicago in the 26-year history of the tournament.
- The White Sox also will welcome more than 150 athletes from the Amateur City Elite (ACE) program for a pregame parade earned for donating a new or gently used glove as part of a Baseball Tomorrow Fund (BTF) equipment drive.

ABREU HONORED

- The White Sox will honor José Abreu as their Roberto Clemente Award nominee tonight in a pregame ceremony with members from Abreu's Amigos program and Easterseals Academy.
- The Clemente Award recognizes the player who best represents the game of baseball through sportsmanship, community involvement and positive contributions, both on and off the field.
- Abreu's Amigos is in its fourth year, partnering with Easterseals Academy to provide regular opportunities for students with special needs to develop social skills in a recreational setting through field trips to the ballpark.

WHITE SOX VS. DETROIT

- The Tigers are 11-7 in 2018, going 7-1 at Guaranteed Rate Field and 4-6 at Comerica Park, to improve to 8-1 in the last nine season series against the White Sox.
 - The Sox are batting .258/.310/.422 (160-621) with a 4.30 ERA (76 ER/159.0 IP) and have been outscored by the Tigers, 82-76.
 - The White Sox are 68-99 against Detroit since 2010 (37-45 at Guaranteed Rate Field).
 - The Sox trail in the all-time series, 1,056-1,098 ... they are 563-516 in Chicago (126-102 at Guaranteed Rate Field) and 493-582 in Detroit (84-91 at Comerica Park).
- #### LOOKING FOR CENTRAL COMMAND
- The White Sox are 27-35 against the American League Central in 2018 (13-20 at home), but have won 10 of their last 14 games by a combined 73-56 margin.
 - The White Sox are 318-412 vs. the AL Central since 2009, posting a losing record every season except 2012 (37-36).

RACE FOR THE PRIZE

- Class A Winston-Salem (Carolina), Class A Kannapolis (South Atlantic) and Advanced Rookie Great Falls (Pioneer) have qualified for the postseason in their respective leagues.
- Winston-Salem won both halves of the CL Southern Division with a combined 84-54 record, the fourth-best winning percentage in the minor leagues ... the Dash will play Buies Creek in a best-of-five semifinal playoff beginning tonight.
- Kannapolis finished second overall in the SAL Northern Division with a 74-63 record and will host Lakewood tonight in Game 1 of its best-of-three semifinal series.
- Great Falls has reached the postseason for the 11th time in the last 12 seasons. ... the Voyagers are at Billings Friday night in the opener of a PL best-of-three semifinal series.

PALKA POWER

- Daniel Palka, who was claimed off waivers from Minnesota on 11/4/17, ranks among the American League rookie leaders in home runs (3rd, 21), RBI (3rd, 55), runs scored (4th, 47) and total bases (5th, 165).
- Palka's 21 homers are the second-highest total in White Sox history by a left-handed hitting rookie, one behind Pete Ward's franchise-record of 22 in 1963.

YOUNG GUNS

- Lucas Giolito (24 years old), Michael Kopech (22), Reynaldo López (24) and Carlos Rodón (25) make up four-fifths of the White Sox starting rotation.
- Giolito leads the staff with 10 victories and is 3-1 with a 4.05 ERA (12 ER/26.2 IP) and 30 strikeouts over his last five starts.
- Kopech has allowed one run over 11.0 IP over his first three major-league starts, two of which have been rain-shortened.
- López is 1-0 with a 1.83 ERA (4 ER/19.2 IP) over his last three starts and has combined to go 2-0 with a 1.33 ERA (3 ER/20.1 IP) in three starts this season against Boston and the Yankees.
- Rodón is 5-1 with a 2.11 ERA (15 ER/64.0 IP) and .151 (33-218) opponents average over his last nine starts.

POWER AND SPEED ...

- Tim Anderson (18 HR/25 SB) is one of five players in the major leagues with at least 18 home runs and 25 stolen bases, joining Boston's Mookie Betts, Pittsburgh's Starling Marte, Cleveland's José Ramírez and Colorado's Trevor Story.
- Anderson is attempting to become the first White Sox shortstop to record a 20-HR/20-SB season and could join Alex Ríos (2010) and Tommie Agee (1966) as the only players in franchise history to post 20 homers and 30 steals in one season.

... AND IMPROVED GLOVEWORK

- SS Tim Anderson has played a career-high 23 straight errorless games (89 TC) and owns a .985 fielding percentage (4 E/266 TC) since 6/10, the fifth-best mark in the American League.
- By comparison, Anderson posted a .957 (53 E/1,247 TC) fielding percentage over his first 302 career games at shortstop from 6/10/16-6/9/18.

QUALITY AND QUANTITY

- The White Sox have made 1,379 quality starts since the start of the 2003 season, tied with the New York Mets for the highest total in the major leagues and 52 more than Oakland (1,327), the next-closest American League team.

ON DECK: LOS ANGELES ANGELS

- The White Sox conclude the homestand this weekend with three games vs. the Angels ... LHP Carlos Rodón (6-4, 2.89) is scheduled to start Friday's opener ... the teams split a four-game series in the first matchup from 7/23-26 at Angel Stadium.

KOPECH AT A GLANCE

- The 22-year-old is scheduled to make his fourth career start, third at home and second against Detroit.
- Went 7-7 with a 3.70 ERA (52 ER/126.1 IP), .219 opp. average (101-461), 170 strikeouts (12.11 per 9.0 IP) and nine home runs allowed over 24 starts with Charlotte this season.
- Became the first pitcher since 1908 to start his first two MLB games and give up one or zero runs and zero walks in both.
- Allowed two runs or less in each of his last seven starts with the Knights, going 4-0 with a 1.84 ERA (9 ER/44.0 IP), 59 strikeouts and four walks ... did not issue a walk in his last 24.0 IP dating back to 7/31.
- His 170 strikeouts are second-most in the minor leagues ... struck out 172 in 2017, tied for the fifth-most.
- Entered the season rated by *Baseball America* and MLB.com as the No. 13 prospect in baseball ... is the No. 2 ranked prospect in the White Sox system behind OF Eloy Jiménez ... also ranked by *Baseball America* as the Top 2018 Rookie and possessing the Best Fastball in the White Sox system.
- Has gone 24-22 with a 3.05 ERA (134 ER/395.2 IP), 514 strikeouts (11.7 per 9.0 IP), a 1.21 WHIP and just 18 home runs allowed in 85 career appearances (84 starts) over five minor-league seasons in the Boston (2014-16) and Chicago (2017-18) organizations.
- Was acquired with INF Yoán Moncada, OF Luis Alexander Basabe and RHP Víctor Díaz from the Red Sox in exchange for LHP Chris Sale on 12/6/16 ... was selected by Boston in the first round (33rd overall) of the June 2014 First-Year Player Draft out of Mount Pleasant (Texas) High School.

LAST START

- Received a no decision on 8/31 vs. Boston ... tossed 3.0 scoreless IP, allowing one hit, one walk and one hit batsman ... stranded two baserunners in the first inning and one in the second.
- Was removed after the third inning following a two hour and nine-minute rain delay.
- Left with the Sox leading, 3-0, after throwing 36 pitches (22 strikes) ... Chicago went on to win, 6-1.

KNIGHT IN SHINING ARMOR

- Went 7-7 with a 3.70 ERA (52 ER/126.1 IP), .219 opponents average (101-461), 170 strikeouts (12.11 per 9.0 IP) and nine home runs allowed over 24 starts with Class AAA Charlotte this season.
- At the time of his promotion, ranked among the International League leaders in strikeouts (1st), strikeouts per 9.0 IP (1st), starts (T1st) and opponents average (3rd).
- Limited right-handers to a .215 average (53-246) and lefties to a .223 mark (48-215) ... opponents overall hit .187 (23-123) with RISP and .185 (10-54) with RISP/two outs
- Was named White Sox Minor League Pitcher of the Month for April after going 0-1 with a 2.14 ERA (5 ER/21.0 IP), 29 strikeouts and a .189 (14-74) opponents average over four starts in the month ... ranked third in the IL in strikeouts per 9.0 IP (12.4) and fourth in strikeouts.

STRIKEOUT SENSATION

- Ranks second among MiLB pitchers with 170 strikeouts in 2018 after finishing the 2017 season tied for fifth (172).
- His 12.11 strikeouts per 9.0 IP (170 SO/126.1 IP) lead the International League.
- Recorded 10 or more strikeouts three times this season and nine or more nine times, including in each of his last three outings since 8/5.
- Owns a strikeout-per-9.0 IP mark of 11.5 or greater in four of his five professional seasons ... registered a 9.7 (70 SO/65.0 IP) mark in 2015.

A STARTING DEBUT

- Became the 15th White Sox pitcher since 2005 to make his major-league debut as a starter, and the first since RHP Dylan Covey last season.
- Just two of the 15 pitchers have earned a win in their debut: RHP Scott Carroll and RHP Lucas Harrell.

VS. DETROIT TIGERS

- Will make his second career start against the Tigers ... earned his first career win on 8/26 at Detroit after allowing one run on seven hits with four strikeouts over 6.0 IP ... escaped two bases loaded jams in the fourth and sixth inning.

FRIDAY'S SCHEDULED STARTER

- LHP Carlos Rodón (6-4, 2.89 ERA) is scheduled to make his 16th start of the season, eighth at home and second vs. the Angels.
- Is 5-1 with a 2.19 ERA (17 ER/70.0 IP), .159 opp. average, 0.96 WHIP, 53 strikeouts and six homers allowed over his last 10 starts (nine quality) ... the 2.19 ERA since 7/5 is the lowest in the American League and seventh-lowest in MLB behind Trevor Williams (1.42), Jacob deGrom (1.45), Aaron Nola (1.92), Zack Wheeler (1.93), Dereck Rodriguez (1.95) and Clayton Kershaw (1.98).
- Suffered the loss in his last outing on 9/1 vs. Boston ... allowed five runs (four earned) on six hits with two homers, two walks and four strikeouts in 6.1 IP ... had his streak of nine consecutive quality starts snapped.
- Has gone 2-2 with a 3.52 ERA (9 ER/23.0 IP), .198 opp. average, 1.09 WHIP and 25 strikeouts in four career starts vs. the Angels.
